March Board Round-Up

On March 20, 2017 the Potterville Board of Education met to receive training on MASB's Superintendent Evaluation tool. Mr. Jay Bennett, a consultant for MASB, is present and is helping guide the board through the steps they will need to take while evaluating Superintendent Donahue.

Mr. Bennett explains that the tool is a growth based model which is intended to help the superintendent grow within the district. Bennet recommends creating goals for the district that take into account the opinions of the community, teachers, parents and students. Mr. Bennet also spoke with board members about reaching a consensus on designating an individual evaluation score. It should not be an averaging of each board members input but rather a reflection of the majority of board members' scores. Mr. Bennett also touched on some details of how the evaluation meeting should be conducted and a timeline for when the evaluation should take place.

The consent agenda of this meeting included review of minutes from the previous two meetings, approval of payment disbursement and a personnel action report.

The board had no resolutions for action during this meeting.
