The Wind Jam

Dates: Saturday, August 26, 2017

Description: The intent of this regatta is to provide casual racing that encourages newcomers and the less experienced to give racing a try. Sportsmanship and the **ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020** are in effect as modified with this notice. ***Be Nice ... Have Fun!***

Starting: The starting sequence is per rule 26 of the **ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020**.

Classes: There will be one class for this event.

12:00pm	Class 1 Warning	Numeral pennant 1	1 sound
12:01pm	Class 1 Preparatory	Numeral pennant 1 and Prep flag	1 sound
12:04pm	Class 1 One-Minute	Numeral pennant 1 Prep flag removed	1 long sound
12:05pm	Class 1 Start	Numeral pennant 1 removed	1 sound

Safety: It is the sole responsibility of each Yacht to decide whether or not to start or continue to race.

Start & Finish: Start will be on a line between the Windjammers Sailing Club burgee on the committee boat and a special mark (S) in the vicinity of Charles Island/ Milford Gulf. The race committee, along with the competitors, will decide on the number of races.

Course: The course is intended to be a triangle marked with inflatable drop marks. The race committee will hail each competitor either by voice, or vhf channel 72 if a government mark is to be used.
