



## REGISTRATION PACKAGE

### REGISTRATION AND ELIGIBILITY

The competition will include a total of twelve teams of two carvers. Carving teams will be selected by the Inspired Ice Selections Jury from applications received by the deadline. Space will be reserved for northern, Canadian and international teams.

Applications must be received by the Co-ordinator by Friday, February 13th, 2015 at 17:00 (5 pm) MT.

Applications may be submitted by regular mail or email.

Applications must include:

- completed registration form
- sketch of the design on letter size (8.5" x 11") paper
- artists' biography, including ice carving experience and previous competitions and exhibitions
- photos of previous ice sculptures
- portfolios of other artistic works

Participants must be at least 18 years of age. Participants will be selected by the Inspired Ice Selection Jury based on relevant carving experience, and originality of design.

Notice of selected teams will be made by the Inspired Ice Selection Jury on Monday Feb. 16th, 2013 by 17:00 MT.

### DIMENSIONS AND CARVING SPACE

Teams:

12 teams will be selected by the Inspired Ice Selection Jury. Space will be reserved for northern, Canadian, and international teams

Ice Block Dimensions:  
8' H x 4' W x 3' D (approx)

Allotted Carving time:  
28 hours

Carving area:  
7.6 m x 7.6m (25 feet x 25 feet)

Natural "Crystal Blue Aurora" ice blocks will be harvested from Great Slave Lake.

Carvers will supply their own carving tools.

Long John Jamboree will supply each team with water, AC power, stepladders, scaffolding and tool tables. Some support for lifting ice will be available on Day One.

Long John Jamboree will provide lighting and clearance of debris from the carving area.

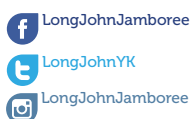

## JUDGING

Ice sculptures will be judged by a panel of three judges selected by the Long John Jamboree, the National Ice Carving Association (NICA) and the sponsor of the competition, De Beers Canada.

The judging will be based on NICA criteria. Sculptures must remain standing throughout the judging process in order to qualify.

The judging will take place from 15:00 to 17:00 on Saturday, March 28th, 2015.

First Impression 10 points

Technical Skill and Difficulty 50 points

- Use of Ice – 10
- Technical Skill – 10
- Attention to detail – 15
- Finished Appearance – 15

Design and Composition 20 points

- Proportion or symmetry – 10
- Design and composition – 10

Creativity 10 points

Artistic Impression 10 points

TOTAL 100 points

Judges will determine the prizes based on the criteria above. In addition to the first, second and third prizes selected by the judging panel, there will be a Carvers’

Choice award voted on by the participating artists, a Media

Choice award voted on by media, and a public choice award voted on by the public.

The Long John Jamboree will assist out-of-town participants with:

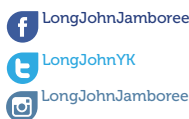
- a travel stipend; and

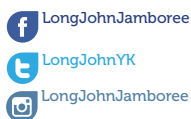

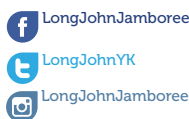
