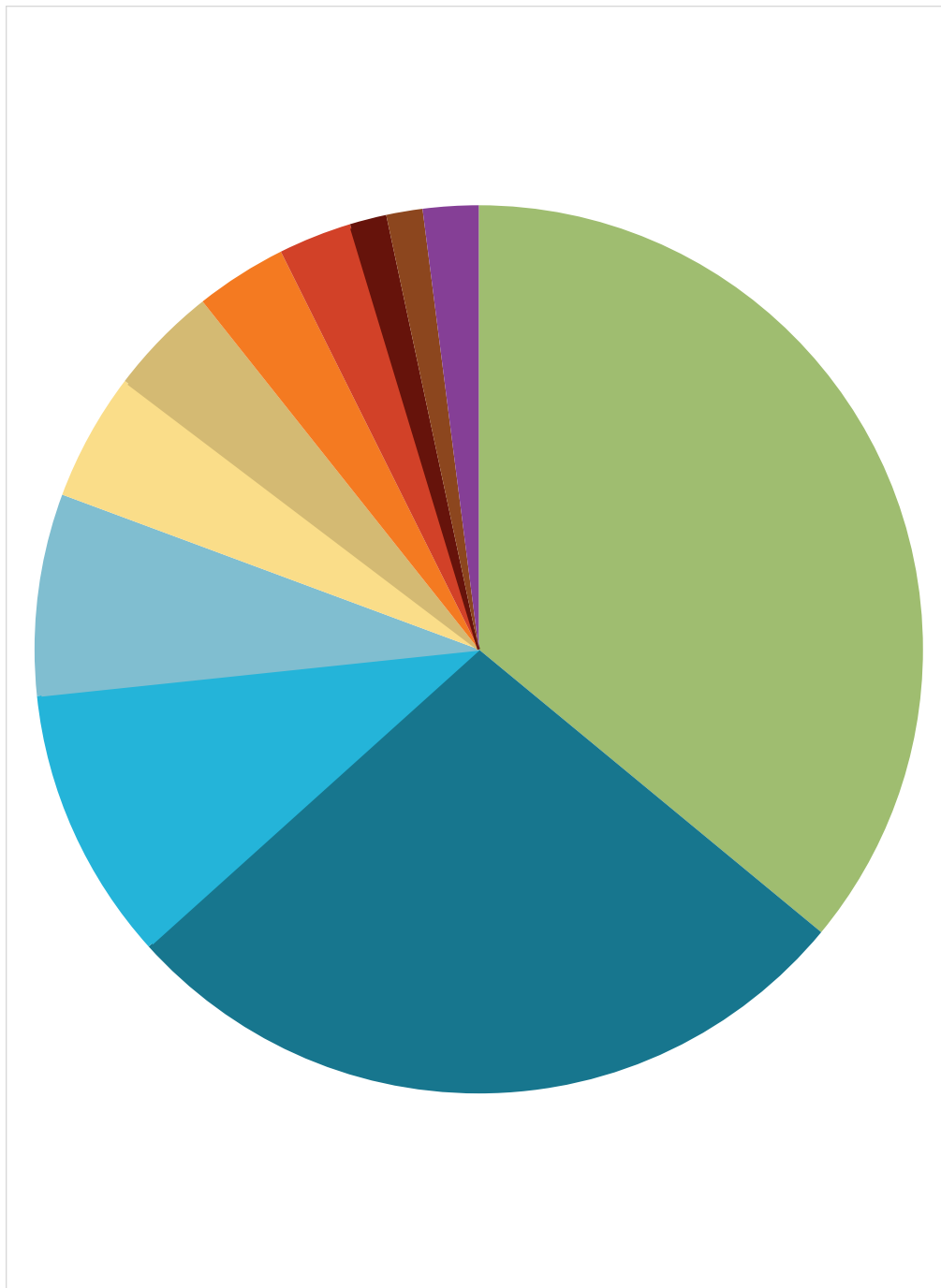

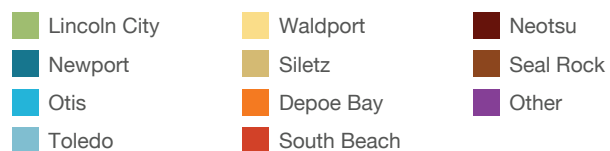

