

28th annual People's Choice Awards

Each year, the American Institute of Architects, Southwestern Oregon Chapter (AIA-SWO) in collaboration with the American Society of Landscape Architects, Willamette Valley Section of the Oregon Chapter (ASLA) sponsor the People's Choice Awards for Architecture. The intent of these awards is to educate and inspire our fellow citizens by showcasing architecture, interiors and landscape architecture projects created within the Southwestern Oregon Chapter area or by members of our Chapter. The program demonstrates to the public the role of the architectural profession in enhancing the built environment. The public is asked to vote for their favorite designs in several categories during **October's First Friday Art Walk, at the Broadway Commerce Center in Downtown Eugene on October 6th, 2017.** Boards will remain on display and voting open during the month of October. Votes will be counted and winners recognized at a Chapter Meeting later in the year.

Participation Benefits

- Gain valuable public exposure and feedback from the community via their opportunity to view and vote on your firm's individual project.
- Your professional colleagues will also have the opportunity to vote on your entry as part of the Colleagues Choice Award.
- Your boards will be displayed during October's First Friday Artwalk, at the Broadway Commerce Center in Downtown Eugene. Boards will remain on display at the Broadway Commerce Center and voting open during the month of October.
- Pictures and written descriptions of all the winners will be posted on the AIA-SWO website. AIA-SWO will also endeavor to publicize the winners in various media outlets.

Submission Requirements

- **ENTRY FORM and PAYMENT:** Each project submitted requires a separate entry form. (Please see reverse) Submit entry forms and payment to Kathy Wendland at AIA-SWO. Mailing address: 92 E Broadway, Eugene, OR 97401. Email at kathy@aiaswo.org. **Entry forms and payment are due on Friday, September 15th, 2017.**
- **BOARD:** One rigid display board for each project entered. A board size of max. 24"x36" is preferred but not required. Provide hanging tabs or eyelets at the two upper corners for each board. Bring submissions to Greg Runyon at PIVOT Architecture at 44 East Broadway, Suite 300. For drop-off questions, contact Scott Clarke: 541.342.7291. **Boards are due by 5pm on Monday, October 2nd.**
- **DIGITAL FILES:** One digital image of the project board and one digital photograph of the project (JPEG or PDF). E-mail digital images to Frank Visconti at frank@rowellbrokaw.com. Limit size of all files to 10 MB max. If you have questions please email Frank. **Files are due by 5pm on Monday, October 2nd.**
- Entrants are encouraged to acknowledge the contributions of all significant parties involved with the realization of their projects; to identify the locations of their projects; and to consider the environment when selecting materials and preparing boards for their submission.

Digital Submission - Student/Emerging Pro

- The Student/Emerging Professional Award category is entirely digital, with entries presented on screen at the PCAs. Digital board must be in pdf format, and not exceed 10 MB.

Eligibility

- Entrants must be AIA, ASLA or AIAS members
- Emerging Professionals are defined as a recent (5-years or less) graduate. Work submitted must have been done outside of a professional office.
- Projects designed by AIA members outside of Southwestern Oregon Chapter area may be submitted if the projects are located within our Chapter area.
- Entrants must have primary design responsibility.
- Projects submitted may be located anywhere in the world if designed by an architect, architecture firm, or landscape architect from the Southwestern Oregon Chapter area of AIA, ASLA or AIAS.
- Built projects cannot have been submitted any previous year, except as an unbuilt project.

Firms with 5 or fewer employees

- Entry Fee \$100* per submission (AIA-SWO or ASLA members)
- \$150 per submission (non-AIA-SWO members)

Firms with more than 5 employees

- Entry Fee \$175* per submission (AIA-SWO or ASLA members)
- \$250 per submission (non-AIA-SWO members)

Students/Emerging Pros

Unbuilt category

- Entry Fee with board: \$20 per submission
- Entry Fee with digital entry only: Free (one submission only)

* To encourage entries from throughout the AIA-SWO chapter, member firms 30 miles outside of Eugene/Springfield will receive a 20% discount on Entry Fees. Firms will be awarded a 10% discount per entry board submitted beyond an initial four boards.
