Thirlmere is a Wilderness Property located 95km south-west of Sydney. The property consists of 5 acres of scenic forest nestled in the beautiful Thirlmere Lakes National Park. This property is owned by the Greater Sydney Conference of the Seventh-day Adventist Church.

Thirlmere is an ideal location for Pathfinder or youth group campouts and offers many great activities for campers to enjoy.

Getting to Thirlmere

- Follow the Hume Motorway (M31) south to Picton Road (B88).
- Continue on Picton Rd (B88) until you arrive at Prince Street.
- Turn into Prince Street, then left onto Argyle Street.
- Turn right at the roundabout and onto Thirlmere Way.
- Continue on Thirlmere Way, then turn right at the roundabout onto Oaks Street.
- Turn left at the next roundabout and head down Barbour Rd / West Parade
- Turn right into Thirlmere Lakes National Park and head down The W E Middleton Memorial Drive.
- Follow signs to the Conference campsite.

About the Campsite

- Pit toilets are present on site. Please bring your own toilet paper rolls and hand sanitizer.
- There are **NO SHOWERS.** Please bring your own solar shower if you desperately need one.
- There is **NO WATER** on site either. Please bring enough 2L bottles for Friday night, until Sunday after noon. ALSO think about bringing water for washing dishes or for showers etc.
- It can get really cold at Thirlmere in the winter time, please pack enough warm clothes.



- Maps of the area




