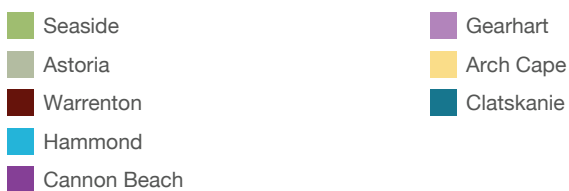
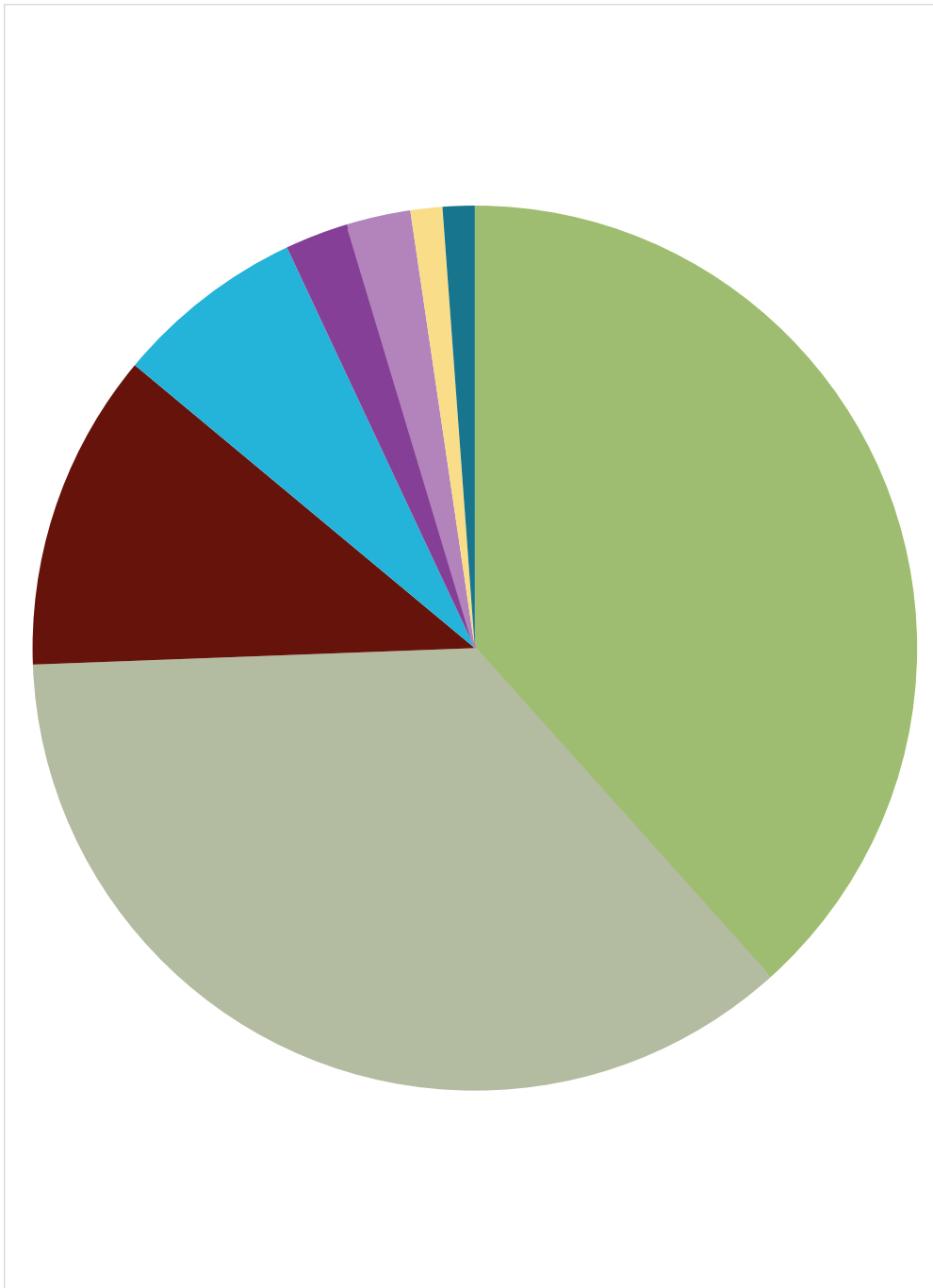

