Ultrasound Consent From

Ultrasound imaging is a noninvasive medical test that helps physicians diagnose and treat medical conditions. Ultrasound images are captured in real-time; they can show the structure of the body's internal organs, as well as blood flowing through vessels. The information gathered during the procedure may lead to the need for further diagnostics, such as:

- Needle aspirates, in which sterile needles are used to extract sample cells from an abnormal area for laboratory testing.
- Tissue biopsy, in which an instrument is used to remove a sample of tissue for laboratory testing (your pet may need to be monitored after this procedure to alleviate possible risks).
- Guided cystocentesis, in which urine is extracted from the bladder using a sterile needle.
