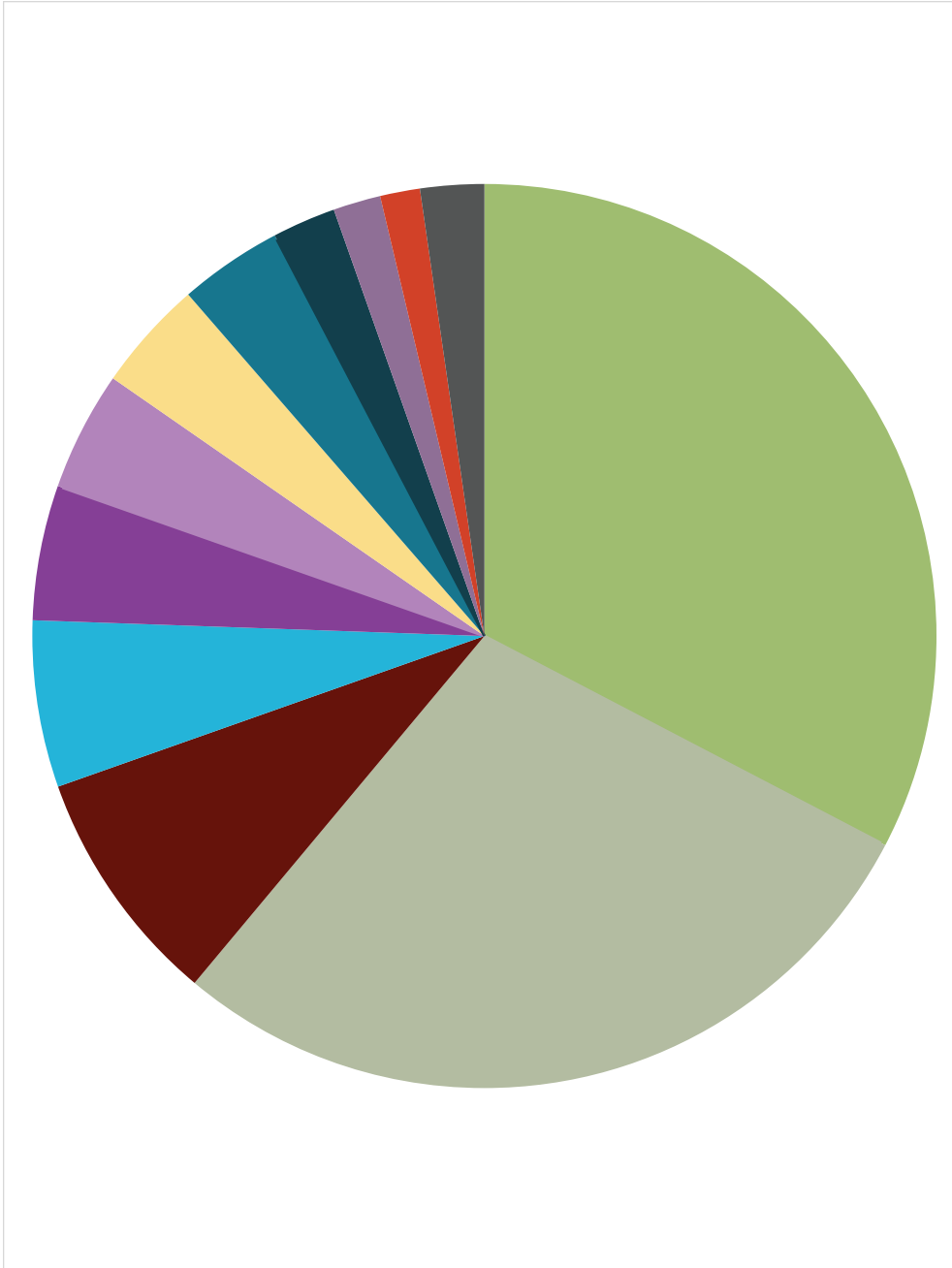

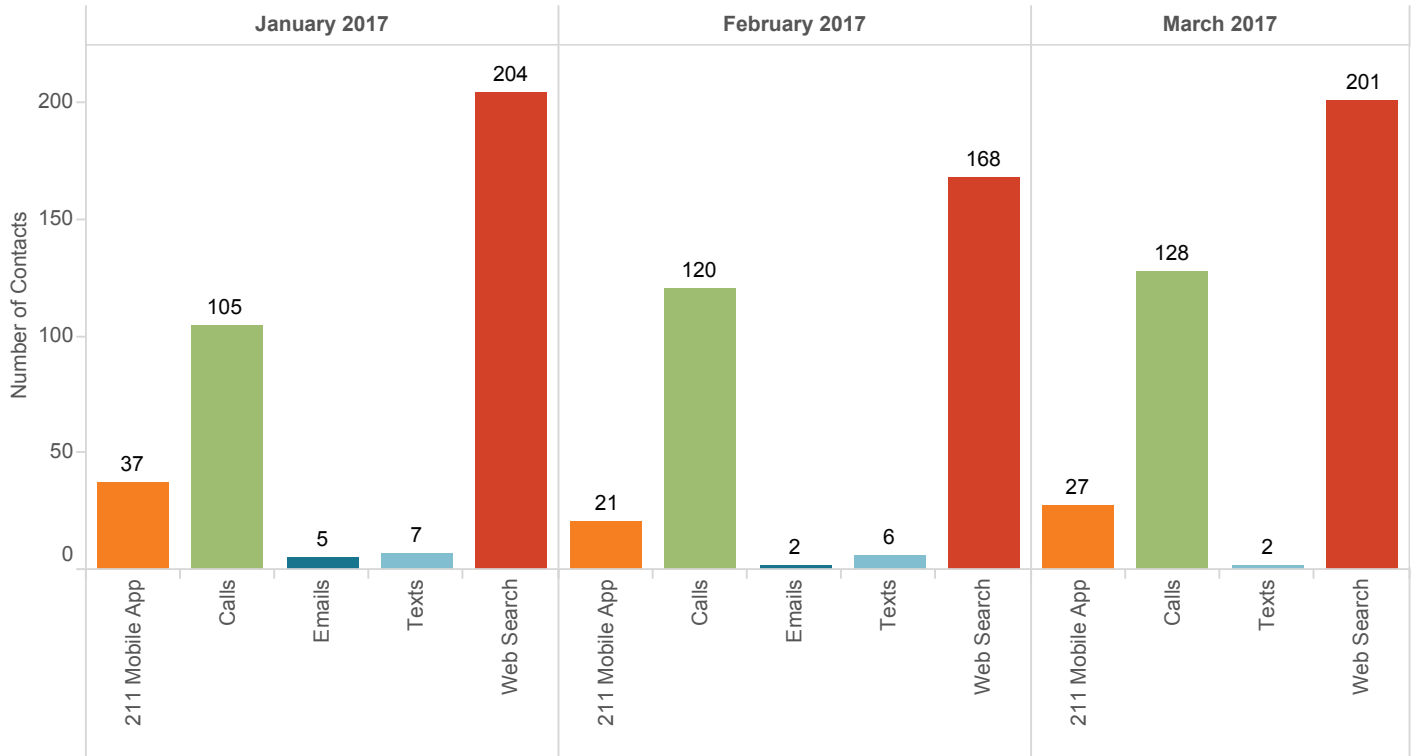

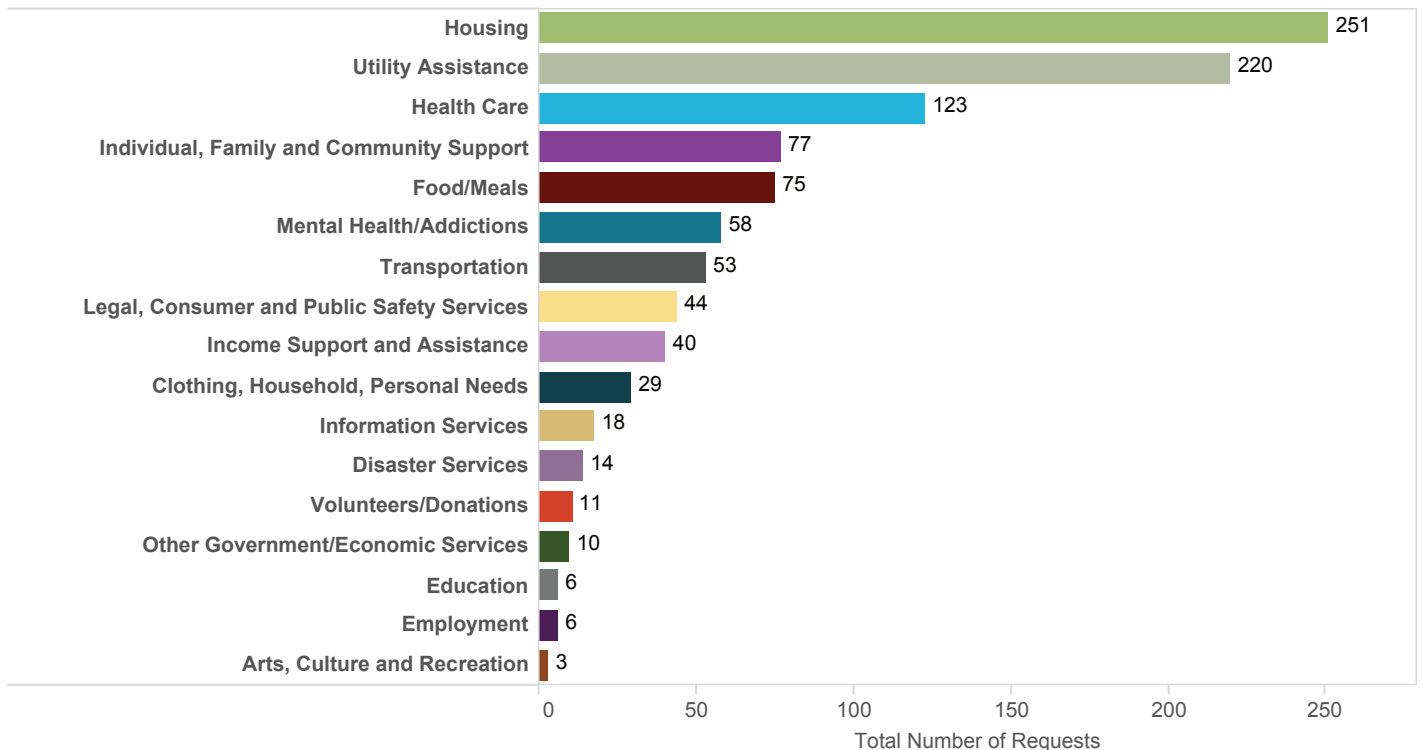

