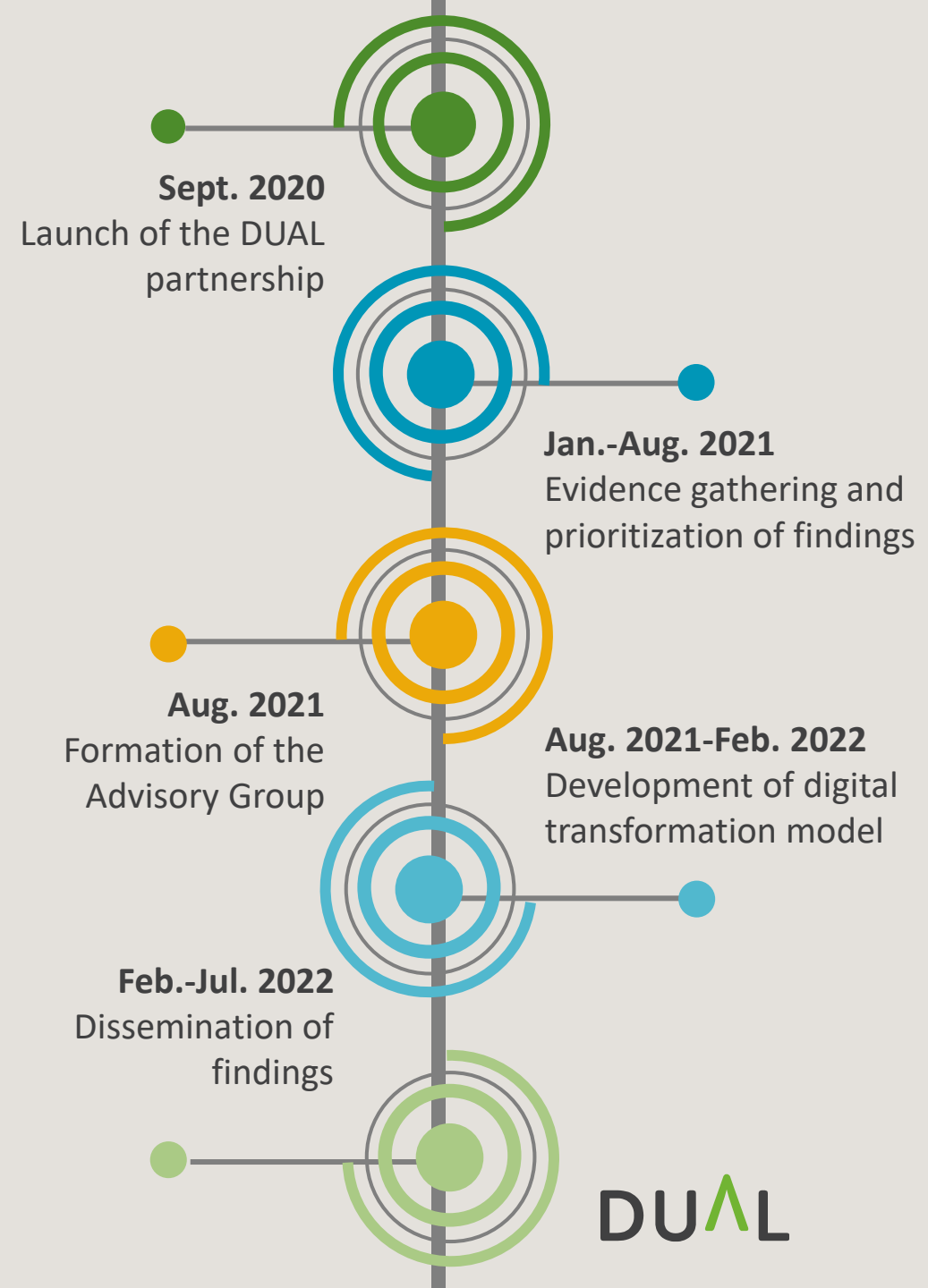
The challenge

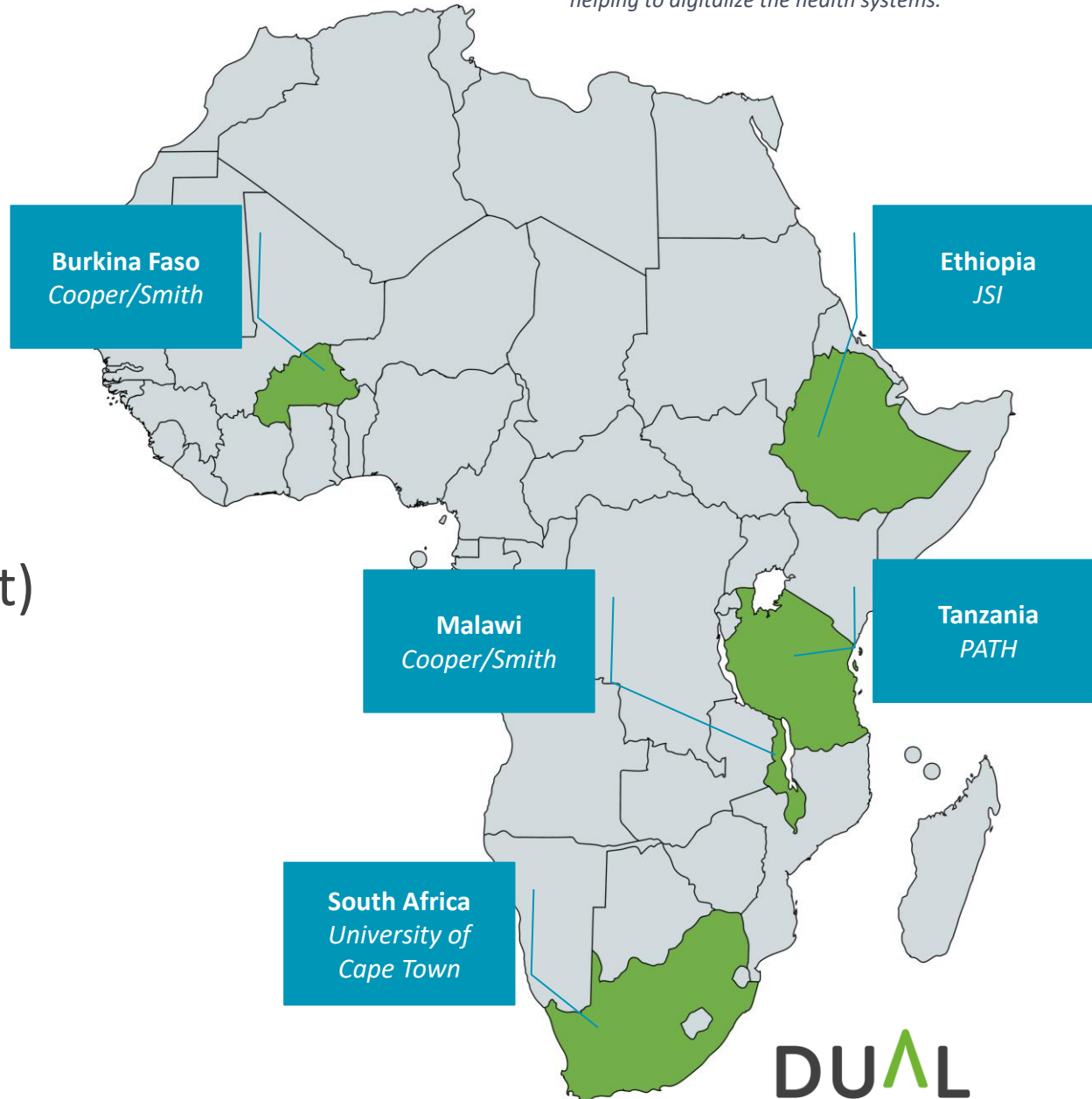
DUAL is amplifying learnings from