Percent of contacts by city



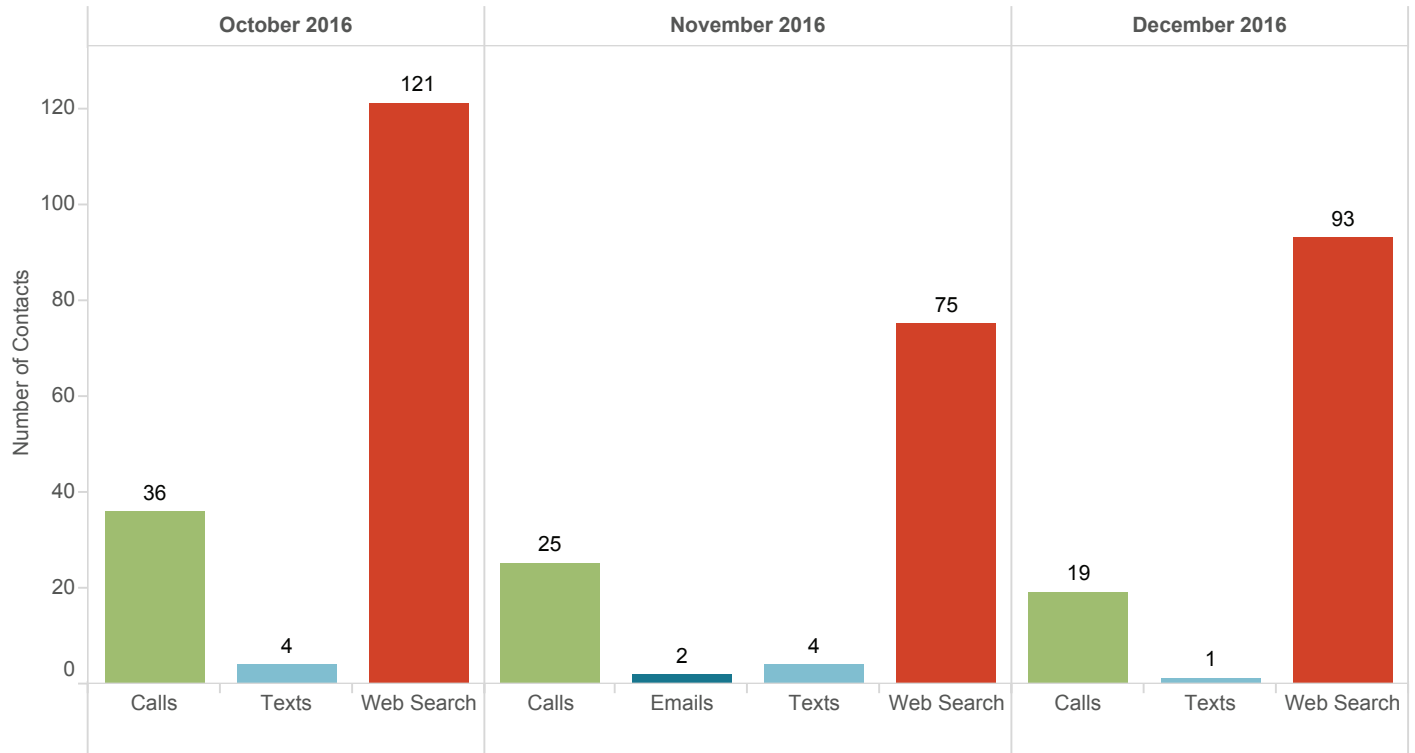

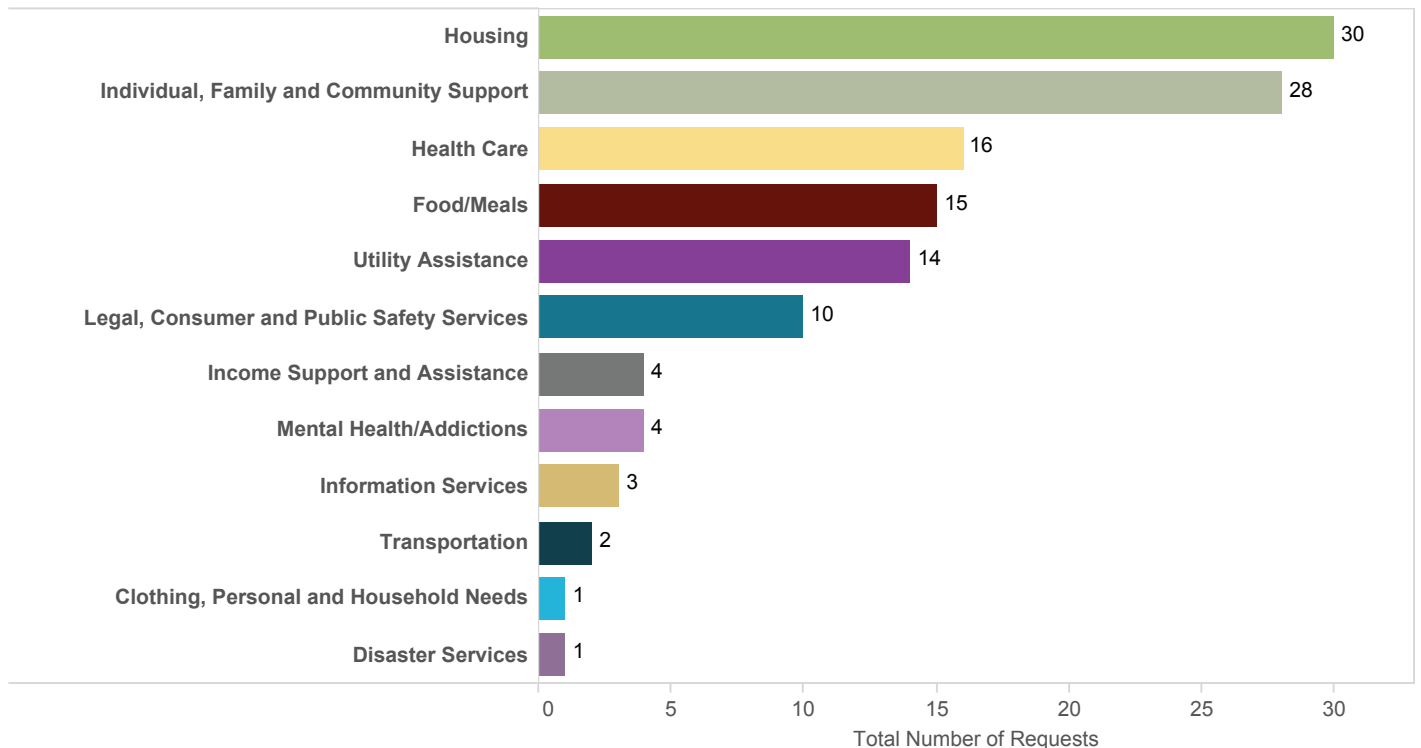

