All express mail must be left with no acceptance signature required.

Incomplete or illegible forms, and those missing payment will be returned. Entries received before the opening day will be returned. All payments must be payable in U.S. funds. **DO NOT SEND CASH.**

Envelopes containing entries for more than ten dogs will be returned. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours after opening. NO FAX OR EMAIL ENTRIES ACCEPTED. Entry forms with email addresses will receive entry receipts. Entries without email addresses will receive only final confirmations after closing. If entry notification is desired a self addressed envelope or postcard must be included. GRKC is not responsible for mail or email that is not deliverable for any reason.

Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations **MUST** be received **in writing** prior to the August 26, 2016 closing date, be legible and include the AKC number, or no refund will be issued. Email changes are welcome. No telephone changes accepted

SITE INFORMATION:

Two rings (100' x 100' on grass) will be used. Both rings will be fenced on 4 sides, except gates. Shade is minimal, ample room for tenting. Limited crating **IS available indoors**. Greater Racine Kennel Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. No dogs may be left in the building overnight.

NO OVERNIGHT CAMPING ON THE GROUNDS.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs. **Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded.**

FOOD:

Food will be available at the trial site, proceeds to benefit Aussie Rescue.

MOVE-UP REGULATIONS:

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition provided written notice is given to the Trial Secretary, **no later than 6:00 p.m., Monday, Sept 5, 2016.** Day to day move ups received **before the close of the trial on Friday** will be accepted. Trial close will be considered to be the awarding of ribbons for the last class. Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. No verbal changes will be accepted.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or that have obtained AKC PAL/ILP number, AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved FSS breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

JUMP HEIGHT POLICY:

All dogs must have an AKC Jump Height Card or be measured prior to running in any classes. It is the owner's responsibility to have the dog measured prior to running or awards may be cancelled. Please check the box on the entry form if your dog needs to be measured.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.

PRIZES AND AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place in each class and height division. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs receiving qualifying scores. A rosette will be given to all dogs finishing an agility title, or a MACH, PACH or PAX. Master Double Qualifier rosettes will also be awarded.

OBSTACLES:

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

The **safety** of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and of the AKC, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

It is expressly understood that owners and exhibitors are solely responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. There will be no refund of any fees. Greater Racine Kennel Club and its agents, members etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Entry fees for bitches that come into season or injured dogs after the closing date will be refunded if a veterinarian certificate (on appropriate letterhead) is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging.

All dogs must be on leash except when in the ring or at the designated warm-up area.

NOTE:

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.

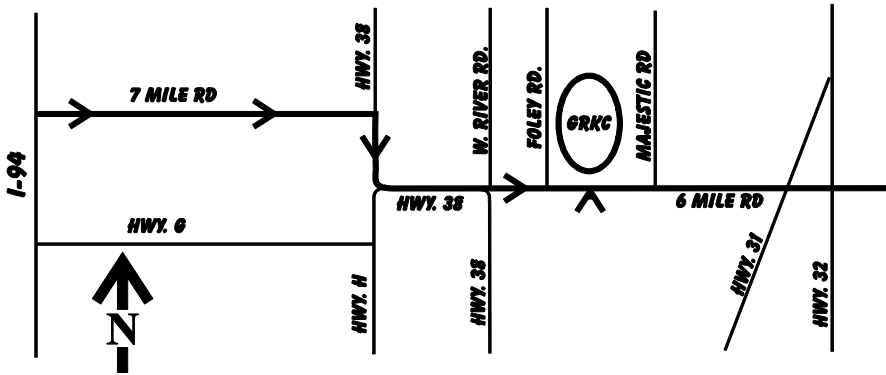

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