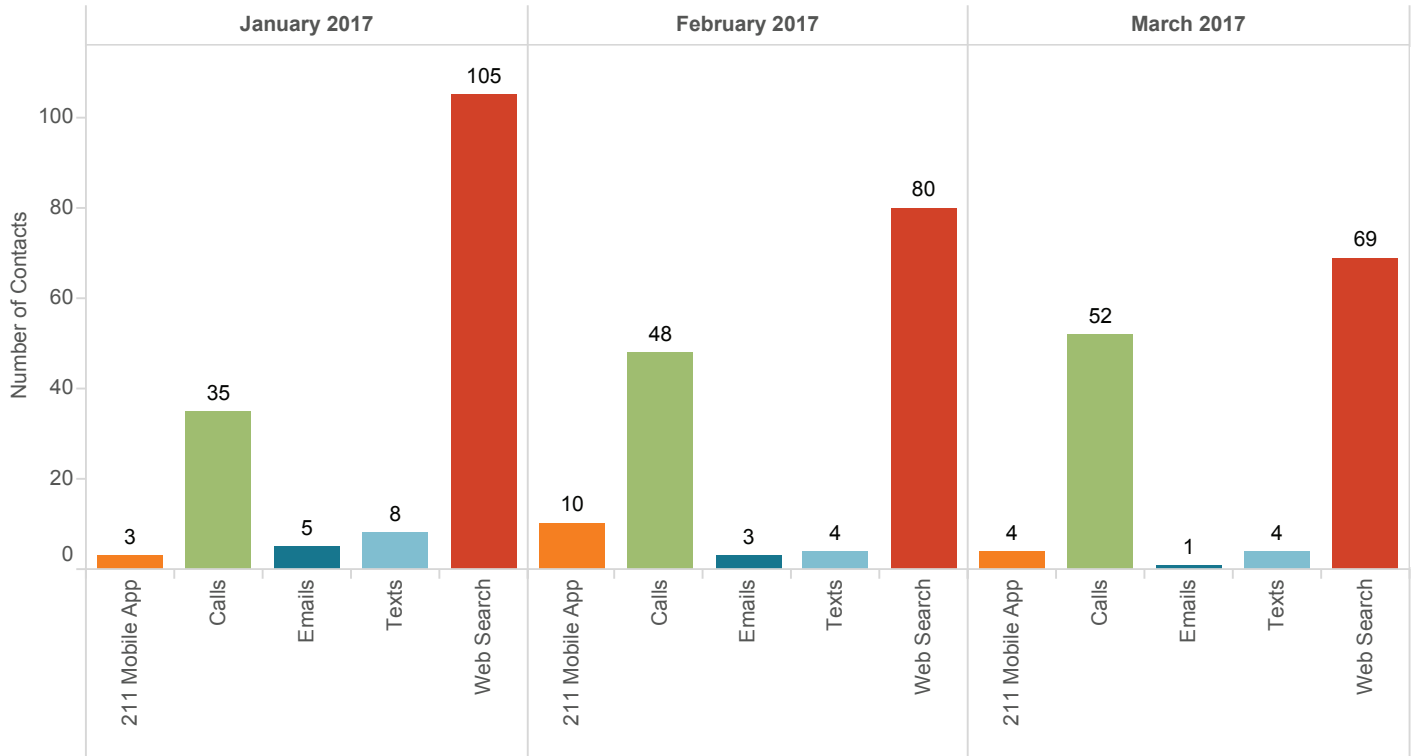

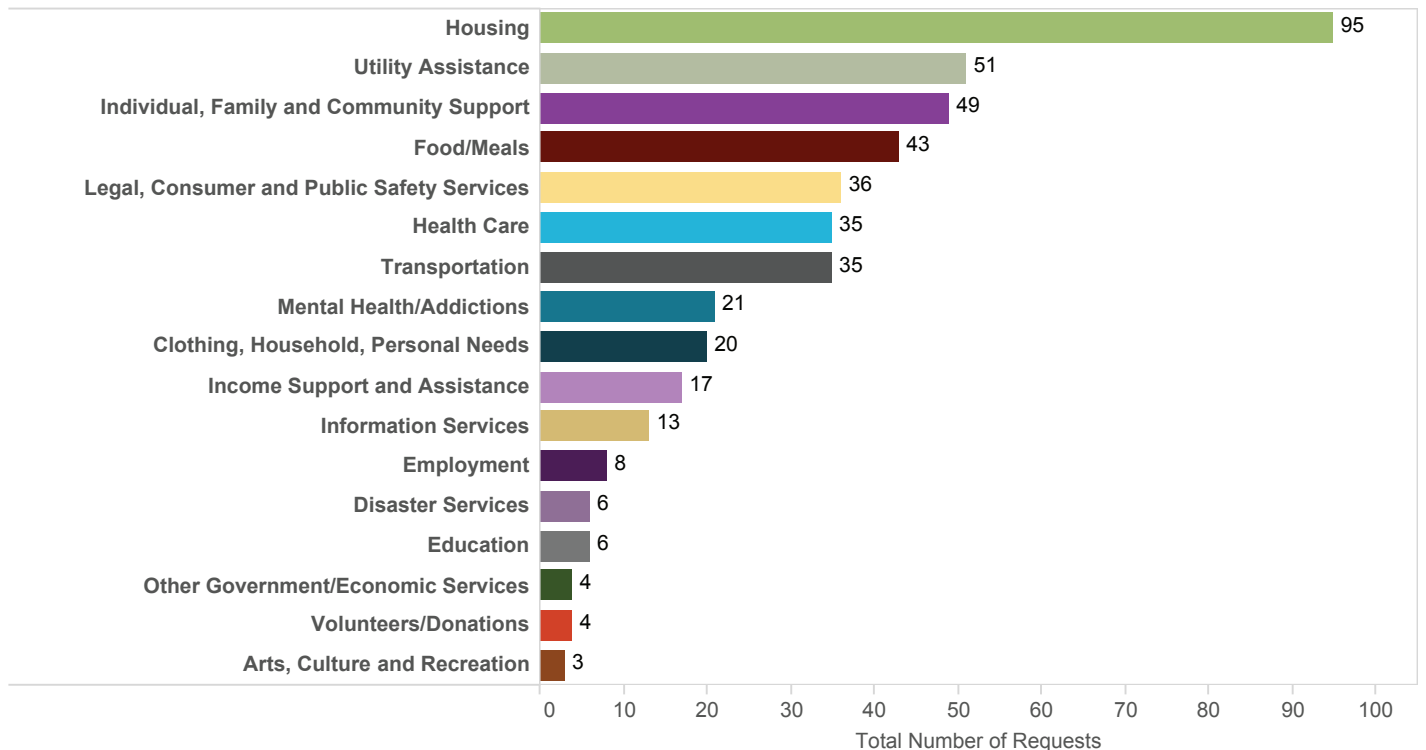

