

Getting Here

By plane

You can access the Caminos de Osa trails either by flying to Palmar Sur, near Sierpe (in order to start the Camino del Agua and the Camino del Oro) or you can fly to Puerto Jimenez (to start the Camino de la Selva and Osa Elemental). All flights leave directly from the Juan Santamaría International Airport in San José.

Car rental

How to get to Sierpe by car (5 hours approximately).

Take highway 27 to Puntarenas, then in the intersection take highway 34 along the coast to Tarcoles, until you arrive to Palmar Norte. When the road comes to a "T junction" take a right and you will go over a long bridge. First right after the bridge will take you to Sierpe.

How to get to Puerto Jiménez (6 hours approx.)

Take highway 27 to Puntarenas, then in the highway 34 interception take route 34 a long the coast to Tarcoles, until Palmar Norte. When the road comes to a "T junction" take a right and you will pass a long bridge. First right after the bridge will take you to Sierpe.

By bus

Travelling in regional buses is a cheap way to get to Osa.

If you want to get to Sierpe:

Take the Tracopa Bus from downtown San José to Palmar Norte and then a taxi 15 minutes to Sierpe.

If you want to get to Puerto Jiménez:

From downtown San José (12th street, ave 7-9) take the Blanco Lobo bus (leaves at 8:00am or 12:00md). Bus 612 to Golfito can also be taken, which takes about 8 hours and leaves at 7am and 3pm.