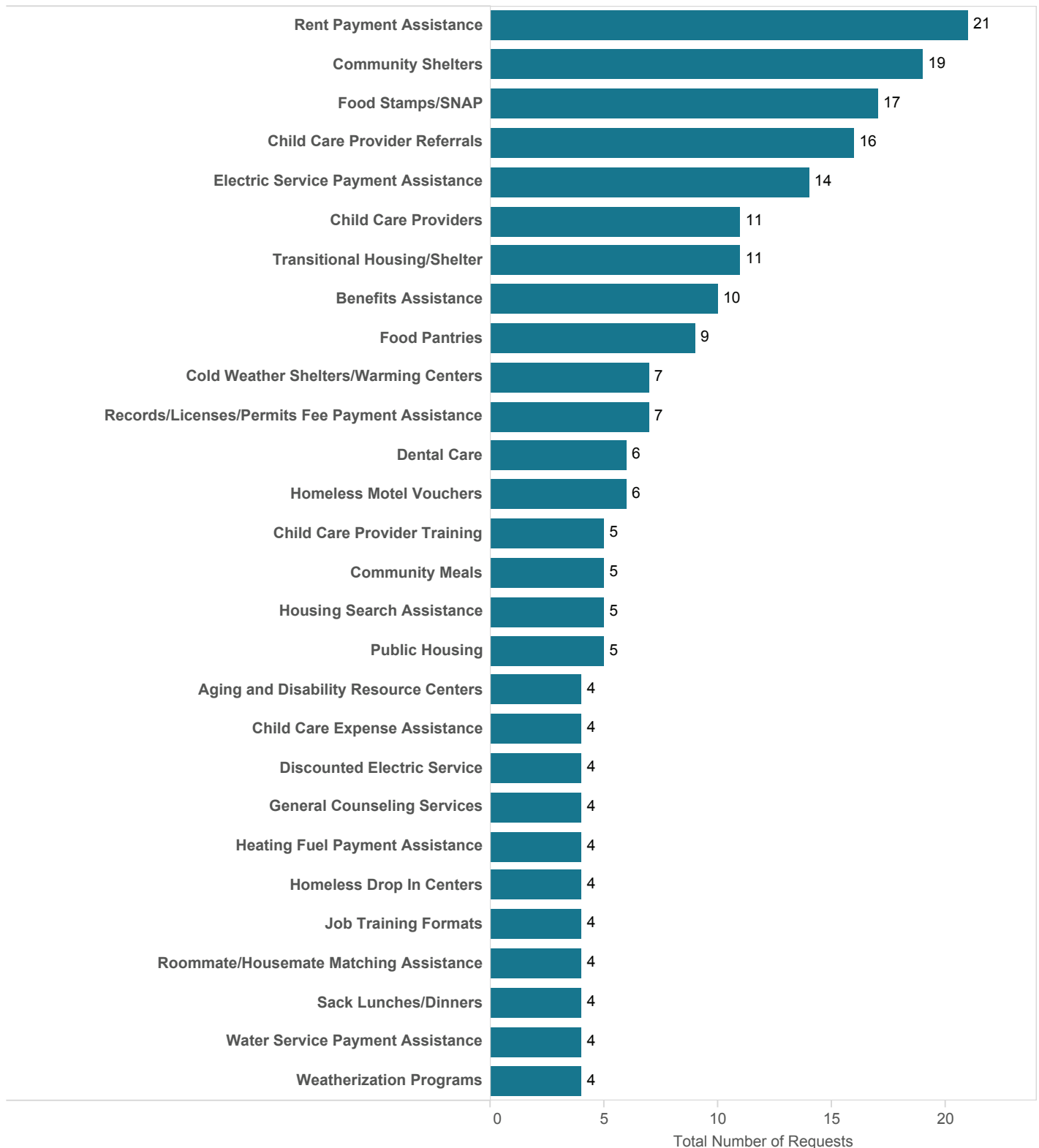
Number of contacts, grouped by month and contact type