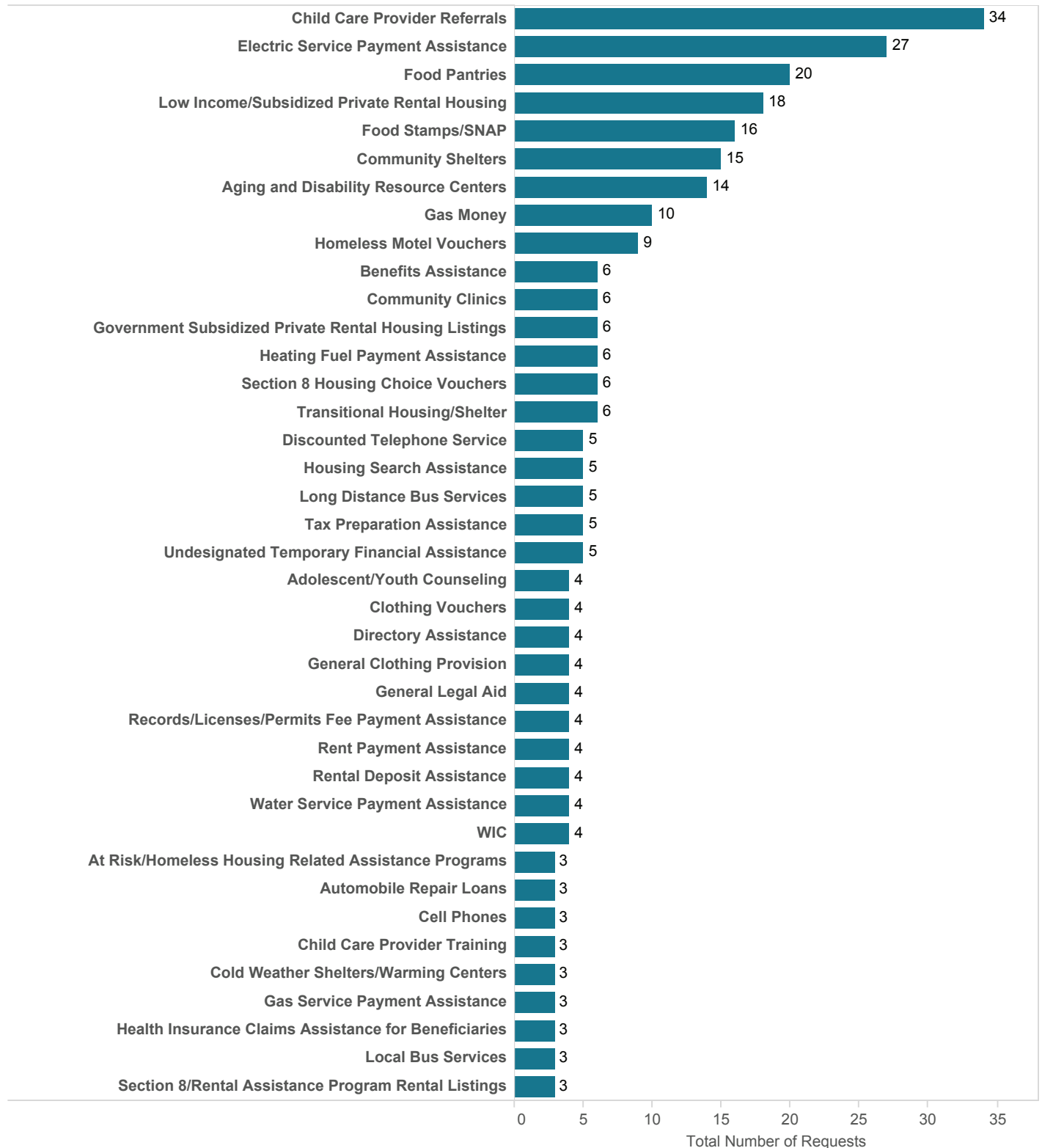
Number of contacts, grouped by month and contact type

