Notice of Race

The Wind Jam

Saturday August 26, 2017 , 12:00 pm first warning

- Eligibility :** The *Wind Jam Regatta* is designed for people who are new to sailing, our local youth/junior sailors, boats who are looking to practice, or any one who wants to enjoy a race in a laid back atmosphere. NOAH participants are highly encouraged to participate. Open to yachts with self-bailing cockpits, fixed berths, and the ability to be self righting. Windjammers strongly encourages compliance with [ORC 4 Regulations](#) and [USCG Regulations](#) for type and size of vessel.
- Rules :** Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017 - 2020, including the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association and the 2017 Eastern Connecticut Sailing Association Rules, as amended by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- Classes :** Classes will be determined by participation
- Courses & Racing Area :** Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions and chosen by the Race Committee depending on wind & weather conditions. Up to two races may be sailed and will be held in the vicinity of Charles Island, Milford, CT. The courses will be short enough so the marks will be visible from the start line in order to reduce any confusion.
- Sailing Instructions & Scratch Sheet :** Will be available in advance at the [W.S.C. website](#). Sailing instructions and Scratch Sheets will be available before the first warning on the day of the regatta, ashore at Milford Yacht Club dock office and Port Milford Marina dock shed and in the vicinity of the start.
- Scoring, Results & Trophies :** Races will be scored using a PHRF based "time-on-time" system. The Low Point Scoring System will be used to determine the places for boats in each class. Results will be posted during the post-race party and online on the W.S.C. website. Trophies will be presented at the W.S.C. Annual Awards dinner.
- Entry :** This event is FREE. Entry shall be made using the W.S.C. general entry form online and must be submitted by Friday August 25.