Number of services with four or more requests across all contact types

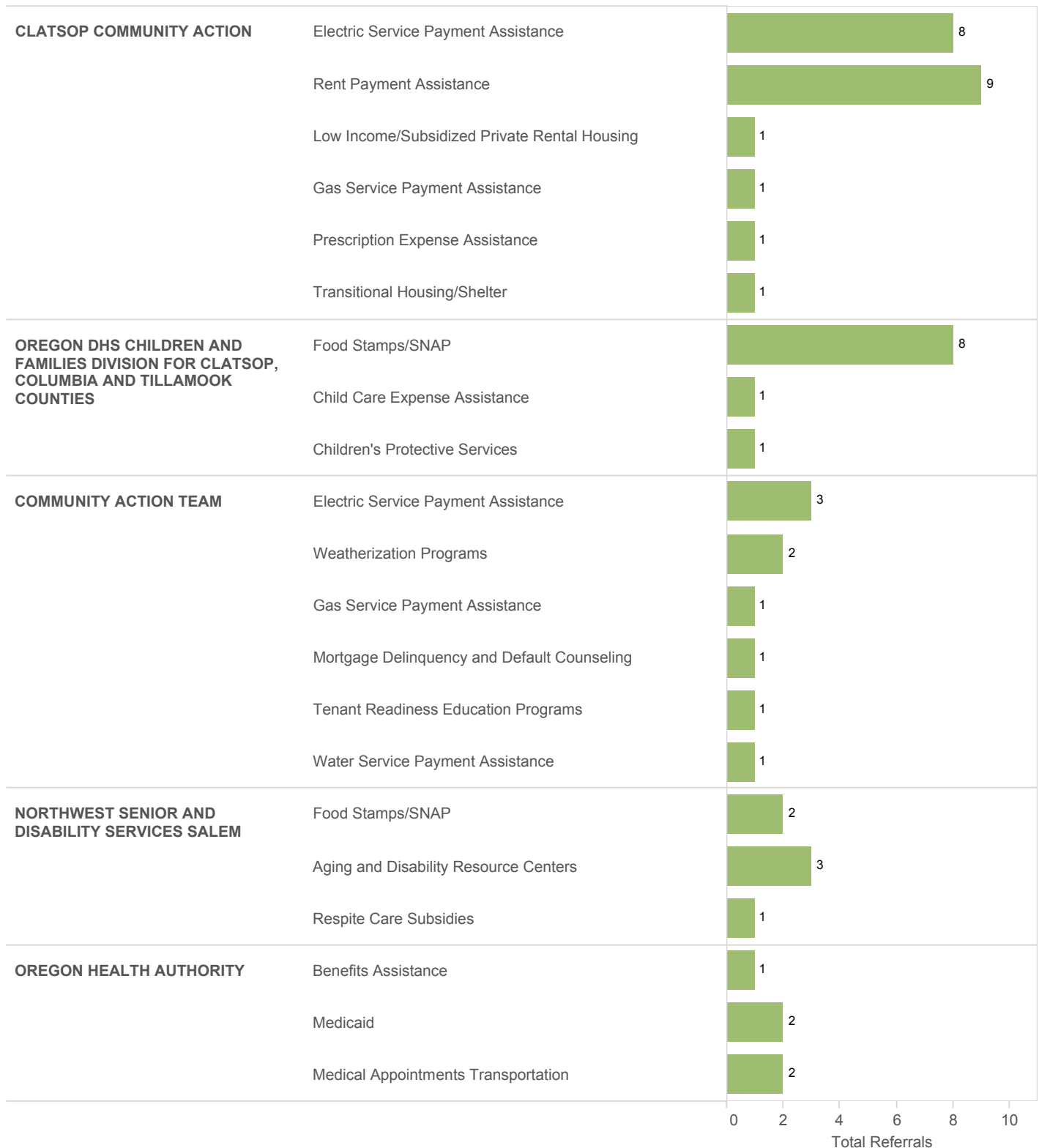

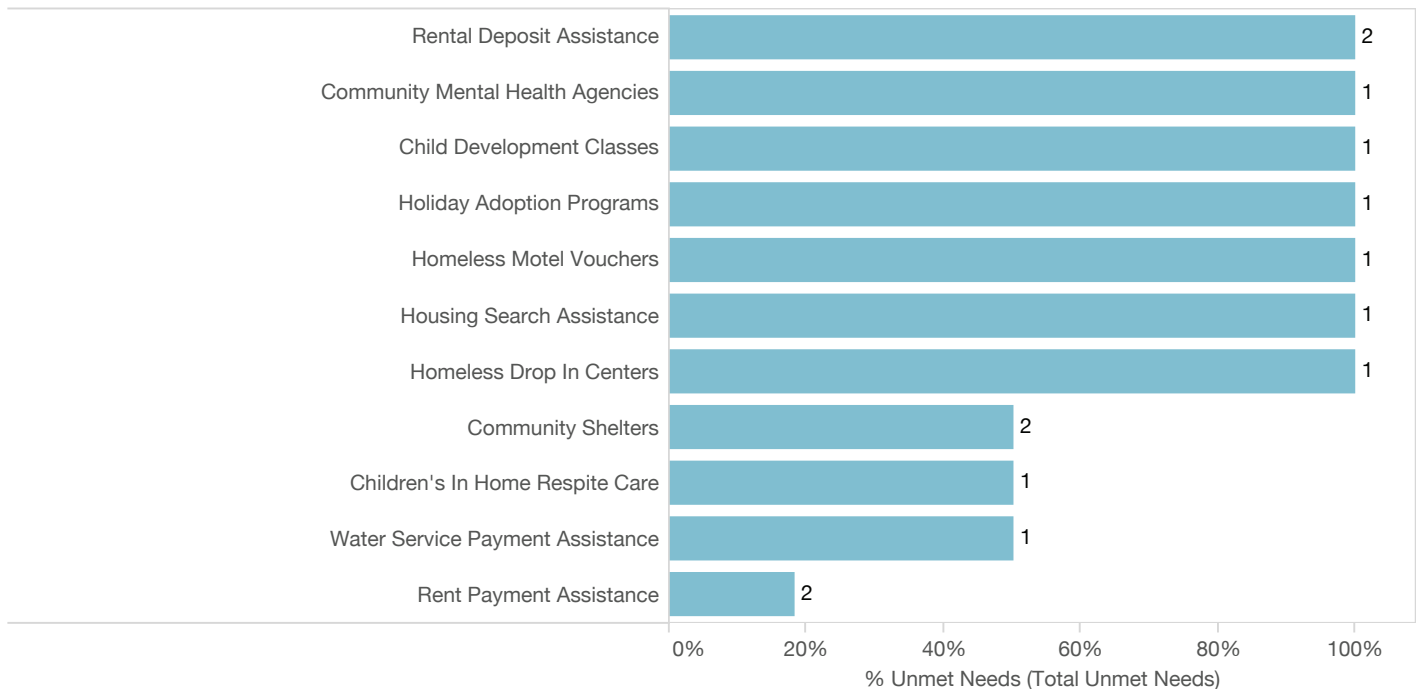
There were 14 instances where there wasn't an appropriate referral for the contact's requested need. Housing requests represent the largest number and proportion of unmet community needs.