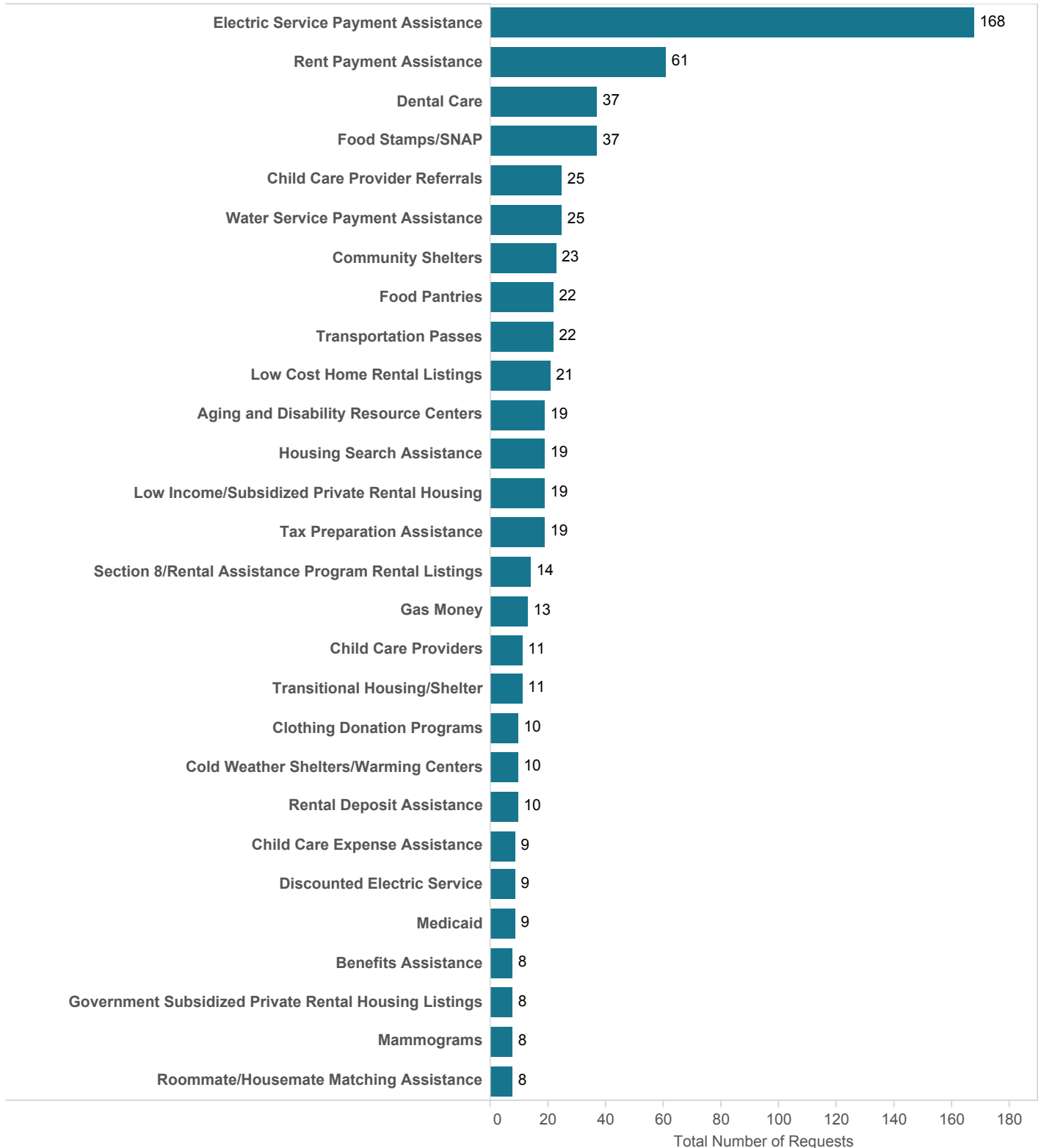
Number of contacts, grouped by month and contact type