Number of services with three or more requests across all contact types

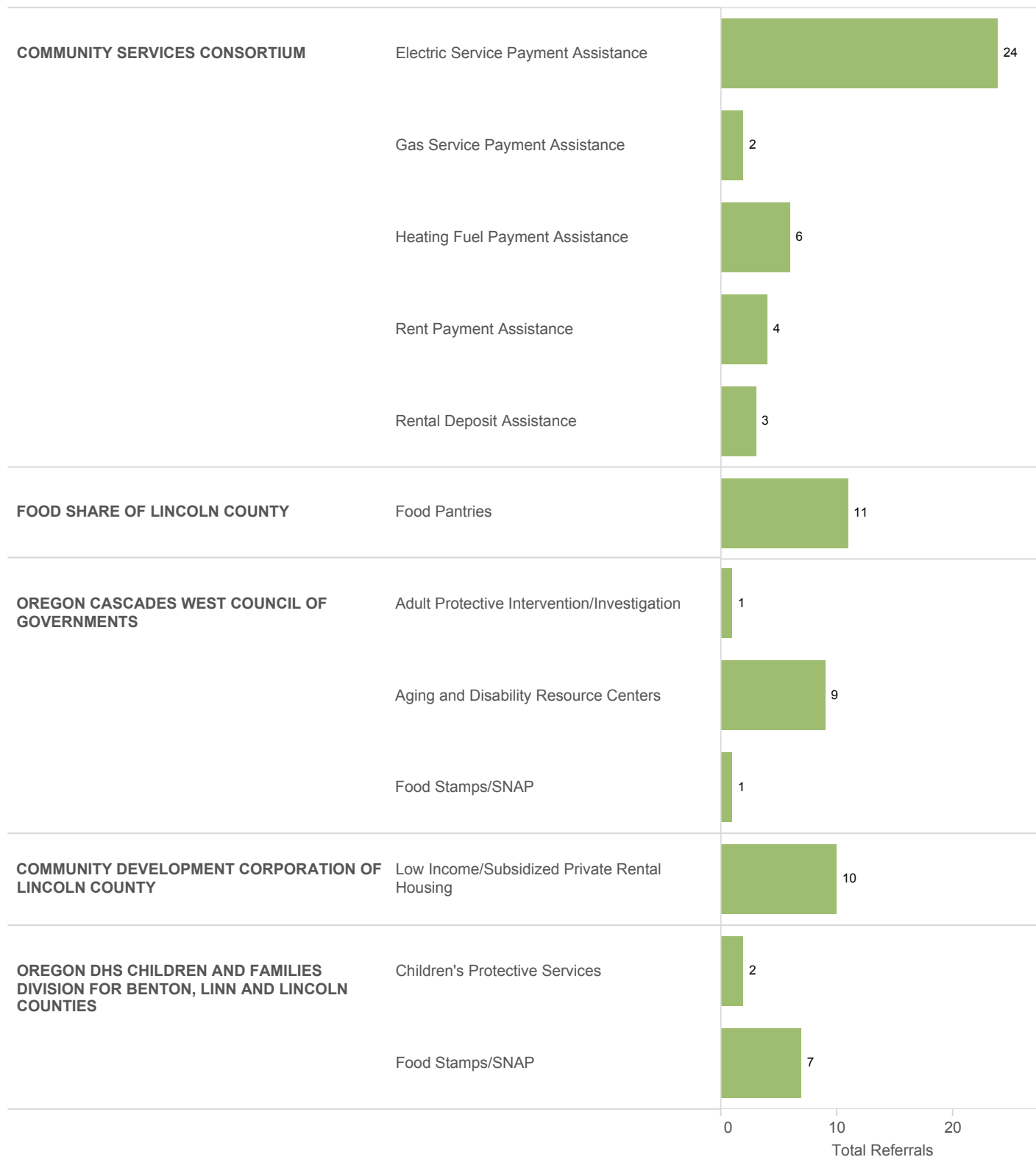

