Everyone Belongs at the YMCA

All people are welcome to participate in Y programs and use Y facilities as members regardless of race, ability, religion, gender, national origin, sexual orientation or income. Whether for one day or for a lifetime, the Y wants to engage as many people as possible in youth development, healthy living and social responsibility. As a non-profit, 501(c)3 membership organization, the Y offers different avenues for member involvement. Y members have full access to Y facilities and programs appropriate to their age. If a program has a fee associated with it, Y members can often take advantage of a reduced fee due to financial hardship. Community members join the Y to participate in a particular program or activity. Community member fees include the fee for the program and a limited membership fee good only for the times and location of the program. Sustaining members make financial contributions to support the work of the Y, but do not receive access to Y programs or facilities in exchange for their contributions.

*Family / Household includes 2 adults, 25 years of age or older, and all children under 24 years of age, living in same household. An additional adult may be added to a Family / Household membership for \$23.00 per month.

**Joining Fees must be paid each time a member joins or rejoins.

Health Plan Memberships

The Y partners with several health insurance benefit programs including At Your Best, Health Alliance, Silver & Fit, United Health Care (Optum), Vitality, and Blue Cross Blue Shield of Minnesota and North Dakota. Check with your insurance to see if you qualify.

Short Term Memberships

- Youth (ages 0-12) Day Membership fee is \$3.00 / day.
- Young Adult (ages 13-24) Day Membership fee is \$6.00 / day.
- YMCA Adult Day Membership fee is \$12.00 / day. Up to three daily membership fees may be applied to a joining fee, if requested within thirty days of first daily membership.
- \$65.00 for thirty days (no limit on renewals)
- Short term members must register at the Membership Services Desk each visit and may be asked to provide photo identification.

If facility usage warrants, community members who wish to use only locker rooms and showers may be admitted between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm for a \$3.00 fee. Photo identification may be required.

Nationwide Membership

Many Ys participate in a Nationwide Membership. As a full paying member, bring your valid Y Membership ID Card along with photo ID to any Y that you may be visiting.

Financial Assistance

Thanks to generous donors, no child is ever denied YMCA participation because of inability to pay. Scholarship applications are available at Membership Services and at www.wenymca.org. Young adult scholarships are available through age 18. An Open Door Membership Program provides an opportunity for low income adults and families. Orientation information is available at Membership Services.

The Y's Facilities

Wenatchee Facility

Our full-service facility located on the corner of Chelan and Orondo avenues, offers an array of cardio equipment, circuit, functional and free weight fitness areas, a swimming pool, locker rooms, a gymnasium, group exercise area, climbing wall and three racquet-ball courts. The facility also features a babysitting area and a youth & teen center with a game room, fitness arcade and learning enrichment center.

Eastmont YMCA Aquatic Center

The Eastmont YMCA Aquatic Center (EYAC) is a public facility owned by Eastmont Metropolitan Parks District (EMPD) and operated by the Wenatchee Valley YMCA.

Access is FREE with your Y membership!

All Eastmont YMCA Aquatic Center programs are available to community members either through a class or an admission fee.

Community Member admission fees: Youth (0-12 years) \$3.00
Adult (13 and older) \$7.00

Adult EMPD Residents (13 and older) \$6.00

Adults must show government issued ID, showing EMPD residency to receive EMPD admission rate. EYAC is located at 980 3rd Street NE in East Wenatchee, 884-3113.

Lake Wenatchee YMCA Camp

The Camp was purchased in 1928 and sits on 26 acres on the north shore of Lake Wenatchee. This beautiful setting provides enrichment programs for children, adults and families in three seasons. Our Camp Lodge, Outdoor Education Center, seventeen cabins, several program support facilities and water recreation is the perfect place to build memories. Program Information

Current pool and group exercise information are available at the Membership Services Desks in Wenatchee and at the Eastmont YMCA Aquatic Center. Updated information is posted at www.wenymca.org and members may wish to receive special notifications on Facebook. Participants are urged to request assistance in determining programs and classes appropriate to their skill, interest, and availability as program and class fees are generally not transferable or refundable.

Guest Policy

Young Adult, Adult and Household memberships receive unlimited guest passes. Each guest you bring can visit us up to two times for free at the Y facility in Wenatchee. After two free visits, the guest will be encouraged to join the Y. Returning guests will have the option to continue to visit by paying a day membership fee. Guests will be asked to complete a guest form and present a government issued ID the first time visiting our facility. Check in at Membership Services is required each visit. Guests under the age of 16 require direct supervision from an adult family member. Members are responsible for their guests. To protect Y members and paying participants from overcrowding, guest passes may not be accepted at the Eastmont YMCA Aquatic Center (EYAC).
