

WEB American Civics Homework Assignment for August 17, 2016: “What’s a Good Rule? - Part 1”

Currently, WEB does not allow food to be consumed in the classrooms. In your small groups (committees) you discussed the pros and cons of changing this policy and allowing food in the rooms.

Continue working on this problem, with the goal of devising a new WEB rule that would allow food in the rooms. Please consult/interview at least three members of your local community for their thoughts on this possible amendment to the existing rules; please take notes about their comments so you can refer to them later in class. For your interviews, use a yellow sticky note to record the name of this person exactly as he/she wishes to be identified, his/her relationship to you, and the date of your interview (such as “Mr. B, my neighbor, Friday, August 19”); use a pink sticky note to record their comments in your own words. Transcribe these notes into your composition notebook, using a clean page for each interview. Keep the sticky notes on from each person on that page for reference when your committee reconvenes.

Update your Table of Contents when you have completed your entries.
