Both positions require the faculty to develop an innovative clinical practice that provides patient-centered care within an interprofessional setting.

Applicants should have a Pharm.D. degree from an accredited college of pharmacy; postgraduate training and clinical experience in an appropriate practice setting, with some didactic and experiential teaching, is preferred. Candidates must be licensed or eligible for licensure in California and demonstrate excellent written and oral communication skills, clinical skills and teaching skills.

Salary and rank will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Applicants should submit a letter of intent describing teaching and research activities/goals, curriculum vitae and three letters of references. Electronic submission of application materials is encouraged.