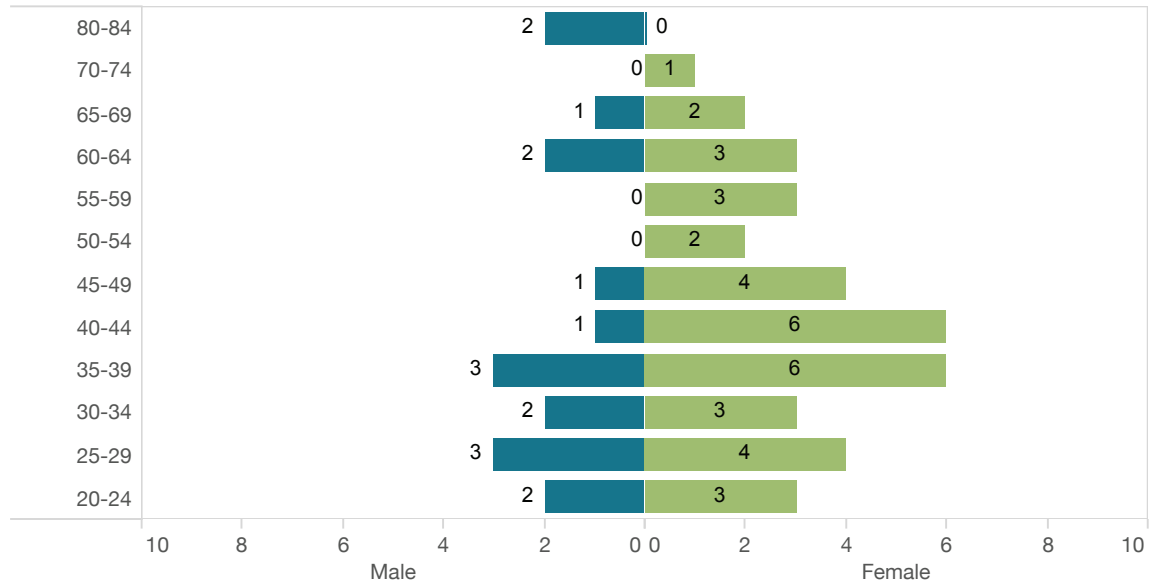

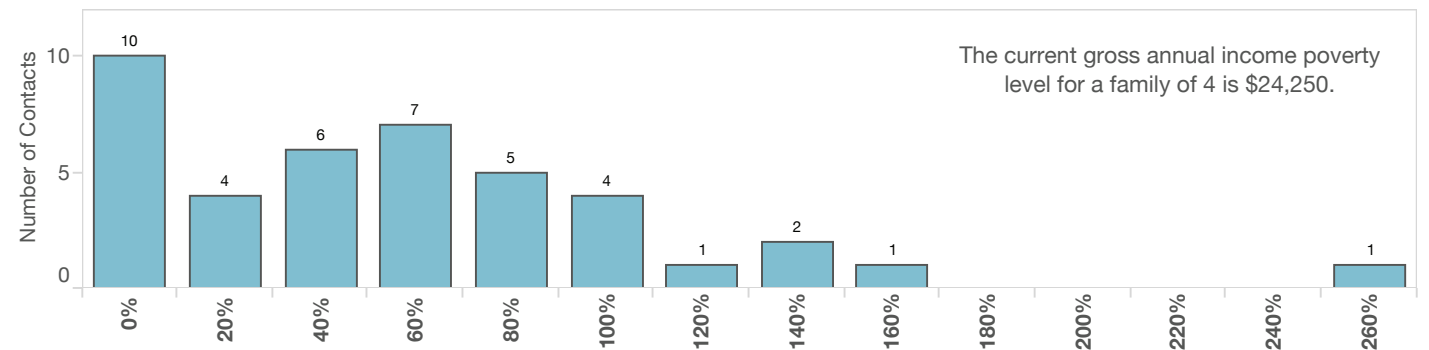

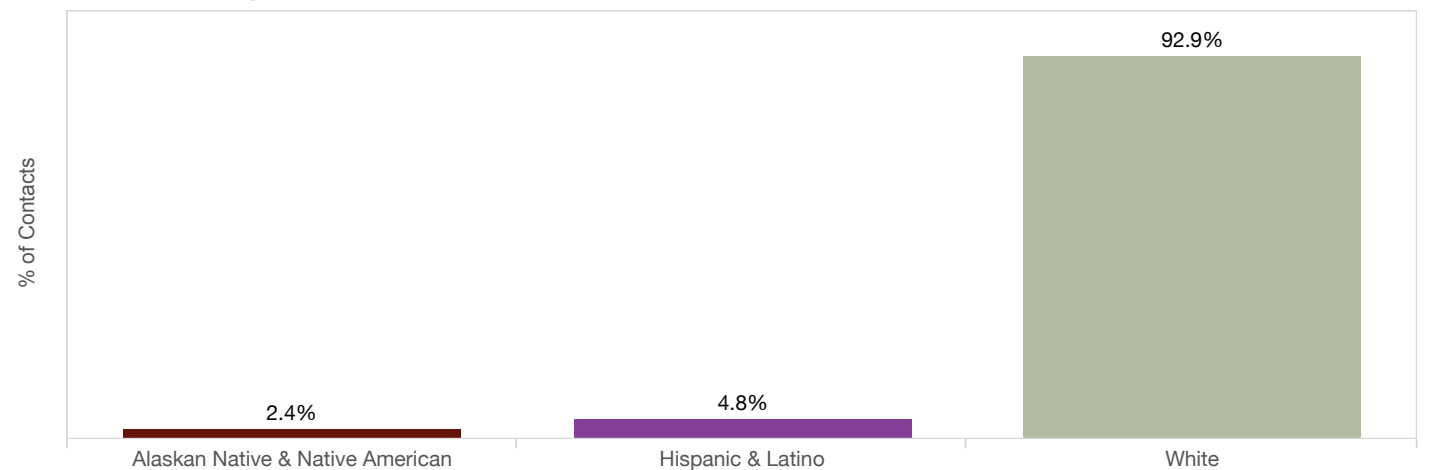
