### **Course Taught in Japanese** – Rev. Mutsumi Wondra

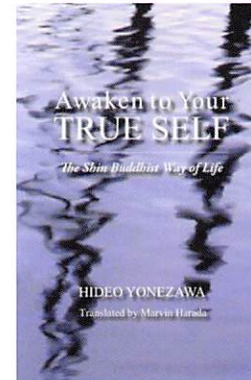

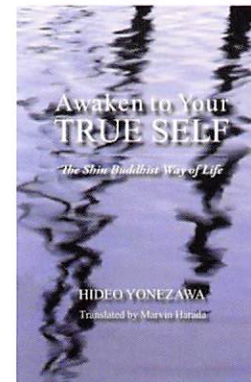

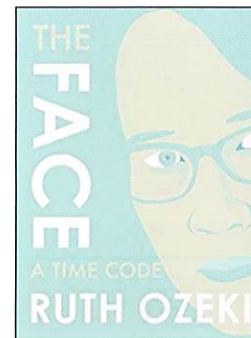
