I first started going to the Crossing during a very difficult and confusing time in my life. My daughter was almost 2 months old, and I was in a very unhealthy abusive relationship with her father. At the time, I knew I needed a major change in my life, but I was so emotionally torn it was hard to see clearly what that change should be.

Talking with the volunteer counselors helped me realize my situation and what steps I should take to be safe. They referred me to the Domestic Violence Center and I began to make an exit plan. They offered to drive me there, but I had taken the bus to The Crossing and did not have a car seat for my daughter. As we were discussing options, a woman stopped in The Crossing to donate a car seat. It was at this moment that I knew God was involved and was letting me know that I was on the right path. I continue going to The

Crossing regularly for parenting education classes and support. The Crossing has helped me set healthy boundaries, and I am volunteering in their childcare area. I have my own apartment and will graduate from the UW with an Associates degree this summer. I am grateful for the guidance and help I receive at The Crossing.

When I first came to The Crossing I felt hopeless. Prison, drug addictions, rape, betrayal, and rejection are all a part of my past. I was raised in a good Christian home, but now as a single mother of three and struggling with the consequences of my past, I felt hopeless. When I met with a counselor at The Crossing, I was reminded that my value and worth to God was not reliant on my behavior, and that He loved me through it all. I began to hope again. I realized I am worth something. I look forward to coming every week to talk and learn. I watch parenting videos that are super helpful and I earn 'mommy money' to help provide for my family. I am recovering, and The Crossing is helping me to learn that coming just as I am is enough. THE CROSSING – *"I just love that place"*.

Comments from 7th and 8th graders after a two day session of Healthy Relationship Education:

- *"Thanks for coming to talk to our class...It got me to re-think about life and how having a child at a young age is super hard and expensive. Ps. You're a very strong person for doing the job you do."*

My mother went through something very similar with me, and it helps me so much to know that these things happen to people other than me. It also made me really stop to think as well. Everything you talked about touched me so much. So thank you again for coming today."*
- *"I really want to thank you so much for coming and talking about your teen pregnancy experience and what The Crossing is all about. You really opened my eyes about having a child especially when being a single parent."*

Donations received through our Walk for Life will:

1. Help provide training for volunteers to bring prevention education on healthy relationships into our area public and private schools beginning in 4th grade.
2. Provide our rural families with education and material needs.
3. Help us purchase character building programs assist our clients' growth toward wholeness and independence.
4. Help us move forward with a transitional living home for single pregnant mothers and mothers with young children.

Nationally 70% of babies born are born to single moms. Over 45% of babies born in Manitowoc County are born to single mothers, and that statistic is climbing. That's about 400 babies annually born to single mothers. Praise God that statistics show that children are more likely to succeed if they are raised in a home with a mother and a father. Statistics also indicate that the majority of single moms will unfortunately remain in poverty.

We feel compelled to respond to the needs of single moms, because most of us know how hard it is to raise a child with two parents; their children are our future. Therefore we are invested in educating, empowering and equipping students and families in Manitowoc County with the skills necessary to develop healthy relationships, build strong marriages, and create safe and stable families which for some will break the cycle of poverty and dysfunction and will strengthen our community.
