

**Regular Transportation Services for the 2017-2018 School Year**

Parents and citizens may be aware that Pottersville Public Schools' transportation provider for the past several years terminated those services as of June 30, 2017. This was within the provider's rights per the amended contract between the provider and Pottersville Public Schools.

At a special meeting on June 28, 2017, the board of education authorized the interim superintendent to seek the services of another transportation provider beginning with the 2017-18 school year. To that end, I have been working with another provider in an effort to arrive at an acceptable contract for regular transportation services. We are still in negotiation.

At this time, I am unable to provide specific details about any aspect of regular transportation services for the 2017-18 school year. I wish to assure parents and community that once I have something specific to report, I will do so in a timely manner.

Providing safe, reliable, and predictable regular transportation services to families for the 2017-18 school year remains the highest priority for the board of education and for me.