Number of services with eight or more requests across all contact types

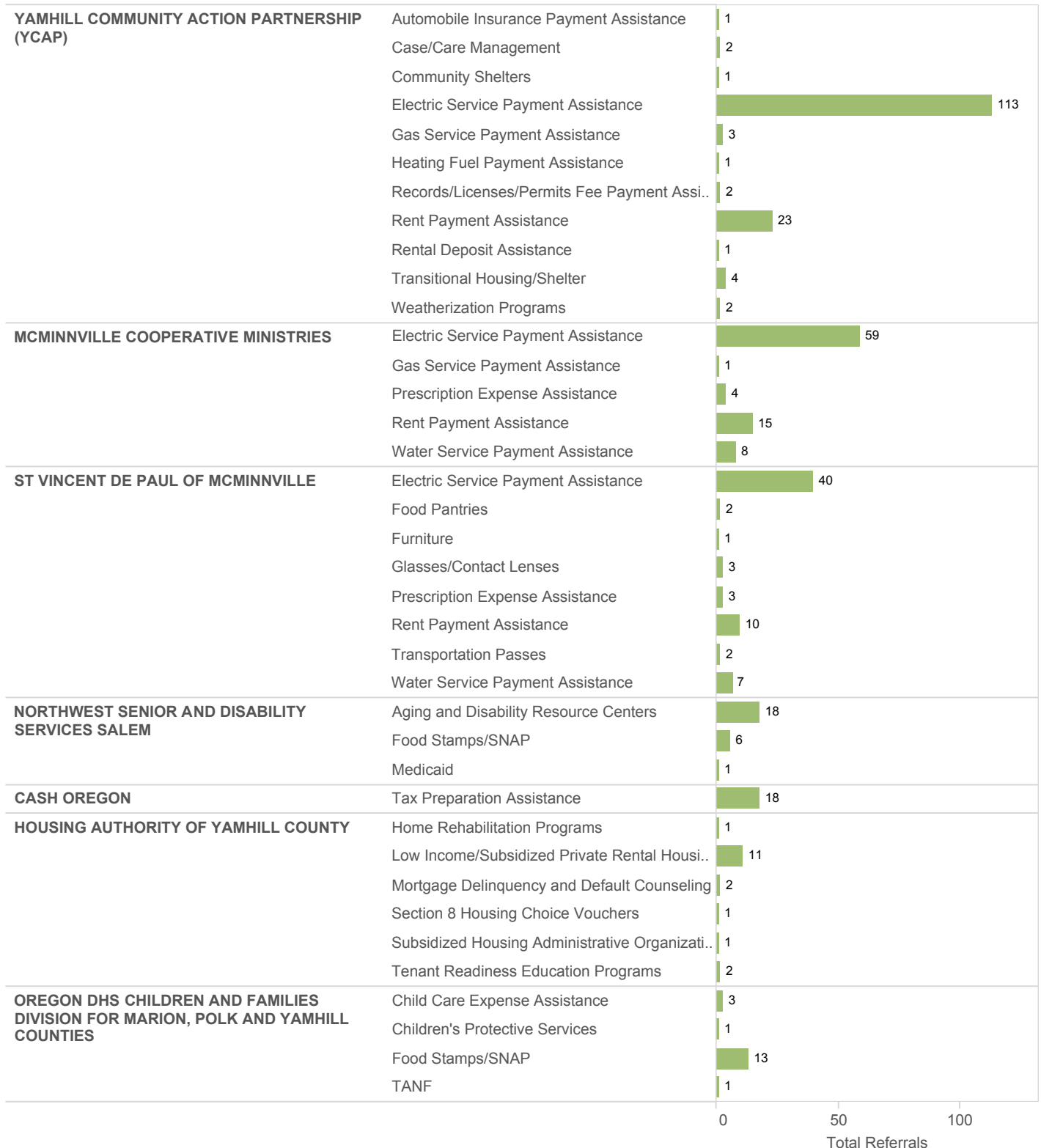