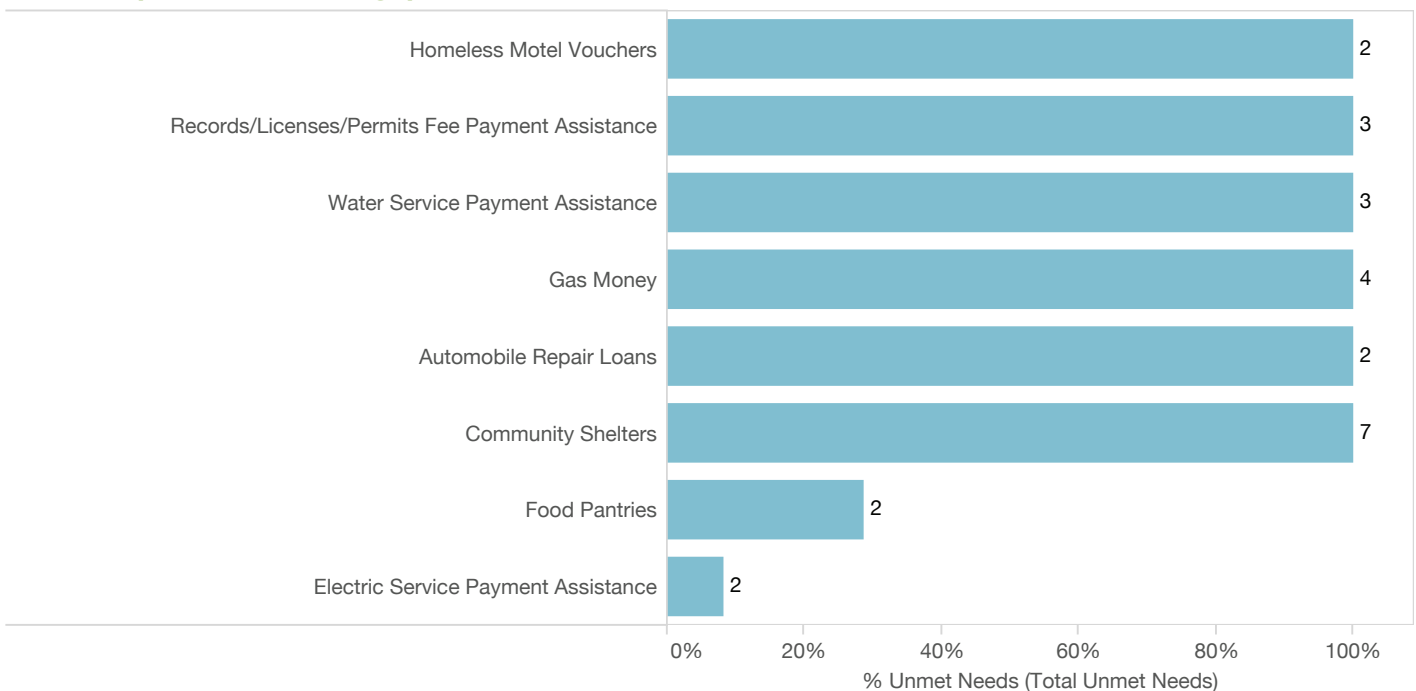

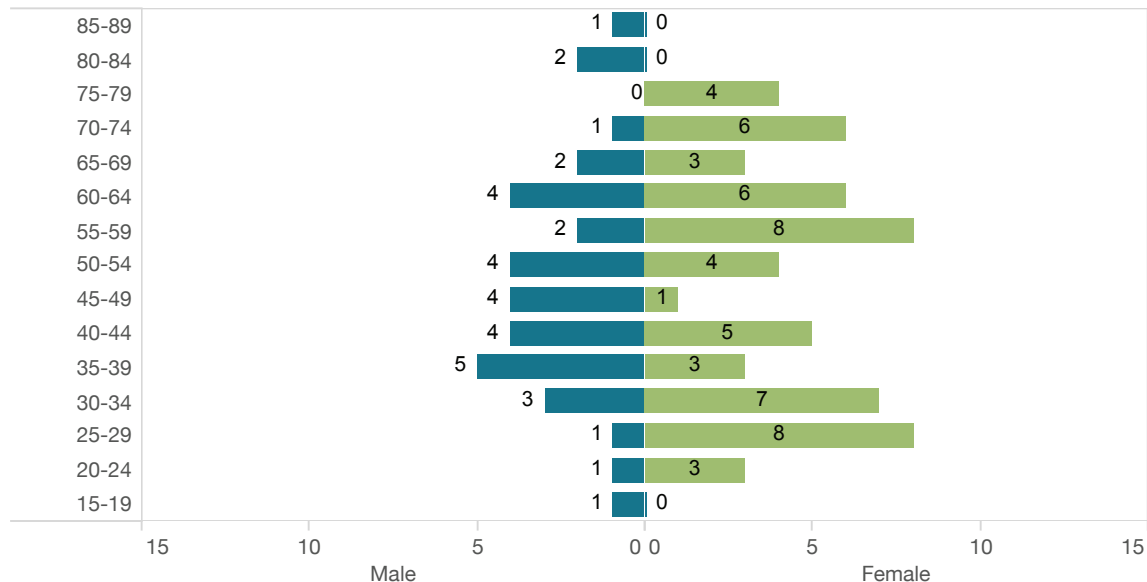

