



Holy Matrimony Wedding Fees

Standard Fees (payable by all)

1. **Reservation Fee:** **\$500**
Required to reserve the date/time on the church calendar. This fee is fully refundable up until two months before the wedding date, if the wedding is cancelled.
2. **Use of the Church** **\$1000***
3. **Clergy Fees** **\$750**
This fee includes pre-marital counseling sessions.
4. **Music Fees** **\$350**
For the services of the organist (music consultation, rehearsal and wedding). If there is special music, an extra rehearsal with soloists, or more than one consultation, there is an incremental fee. Soloists and instrumentalists are available and are subject to an additional fee. Please discuss directly with the director of music.
5. **Altar Guild:** **\$150**
The Altar Guild is responsible for preparing and adorning the altar for the wedding. The altar guild also provides all flowers for the altar and will work with you regarding color schemes and flower selections.
6. **Vergers:** **\$200**
The vergers will ensure the church is clean and tidy before your wedding and that everything is ready for the service. He will also act as your master of ceremonies during the rehearsal and on the wedding day itself.
7. **Bulletin (wedding programs/ Admin and Production fee) - \$300**
We will produce up to 100 copies of your wedding bulletins for you. Booklets are produced in black and white on standard 8.5 x 14 paper, folded and booklet-stapled to make an 8-page booklet. Additional copies, other formats, paper types, color printing, attachment of ribbons, etc., can be provided for an additional fee.

Variable Fees

1. **Carillon** **\$250**
St. Peter's has a wonderful 49 bell, concert grade carillon. The bells are rung before and after the ceremony.
2. **Use of the Great Hall for wedding reception**
 - a. **Communicants** **\$250**
 - b. **Non-communicants** **\$1000**

Payment of fees

Reservation fees must be paid in full in order to reserve the date/time on the church calendar. Checks should be made payable to St. Peter's church, memo "wedding deposit" and the date of the wedding.

Wedding fees must be paid in full no later than two weeks prior to the rehearsal. Checks should be made payable to St. Peter's church, memo "wedding fees" and the date of the wedding.

Communicants and Non-Communicants

A communicant of St. Peter's Church is one who worships regularly at St. Peter's, has received Communion here at least three times in the past year, and contributes regularly to parish support. If at least one member of the couple, or the parents of one member, fit this definition, the "Communicant rate" applies.

Note: No one is ever denied the sacrament of Christian Marriage because of the inability to pay the fees. In cases of financial hardship, fees can be negotiated with a member of the clergy.