five focal countries with support from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.

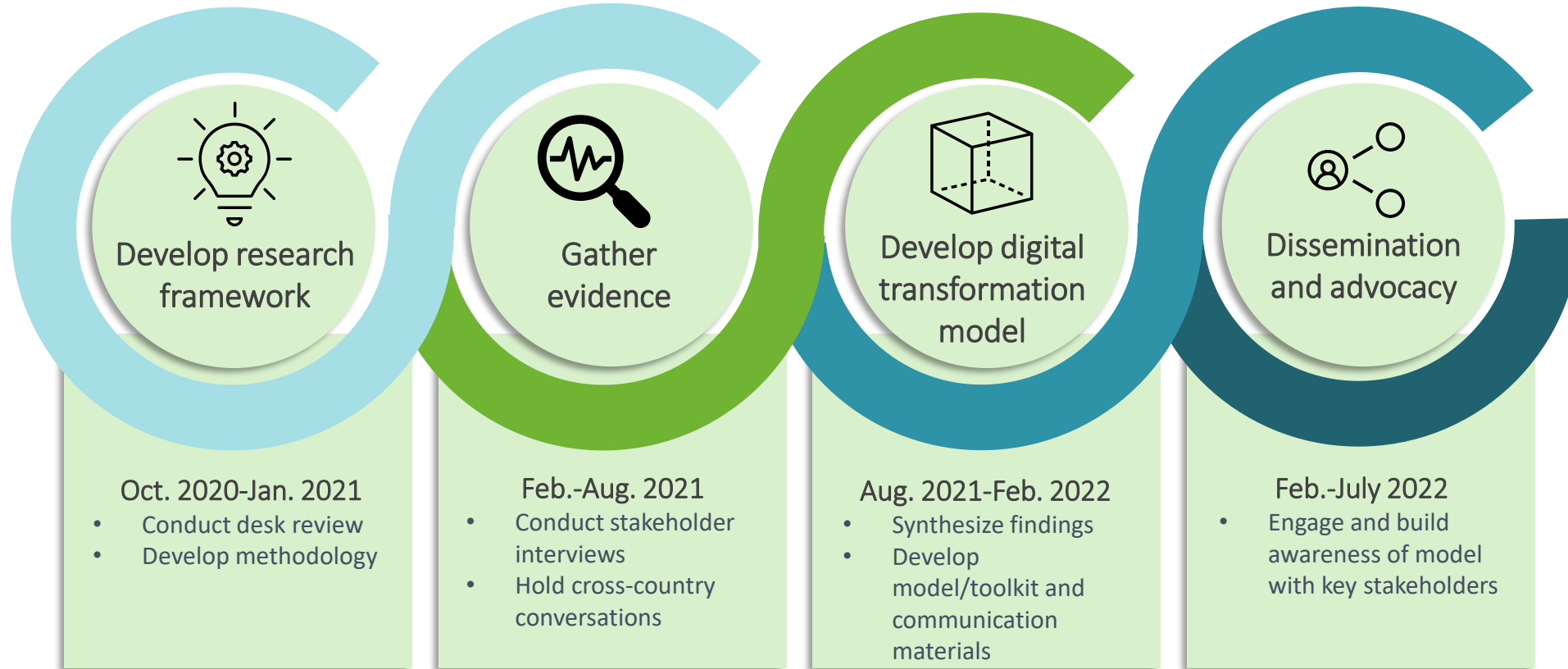