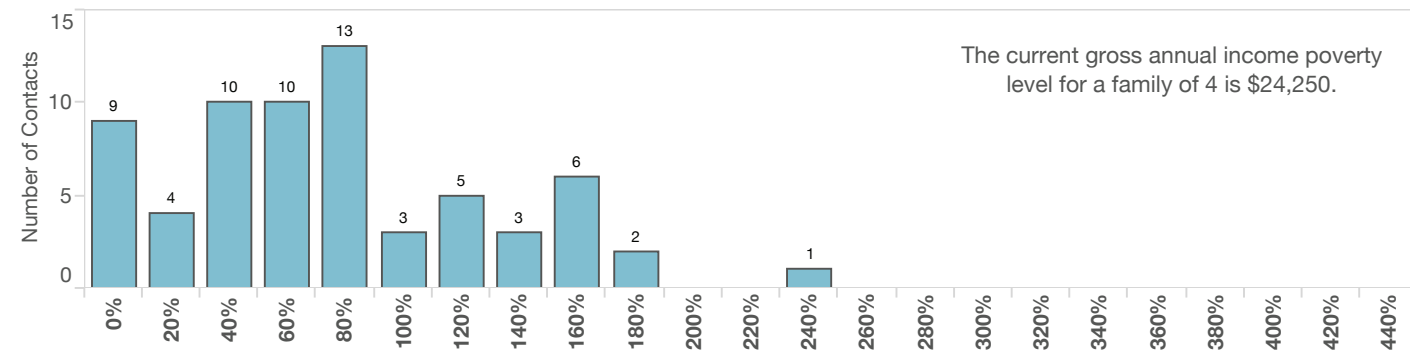

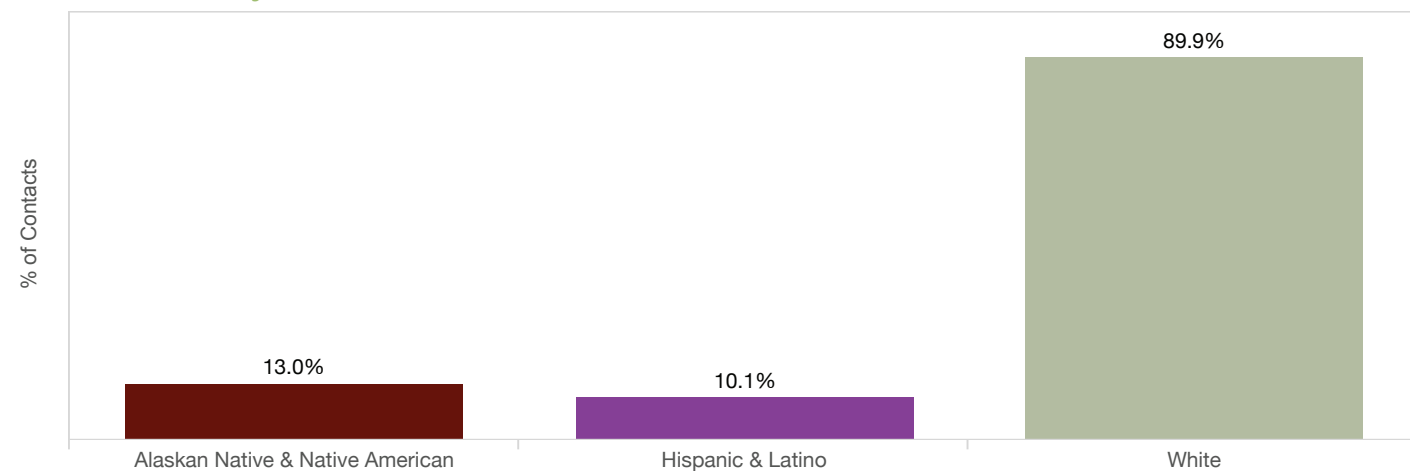
Age and gender

Race and ethnicity

