



What Drugs Cause It?



* more likely to occur if exposure to 2 or more drugs*

Features




Management

Convulsions

- 1st line = **benzodiazepines** 4mg IV
- may require repeat dose of benzodiazepines
- 2nd line = barbiturates
 - ↳ **phenobarbital sodium** 10mg/kg. Max rate 100mg/min. Max dose 1g

Agitation and Delirium

- 1st line = **diazepam** (PO/IV) 0.1-0.3mg/kg
 - ↳ repeat dose IV can be given after 10-15 mins if patient remains agitated
- 2nd line = **Haloperidol** 5-10mg PO or 2-10mg IV
 - * CONTRAINDICATED IN PARKINSON'S DISEASE *
- severe cases - consider **chlorpromazine** 12.5-25mg IV



Hyperthermia

- temperature monitoring if >39°C via rectal probe
 - cooling methods → ice baths
 - internal/invasive
 - ice packs
 - mist + fan
 - may need intubation and paralysis
- DANTROLENE**
1mg/kg IV to max 10mg/kg → If muscular hyperactivity

Rhabdomyolysis

- when CK 5 times upper limit of normal
- commence IV fluids
- consider urine alkalinization
 - ↳ 225ml of 8.4% sodium bicarbonate over 1 hr
- consider haemofiltration
