Notice of Race

Organizing Authority: Windjammers Sailing Club in conjunction with the Eastern Connecticut Sailing Association.

Rules: Racing will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017 - 2020 (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association and the 2018 Eastern Connecticut Sailing Association Rules, as amended by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

Entries & Eligibility: Boats must have a valid 2018 ECSA PHRF certificate. Yachts must have self-bailing cockpits, fixed berths, and self-righting. Entries and payment deadline: must be received no later than by 5:00 pm on Wednesday September 19, 2018. Entries shall be made using the online entry form available on the Windjammers website www.windjammers.org or the ECSA Offshore Racing Entry Form available on the ECSA website www.ecsa.net.

Entry Fee: \$65 which includes entry for all crewmembers at the post race get together. Payment shall be submitted online at our website or mailed to Windjammers Sailing Club, P.O. Box 129, Milford, CT 06460-0129

Schedule: There will be no more than two (2) races with the first warning signal no earlier than 1200 hours.

Start / Finish: The racing area will be held in an area about 1 nm south of Charles Island. Milford, CT

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions and the scratch sheet will be available on our website no later than 24 hours before the first start. They may be available on the water from the Race Committee.

Classes: Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker classes will be determined by the Race Committee using ECSA PHRF ratings. One-Design classes of at least three (3) or more boats may request to be a separate class.

Courses & Marks: Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions; marks may be a combination of inflatable and government marks.

Scoring: Races will be scored using a PHRF based "time-on-time" system. The Low Point Scoring System will be used to determine the places for boats in each class.

Results & Prizes: Results will be posted as soon as possible following completion of racing on the Windjammers website and may be available at the post race party. Prizes will be awarded at the Windjammers Sailing Club (WSC) Banquet at the end of the season.

Party: There may be a party following the race. Details will be announced closer to the date, as well as posted on the Windjammers website.
