## YOU'VE BEEN APPROVED!

CONGRATULATIONS! Berens River Student Services will provide you financial assistance towards Tuition, Books & Supplies, and Living Allowance. As a sponsoring agency, we require our students to follow and abide by the conditions set by our policy to ensure a successful education and sponsorship relationship.

## POST SECONDARY

Sponsored Students must be aware of the following:

- Credit accounts are setup for Textbooks at your University/College Bookstore. Just provide your student number and you can proceed in collecting your required textbooks
- We provide \$50.00 for school supplies (ie. Pens, pencils, paper, binders, highlighters, erasers, etc) in September and January for each term. **Non-Essential supplies (ie, Backpacks, school memorabilia, memory sticks/flash cards) are not considered essential school supplies and will be at your own cost.**
- Transcripts are required to be submitted at the end of each Academic Term, or continued sponsorship or future sponsorship applications will not be accepted.
- **Course Withdrawals must be reported immediately.**
- Full Time Students must be registered for full time programs and courses in order to qualify for Living Allowance, at a minimum of **18 credit hours**.
- **Summer Sponsorships will not be approved**
- Students are required to meet with Education Counsellor monthly when they pick up their allowance to report their progress on a regular basis.
- **Out of Town** Students can give their monthly progress reports via email: [jurgenv@berensriver.ca](mailto:jurgenv@berensriver.ca)
- Regular attendance is mandatory; **missing 50% of your classes will result in termination of your sponsorship.**
- **Extra allowance cheques after your term of sponsorship is complete will not be granted.**

## UNIVERSITY

Attending University requires a strong desire and commitment to your education. Universities do not track attendance therefore we respectfully assume that all University students are dedicated and mature in aspiring to fulfill their future goals.

To be a successful University Student, emphasize studying your textbooks and highlight key points that will give you the advantage in the exams. Every student and Professors you meet at University are personable and mature adults, so don't be afraid to discuss topics regarding your text, course assignment and class lectures. Attendance is strongly advised, as each class covers a lot of material in the text and Professors also use that time to build their own personality profile on the students they teach. Stay in good standing with your professors and you will make positive gains towards achieving your goals.

## COLLEGE/TECHNICAL/TRADE

Attending a College or Technical Trade Institution needs you to attend daily. They do track attendance and this does affect your overall grade.

To be a successful college student, emphasize participating as much as possible, attend classes daily and build a working relationship with your peers and your instructors.