Map depicts 5 focal countries and the partners helping to digitalize the health systems.

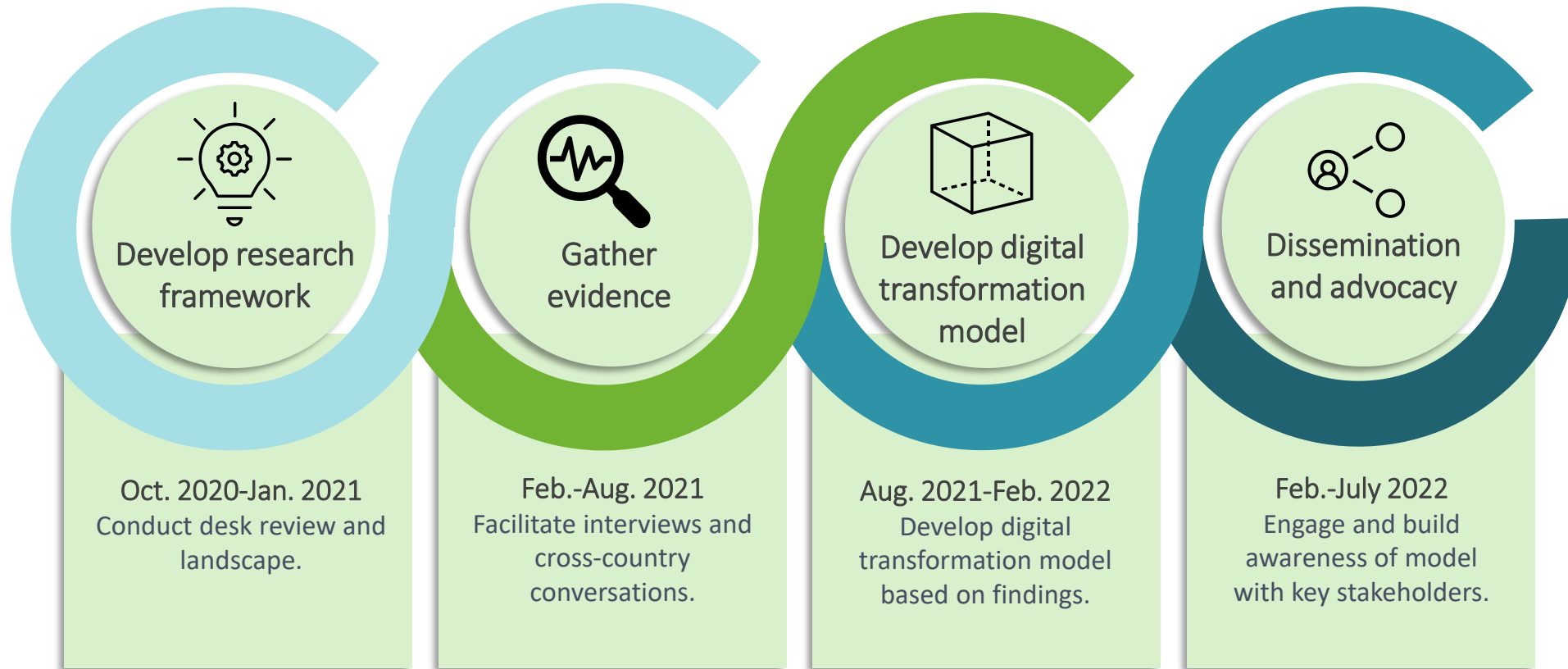