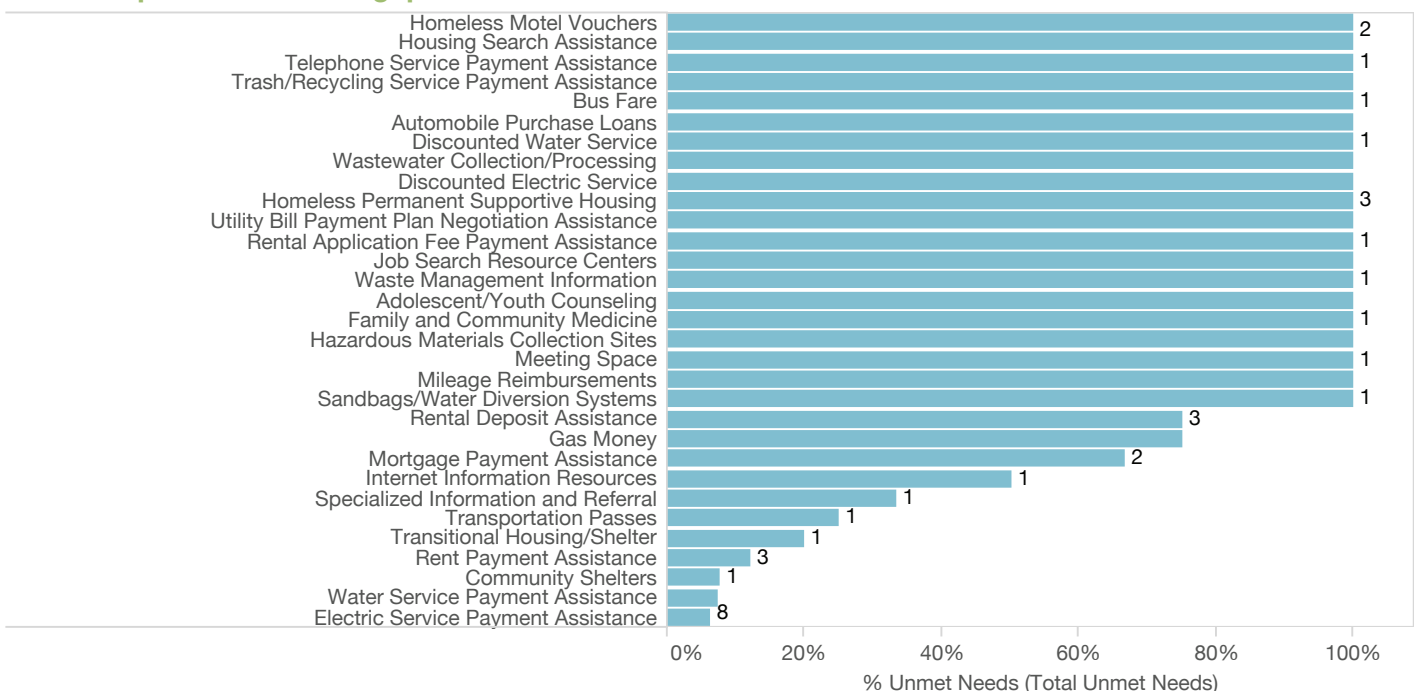
There were 50 instances where there wasn't an appropriate referral for the contact's requested need. Housing requests represent the largest number of unmet community needs.

