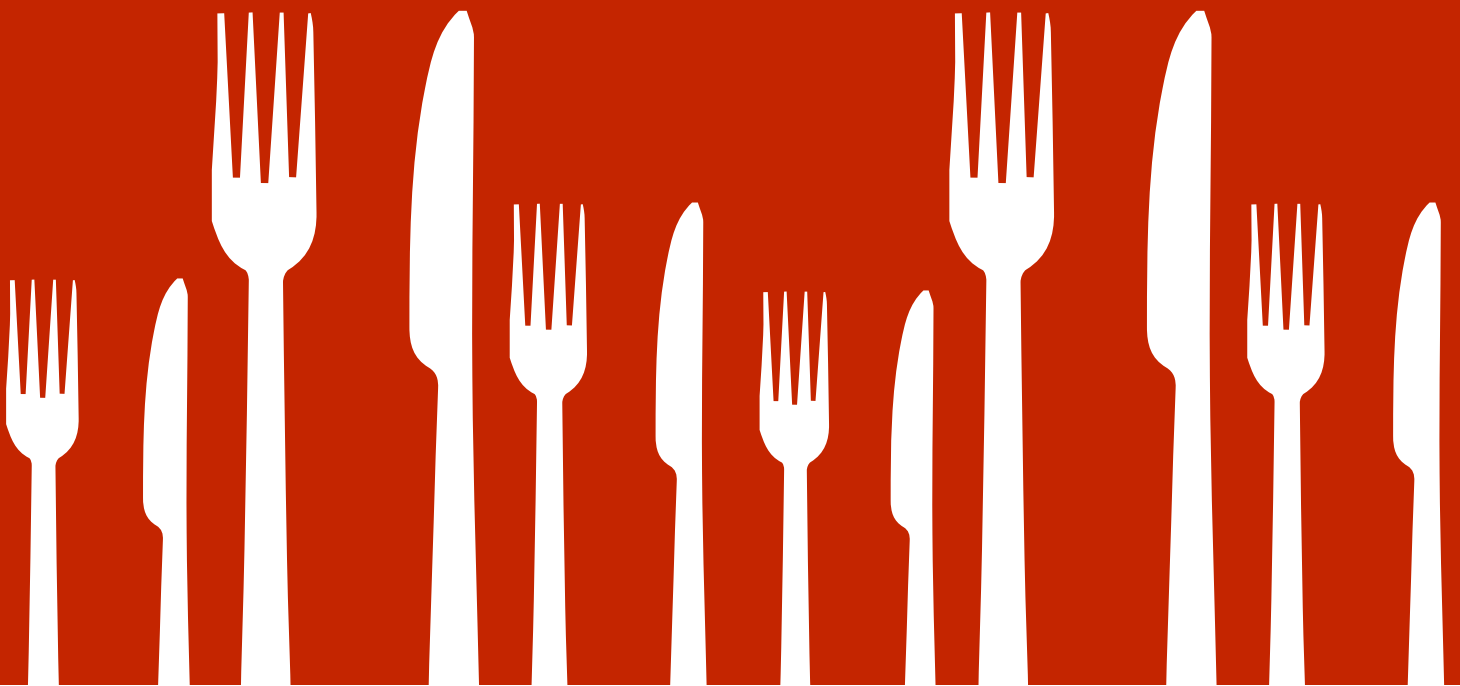

COPE

Every year, the Pomegranate Restaurant / Fort Erie Secondary School students host a food drive to collect non-perishable food items for Fort Erie's Community Outreach Program, the local food bank. So far, 650lbs of non-perishable food items, and \$700 has been donated to COPE.



Farmers' Market

Once a year, the Pomegranate students visit the Ridgeway Farmers' Market to hand out free food to the public, and to spread the word about Fort Erie Secondary School's SHSM hospitality and tourism class, and the Pomegranate Restaurant itself.

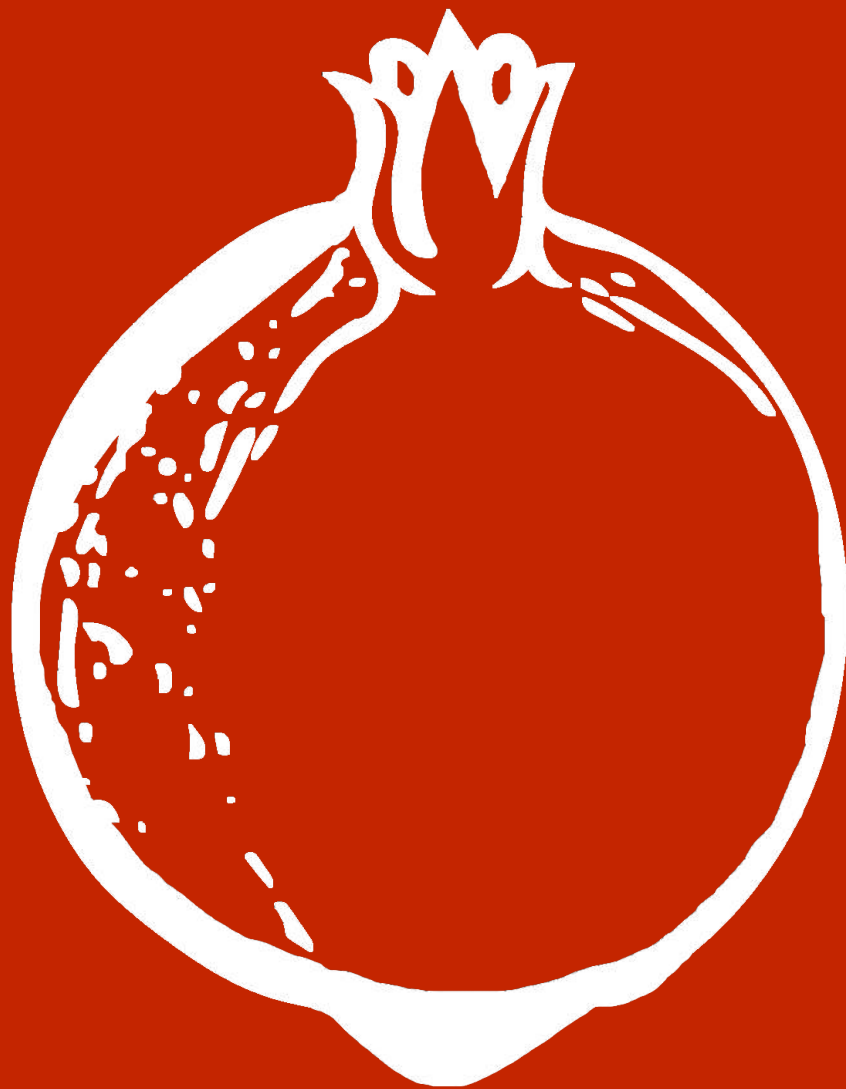