Age and gender

Race and ethnicity

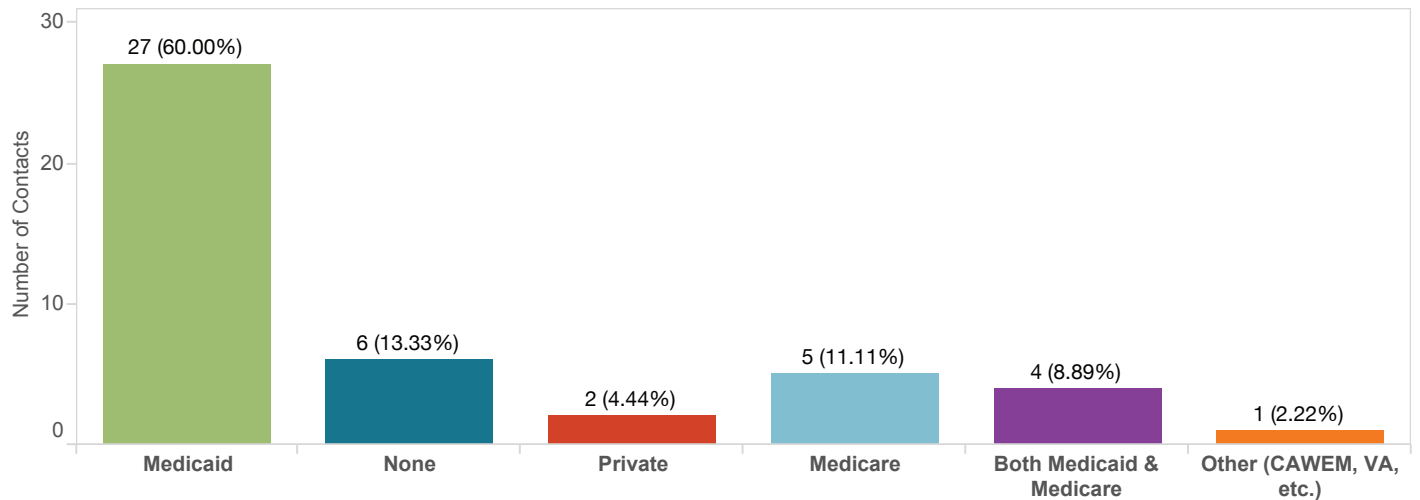

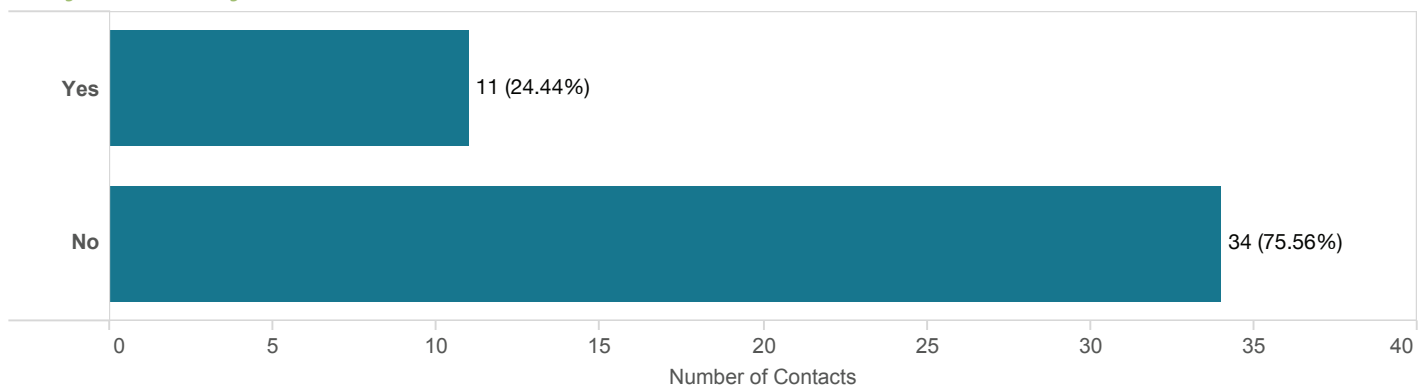