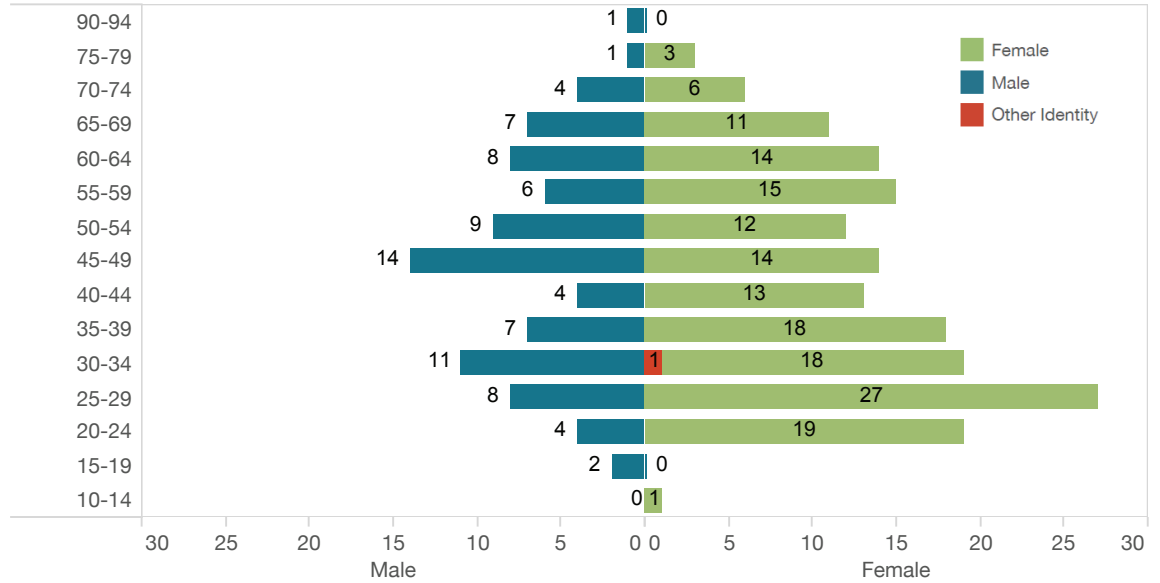

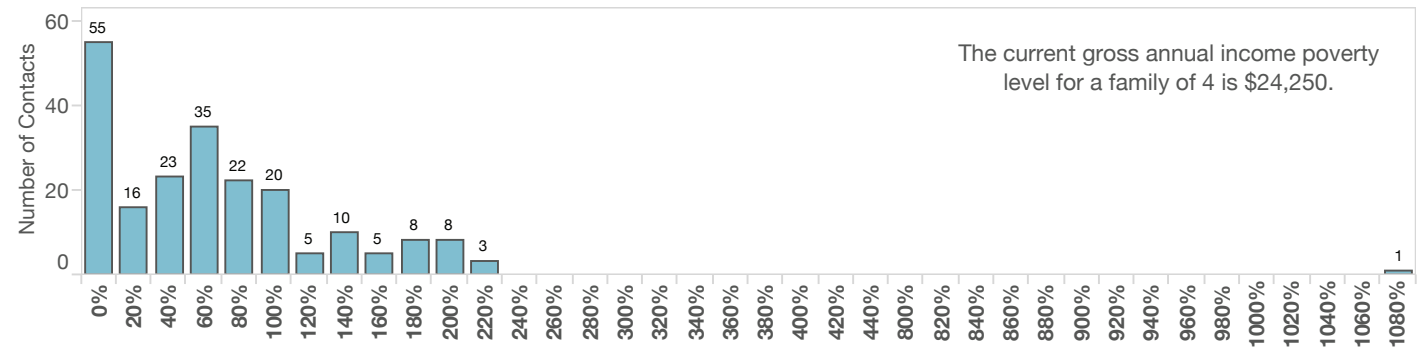

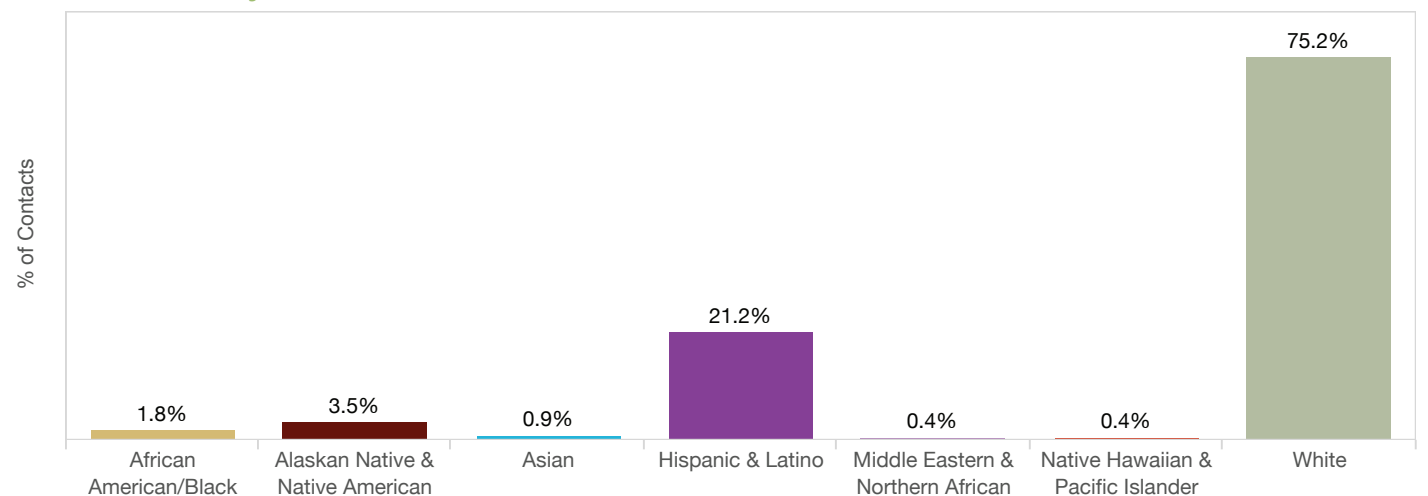
