### **February Board Round-Up**

On February 21st, 2017 the Potterville Board of Education met to recognize and discuss various topics, including but not limited to, Potterville Middle School becoming a Reward School for the State of Michigan, they received a presentation on district budgeting and purchasing processes and discussed the schools calendar.

The board also discussed its consent agenda and reviewed minutes from the last two meetings. The agenda included approval of payment disbursement, a personnel action report, and the hiring of a physical education teacher.

NEOLA Policy was brought up as a part of the meeting agenda and a motion to approve the board policies failed. The board then moved to move these policies to their next meeting on March 1<sup>st</sup> so they could be further examined.

The board also heard a report from Superintendent Donahue on a bus incident that occurred on January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017. The parent of the student in this matter spoke to the board at the recent work session of 2-1-17. He reviewed key points of the report, a copy of which has been entered into the record for this meeting. Mr. Donahue also shared details about a Region VI legislative breakfast that is happening in April as well as details of a pending office and conference room renovation.
