The sculptor wraps strips of Corten steel into circles of various sizes, then bolts them together into a highly permeable wall you can walk through or sit inside. The construction gives steel the friendliness of Jell-O, a sleight of hand reminiscent of Joel Shapiro's improbable ability to make a few wood posts look like a ballerina. The gallery has two examples, a dark rust wall inside and another slowly oxidizing to bright orange in the courtyard. Through Oct. 18; the outdoor sculpture will remain through Nov. 29.