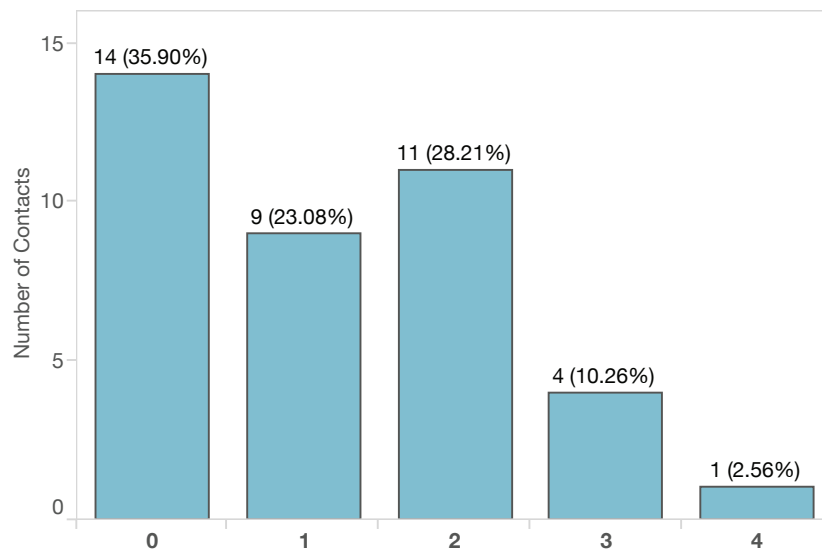
Health insurance status



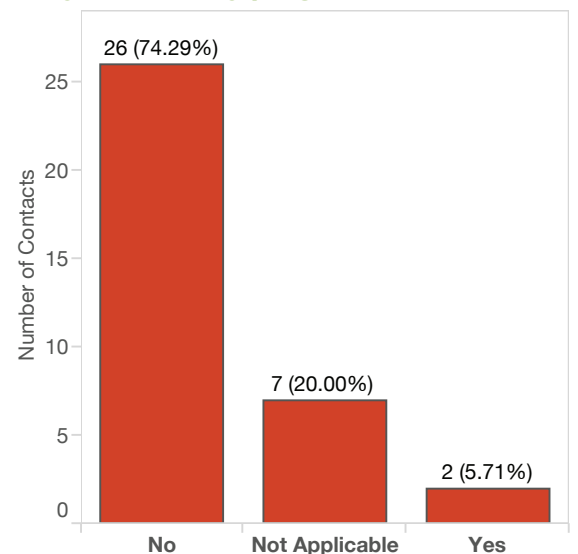
Are you currently homeless?
