

PRESS RELEASE – Code Elektro “WOLF”

Code Elektro will release the sequel to the critically acclaimed debut, “Superstrings”, on June 3, 2016 via Iceberg Records. The title of the new album is “Wolf”.

The music is characterized by the use of synthesizers and sound design. It sounds similar to the soundtracks of movies like Blade Runner and TRON: Legacy. However, it also takes a step forward to create something new.

The previous record, “Superstrings”, was well received by critics and audiences worldwide and was nominated for a GAFFA AWARD for Best Danish Electronic Album 2015.

CONCEPT

“Wolf” is similar to a concept album in that it mixes themes such as *technology, the future and the role of man in relation to nature*. Each track on the record describes a feeling or an action, and all of the tracks describe an adventure. From the initiation ritual of the wolf den to the Scandinavian nature, storms, the darkness of night, the city lights – and the final transformation.

Jon Gotlev (Liserstille, NoHeroes) created the cover and illustration. He also created the large inner cover illustration on the vinyl.

DYNAMIC SOUND

Code Electric has partnered with Nordic Dynamic and Peter Lyngdorf (HifiKlubben) for sound quality and dynamics. On the vinyl version – *and* a special Nordic Dynamic version – there are more dynamics and better sound quality, which are not possible on traditional platforms such as iTunes and Spotify. This allows “Wolf” to maintain natural texture and extra musical depth – although the sound universe is very electronic.

CODE ELEKTRO

The man behind Code Elektro is composer and sound designer Martin Ahm, who has worked professionally in music and sound design for almost 10 years. Collaborators include: Fanta, BMW and MTV. Martin also teaches music composition for film at the University and the Conservatory of Music.

In 2012 he founded Code Elektro. While Code Elektro is an artistic platform for Martin, it is also very much a gift from one sci-fi fan to other sci-fi fans. Code Elektro takes inspiration from – among others – Vangelis, John Carpenter and Daft Punk, and maintains as its main focus the creation of mental images in the listener’s mind - from drama to excitement to beautiful atmospheres.

The record will be released on iTunes, Spotify, Tidal, Amazon, Deezer, Google Play, etc. There will also be a Nordic Dynamic version of extra-good quality in vinyl *and* digital formats.
