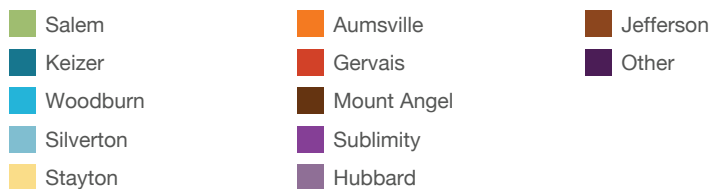
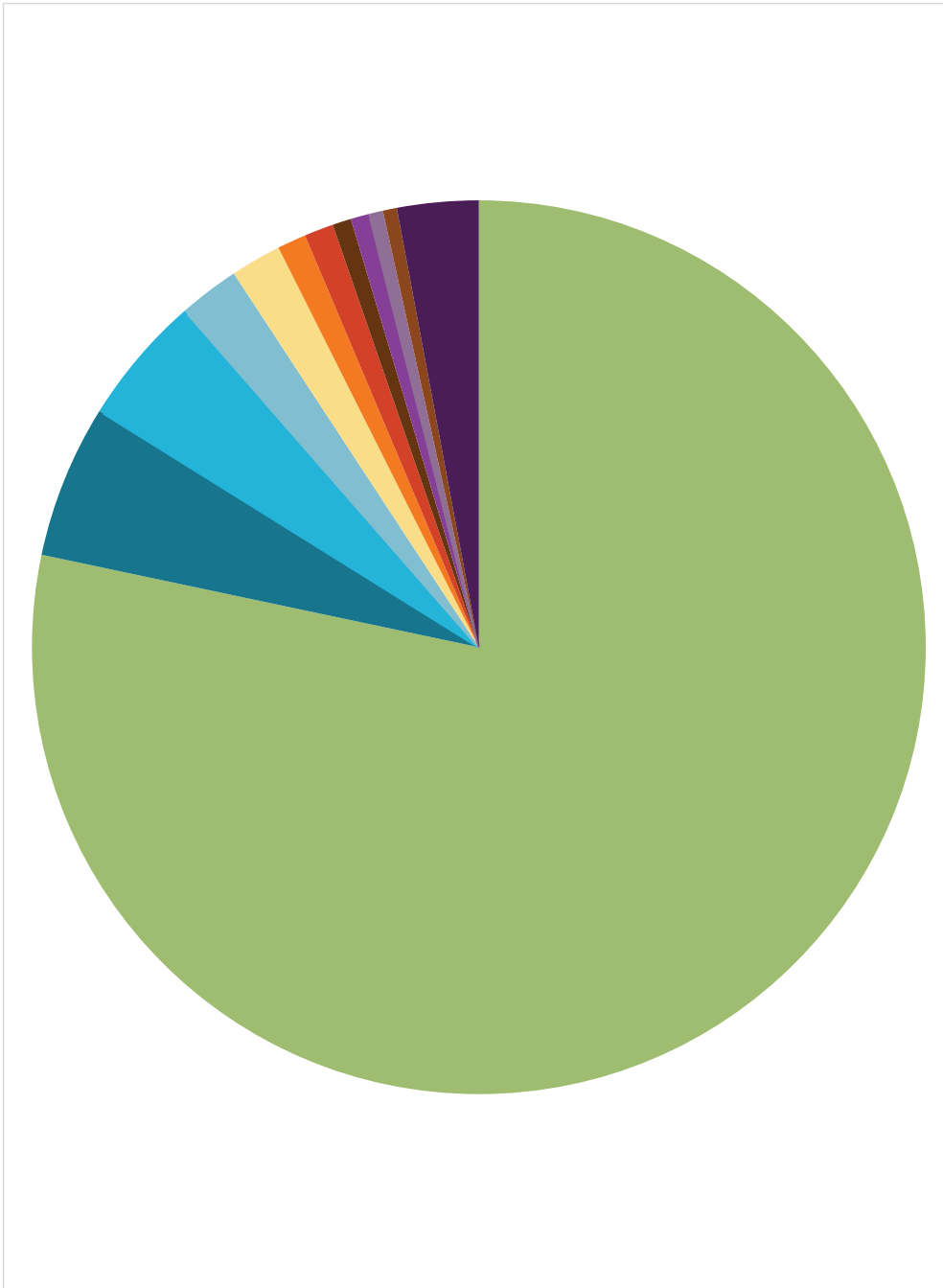

