↔ Vineyard Notes ↔

The 2013 vintage was another wonderful year in the vineyards up and down California. An early and warm start to spring, plenty of sun throughout the summer, and a mid-August spike of heat provided the rare combination of high yields with high quality. The Mendocino fruit gives the wine its floral component while providing some backbone to boot. The Sonoma vineyards add the stone fruit component.

↔ Tasting Notes ↔

30% of the wine was aged in once and twice used French oak barrels. The high tone pear, fig and ripe peach nose give way to secondary aromas of toast, vanilla and citrus. Expansive flavors of pear, quince and citrus fan out across the palate with finishing notes of white peach and lime.
