21. P.37 "Blessed are you when people insult you and persecute you, and falsely say all kinds of evil against you."
22. P.38 "Rejoice and be glad."
23. P.39 "You are the salt of the earth."
24. P.39 "Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good deeds."
25. P.41 "Do not think that I came to abolish the law or the prophets; I did not come to abolish but to fulfill."

63. P.82 He told the twelve that when they arrived at a city, they were to inquire who is worthy in a city to stay there.
64. P.83 "As you enter the house, give it your greeting."
65. P.84 "Whoever does not receive you...shake the dust off your feet."
66. P.84 "Be shrewd as serpents and innocent as doves."
67. P.86 "It is not you who speak, it is the Spirit of your Father who speaks in you."
68. P.87 "Do not fear them."
69. P.88 "What I tell you in the darkness, speak in the light, and what you hear whispered in your ear, proclaim among the housetops."

100. P.136 He looked at them with anger, for He was grieved at their hardness of heart.
101. P.137 "Take care of what you listen to."
102. P.137 "A prophet is not without honor except in His hometown and among his own relatives and in his own household."
103. P.138 "Listen to Me, all of you, and understand."
104. P.139 He sighed deeply in His spirit.

105. P.140 "For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will also be ashamed of him when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels."
106. P.141 He took Peter, James, and John up to a high mountain by themselves.
107. P.142 "If you can? All things are possible to him who believes."
108. P.142 "Have salt in yourselves, and be at peace with one another."
109. P.143 "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."
110. P.144 "When you see these things happening, recognize that He is near."
111. P.145 He began to be very distressed and troubled.
112. P.146 He reproached them for their unbelief and hardness of heart.
113. P.155 When He was about twelve years old, His parents found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions.

120. P.161 "Make friends for yourselves by means of the wealth of unrighteousness, so that when it fails, they will receive you into eternal dwellings."

122. P.163 "The things that are impossible with people are possible with God."
123. P.164 "I tell you that to everyone who has, more shall be given, but from the one who does not have, even what he does have shall be taken away."
124. P.165 When He approached, He saw the city and wept over it.
125. P.166 He entered the temple and began to cast out those who were selling.
126. P.167 "So make up your minds not to prepare beforehand to defend yourselves."
127. P.168 "By your endurance you will gain your lives."
128. P.169 "But when these things begin to take place, straighten up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near."
129. P.170 He came out and proceeded as was His custom to the Mount of Olives.
130. P.171 Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures.

131. P.188 And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.
132. P.189 "Take these things away; stop making My Father's house a place of business."
133. P.190 For His part, Jesus did not entrust Himself to them, for He knew all men.
134. P.191 "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."
135. P.192 Many more believed because of what Jesus said.
136. P.193 "Do not sin anymore, so that nothing worse happens to you."
137. P.194 He tested Philip; He knew what he intended to do.
138. P.195 "Do not grumble among yourselves."
139. P.196 "He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him."
140. P.197 Jesus knew that His disciples grumbled at what He said.
141. P.198 "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are Spirit and are life."
142. P.199 Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, as well as who it was that would betray Him.
143. P.200 "No one can come to Me unless it has been granted him from the Father."
144. P.201 "Do not judge according to appearance, but judge with righteous judgment."

145. P.202 They picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.
146. P.203 “Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me.”
147. P.204 “He who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and greater works than these he will do; because I go to the Father.”
148. P.205 “Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit, He prunes it so that it may bear more fruit.”
149. P.205 “Abide in Me, and I in you...apart from Me you can do nothing.”
150. P.206 “I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit.”
151. P.207 “He who hates Me hates My Father also.”
152. P.208 “You will testify also, because you have been with Me from the beginning.”
153. P.209 “You will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice; you will grieve, but your grief will be turned into joy.”