Percent of contacts by city



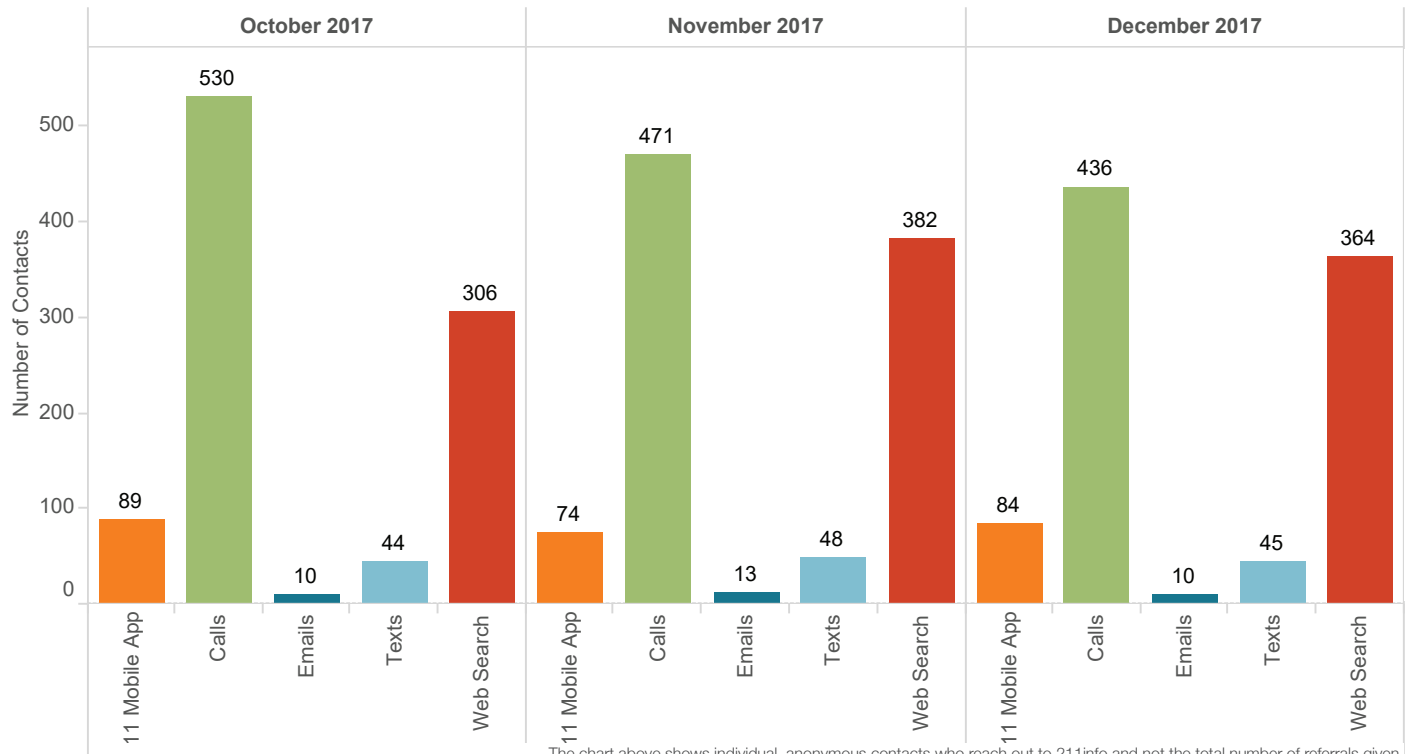

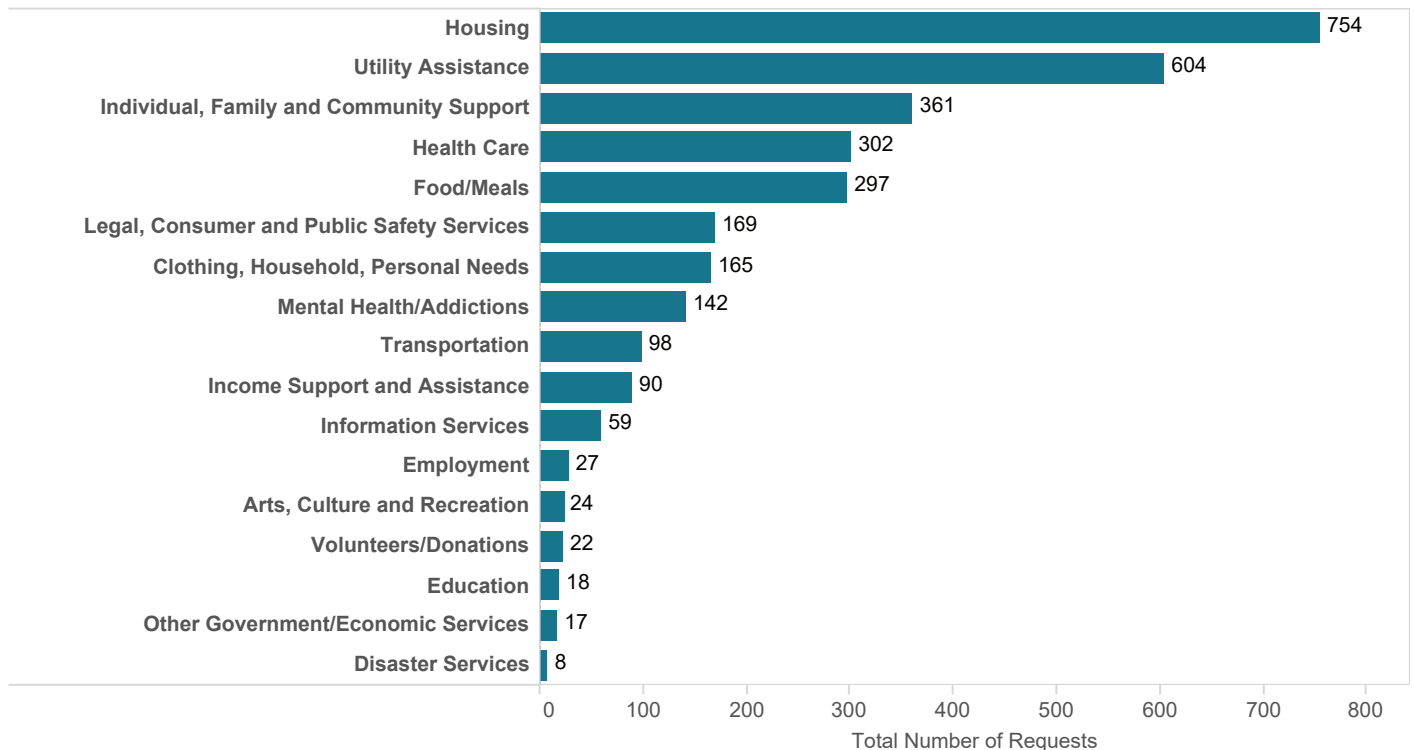