Age and gender

Race and ethnicity

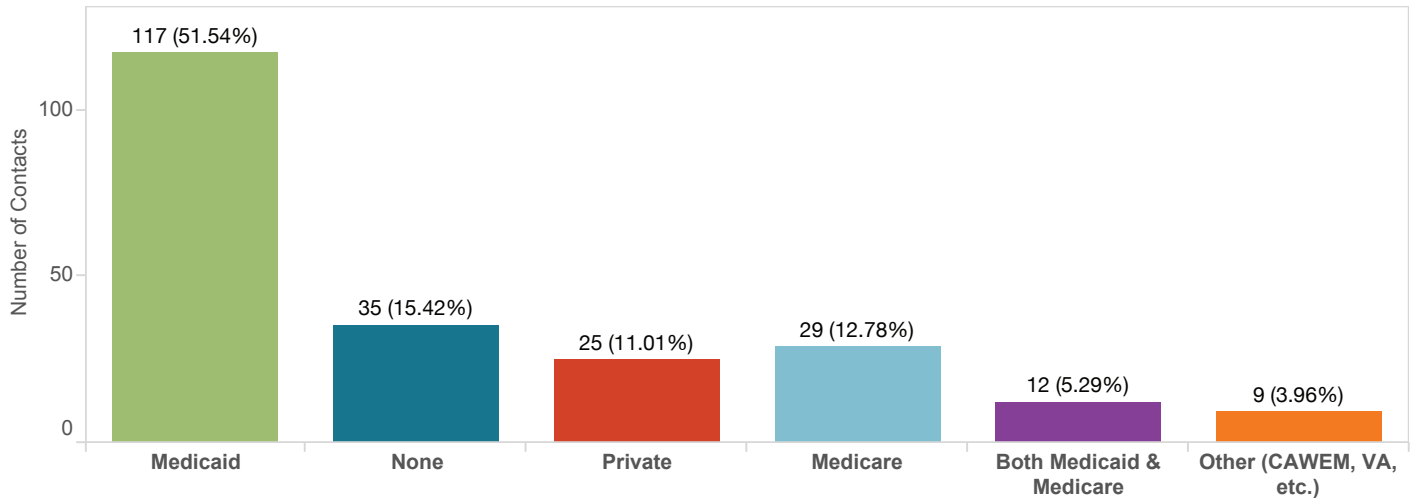

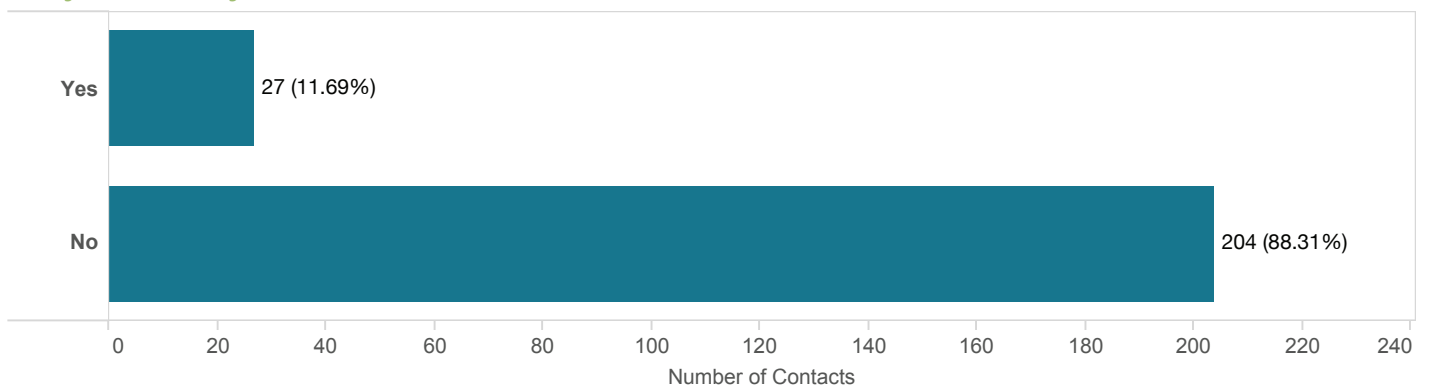

