TUTORING

St. Peter's is home to The Afterschool on South, an afterschool program that offers a safe and caring community for children in grades K – 8 in Morristown and the surrounding areas. Children that attend receive a healthy snack, homework time, recreation time (outdoors weather permitting), tutoring and enrichment from certified subject specialist teachers, center time, and classes in art, music, and sports. Assistance is needed on a daily basis during the school year between 3:00 and 6:00 pm to tutor children, help with homework, serve snack, assist with bus duty, play a game, present a special activity, read with a child, help with a project, or just show a child that you care!



HEALTHY MARKET

Each Wednesday, our Healthy Market provides fresh fruit, vegetables, and meat for families to take home. Produce comes from Trader Joes, Whole Foods, Stop & Shop, and local farms. Many women with young children come each week to pick up fresh items to cook healthy meals for their families. Volunteers are needed to help set up each week and distribute groceries to families.



REFUGEE ASSISTANCE

Refugee Assistance Morris Partners (RAMP) seeks to assist families currently held in Middle Eastern refugee camps to transition to productive lives of dignity, safety, and hope in the Morris County area of New Jersey. RAMP provides a full range of core support services to assist the refugee families. These services include: welcome procedures; community orientation; finding employment opportunities; identifying appropriate social services; educational assistance (schools and English language instruction); transportation; and medical care. Services also include raising, managing and judiciously distributing funds, and finding and furnishing suitable living arrangements.

independence for each of the resettled families. Opportunities abound to be involved with helping these families!

BILINGUAL SUMMER CAMP

Each summer, for six weeks, St. Peter's is home to Bilingual Vacation Bible School. This camp serves as many as 80 children on any given day. Activities each day include a music class, sports, computer time, cooking, puzzles, games, and field trips. This past summer included field trips to Sunrise Lake, a water park, and a Somerset Patriots game. Our camp program depends on the help of many volunteers.
