Habitat for Humanity's Women Build Program recruits, educates and inspires women to build simple, decent and affordable homes in their community.

Poverty housing is a severe threat to children's health, growth and potential. It is a key component in the continuing cycle of poverty. According to the US Census Bureau, more than 12 million children, one out of every six, is living in poverty.

Women have the capability and determination to build Habitat for Humanity homes, addressing the problem of substandard housing in a concrete way, so that families have safe, decent and affordable homes.

Women Build is not about excluding men, it's about including women.

Nationwide, about 70% of all Habitat volunteers are women, but less than 20% of them are found on the construction site. The Women Build Program seeks to create an environment for women to learn construction skills and gain the confidence to make a difference in their own community.

More than 3500 homes have been built by Women Build crews around the world.

This year, Habitat for Humanity of Seminole County & Greater Apopka will participate in **National Women Build Week with a Build-a-Thon from May 2-9, 2015.** Women from all walks of life are invited to join us as women come together to sponsor and build a home for a single mom and her children in our community.