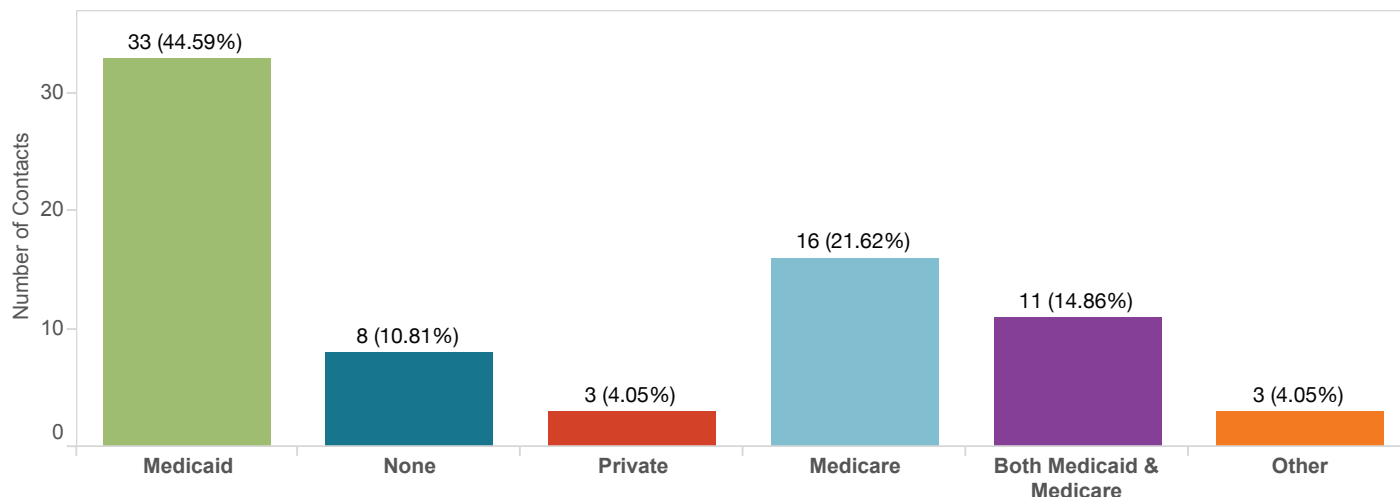

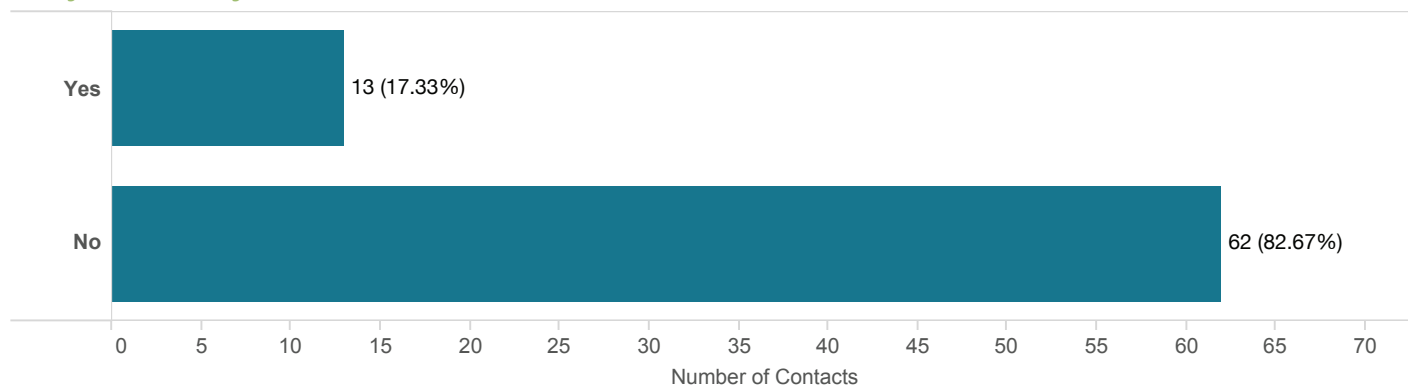

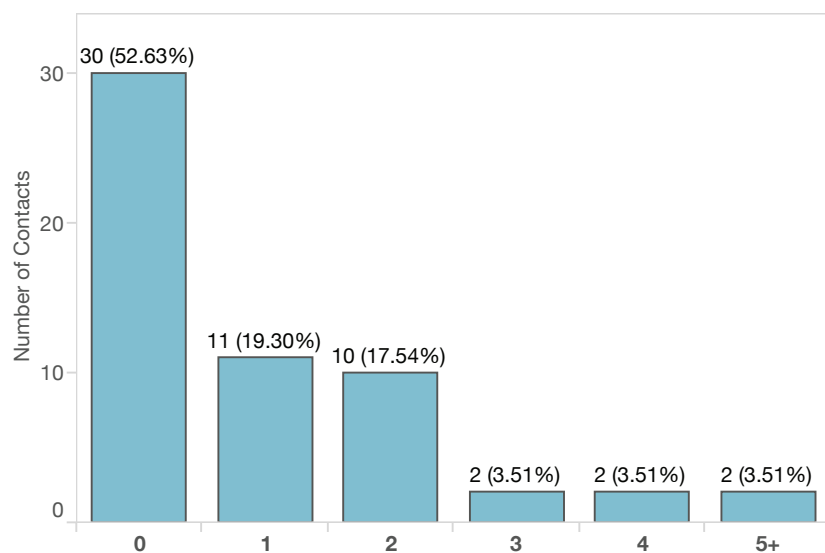
Health insurance status



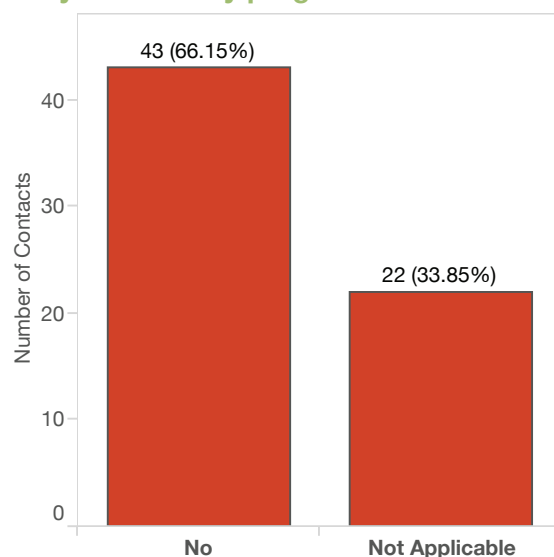
Are you currently homeless?
