
Initial Exposure

SIGNS + SYMPTOMS

-  Pharyngeal odema
-  Tongue swelling
-  Rash
-  Bronchospasm
- 
-  Hypotension
(systolic BP < 110)*
-  Tachycardia (HR > 90)*

TREATMENT

-  IM adrenaline
500 mcg 1:1000
-  IV chlorphenamine
10 mg
-  IV hydrocortisone
200 mg
-  High flow oxygen
