

# POSSIBLE WORLDS

## VOLUNTEER AND INTERNSHIP GUIDELINES

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- Volunteering at Possible Worlds is based on an arrangement that mutually benefits both parties.
- Volunteers will be assigned projects or tasks that assist Possible Worlds in implementing its mandate and allows the volunteer to gain experience and skills beneficial to their future career.
- Volunteers will be occasionally asked to assist in events, projects and tasks involving all aspects of the organization.
- Volunteers will be responsible for tracking their hours. They will be and allotted at \$25 shop credit for every 15 worked hours, upon request. Volunteers who have worked 50 hours are eligible for a complimentary [Premium Advocate Membership](#).
- Volunteer work includes no monetary compensation or other benefits or insurances.
- Volunteer work does not automatically lead towards a permanent position at Possible Worlds.
- Internships can be completed to acquire credits for coursework at universities, secondary and postsecondary institutions.
- Each intern is assigned a staff member who conducts an initial interview based on the volunteer's resume, and who acts as their mentor and supervisor during their work.
- If Possible Worlds feels the volunteer or intern can no longer complete projects or tasks as required, the work arrangement can be terminated, at any time, without recourse from the volunteer or intern.
