Marit Tingleff studied at the National College of Art and Design in Bergen. Marit is professor of ceramics at Oslo National Academy of the Arts, and is one of Norway’s most celebrated ceramists since 1980. Her work is very expressive, with strongly ornamental features and undulating, organic lines. She has participated in a number of exhibitions in Norway and abroad, and was one of the key exhibitors at during the Oslo International Ceramics Symposium in 2003, when her work was included in *Concentus*, the main OICS exhibition at the Museum of Decorative Arts and Design. Her international breakthrough came when she participated in the exhibition *Scandinavian Craft Today*, which travelled to Japan and the USA in 1987-88. Purchasers of her works include Norwegian museums of decorative arts, Design Museum, Denmark and the Victoria and Albert Museum, UK. She has been awarded several public commissions, including artwork for the Government Administration Complex in Oslo.
