January Board Round-Up

On January 16, 2017 the Potterville Board of Education met and selected its officers. Stacy Sipes was nominated and approved as Board President with seven votes in favor and none opposed. Bill Scott was nominated for the roll of Board Vice President and was approved with seven votes in favor and none opposed. Amy McDowell was nominated for the roll of Board Treasurer and was approved with seven votes in favor and none opposed. Lastly Loren Smalley Jr. was nominated for the roll of Board Secretary and was approved with seven votes in favor and none opposed.

Next the board discussed its consent agenda and reviewed the minutes of its previous two meetings. After discussion the board decided to hold December 19th minutes for further review. Board Secretary Smalley had questions about payments made to multiple vendors and requested that these payments be held until further review from the board.

NEOLA Policy was brought up as a part of the meeting agenda and Vice President Scott requested discussion of the policy updates. The board then moved to move these policies to their next meeting in February so they could be further examined.

The board then had two resolutions for action during this meeting.
