- 175** - Heidelberg Science Scholarship - (20) \$2,000 Scholarships renewable 3 subsequent yrs pending 3.0 GPA. If a student receives a local scholarship & a State Science Day scholarship, students may only use the State level scholarship - Non-Heidelberg scholarships may be used with this award.
