



## CREATING NEW RITUALS

Amity Vineyards sits atop the Amity Hills in the Willamette Valley, the heart of Oregon Wine Country. The first vines were planted in 1971, and as a consequence, our Pinot Noir, Pinot Blanc, and Riesling are produced from some of the oldest vines in the state. Ryan Harms from Union Wine Company and his brother, Eric Harms, have brought new energy to the winery after purchasing it in 2014. Eric concentrates on the business side of things, allowing Ryan to focus solely on producing the wine.

The 2015 vintage started off with a mild winter which caused bud break to occur very early. The early warm temperatures continued, with flowering occurring in late May to early June in most of the state. Similar to 2014, the summer was warm and dry. As we approached what looked to be like an exceptionally early harvest, the weather cooled off as we entered into September and allowed the flavors to catch up with the escalating sugars. The harvest was bountiful and extremely high quality, with the resulting wines showing generous fruit, intense concentration, and great energy reminiscent of the vintage.
