Work will begin in May on the construction of a house that will become home to a single mom and her two young children. Habitat for Humanity ReStores are an integral part in supporting the construction efforts in Seminole County and Greater Apopka. After losing their current lease, the Habitat for Humanity ReStore in Apopka plans to close its doors on April 20th.
