October Board Round-Up

The Potterville Public School Board of Education met Monday, Oct.17, to recognize and discuss various topics, including but not limited to, public input on concerns from teachers in the district, the recent hiring of an interim Student Support Center Director and a presentation on the 2015-2016 audit report. Tim Donahue, Superintendent at PPS, brought the meeting to a close by updating the Board on current legislation in process of being finalized, discussed the renewal of the sinking fund and discussed his hopes for a successful Fall Homecoming.

- Cindy Scott, auditing manager at Stephenson Gracik, went over the District's audit results for the 2015-2016 school year. Our audit was unmodified, meaning the District received the highest level of assurance. The ending fund balance for unassigned general funds was 2.93 percent; close to a half percent decrease from last year's ending unassigned fund balance.
- Mr. Donahue closed the meeting by discussing with the Board renewing the sinking fund with the District's first installment of the monthly *Money Matters Memo*. The memo details the District's expenses and revenues. The sinking fund millage has reduced from 5 mills to 3.5 mills.
