Course Taught in Japanese – Rev. Mutsumi Wondra

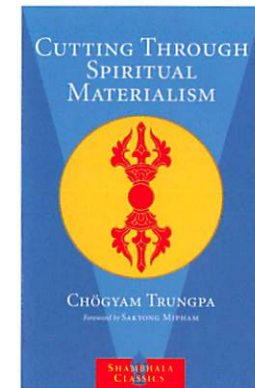
Saturday mornings, 9:00 – 11:00 a.m. January 14, 21, February 4, 11

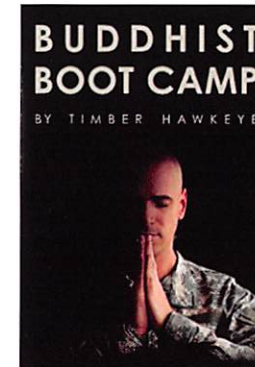

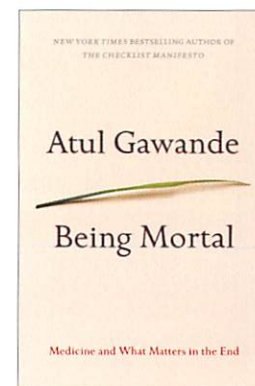
