and Chad Relief has completed seventeen
projects in aid of refugees from the CAR
living in seven camps in southern Chad.*

Because of the military coup in the Central African Republic and flooding at Yaroungou camp, twenty-three thousand refugees are living in facilities designed for 6,000 at UNHCR camps Belom I and II outside of the village of Maro in south Chad. On a visit in April, 2013 CRF personnel were told that the highest priority need at Belom was housing for the aged, blind, disabled, children without parents and households without men. Working with the Lutheran World Federation, CRF has funded the construction of 205 houses at Belom. Here is a picture of one of these houses and the family that lives in it.



This new influx of refugees also included disabled persons in need of wheelchair/tricycles if they were to be at all mobile. CRF has had a program of providing, maintaining and repairing such equipment since 2008. Here is a picture of refugees at Belom who received wheelchair/tricycles in September 2013.