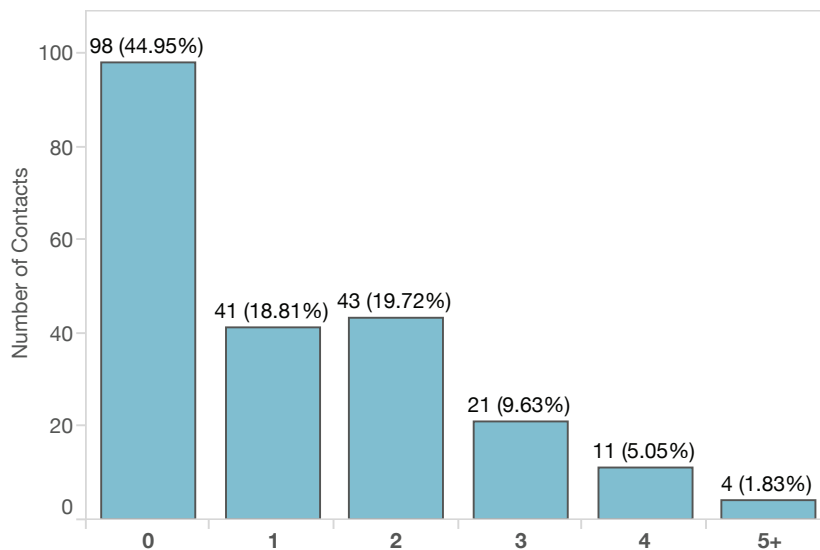
Health insurance status



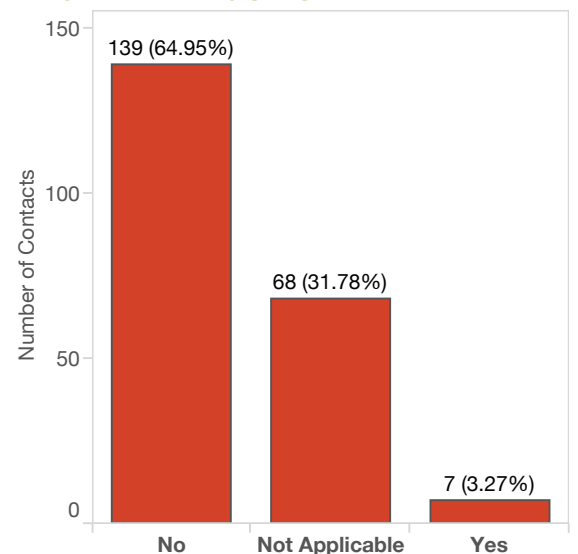
Are you currently homeless?