Number of contacts, grouped by month and contact type

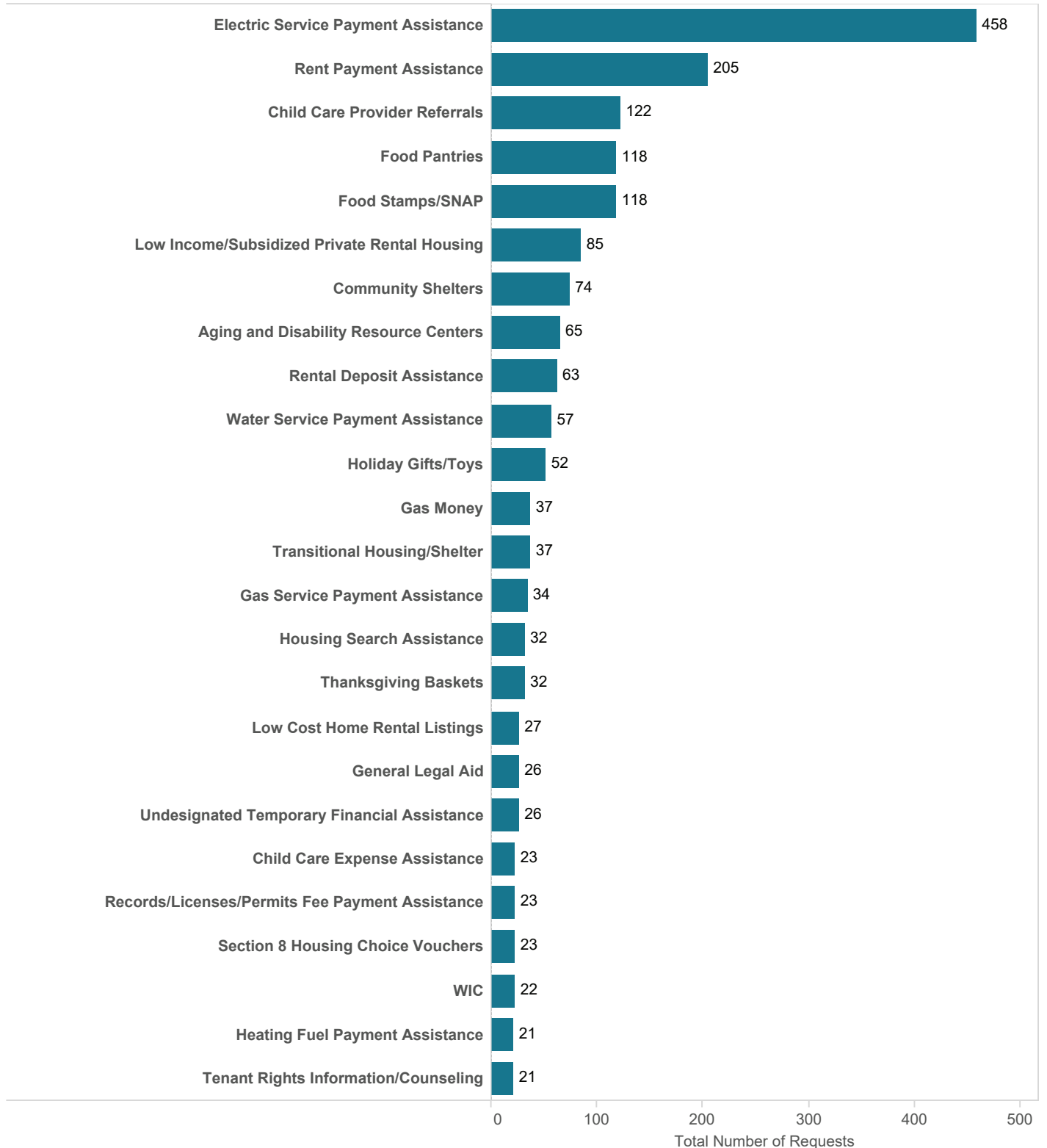


The chart above shows individual, anonymous contacts who reach out to 211info and not the total number of referrals given.

Top 25 needs across all contact types

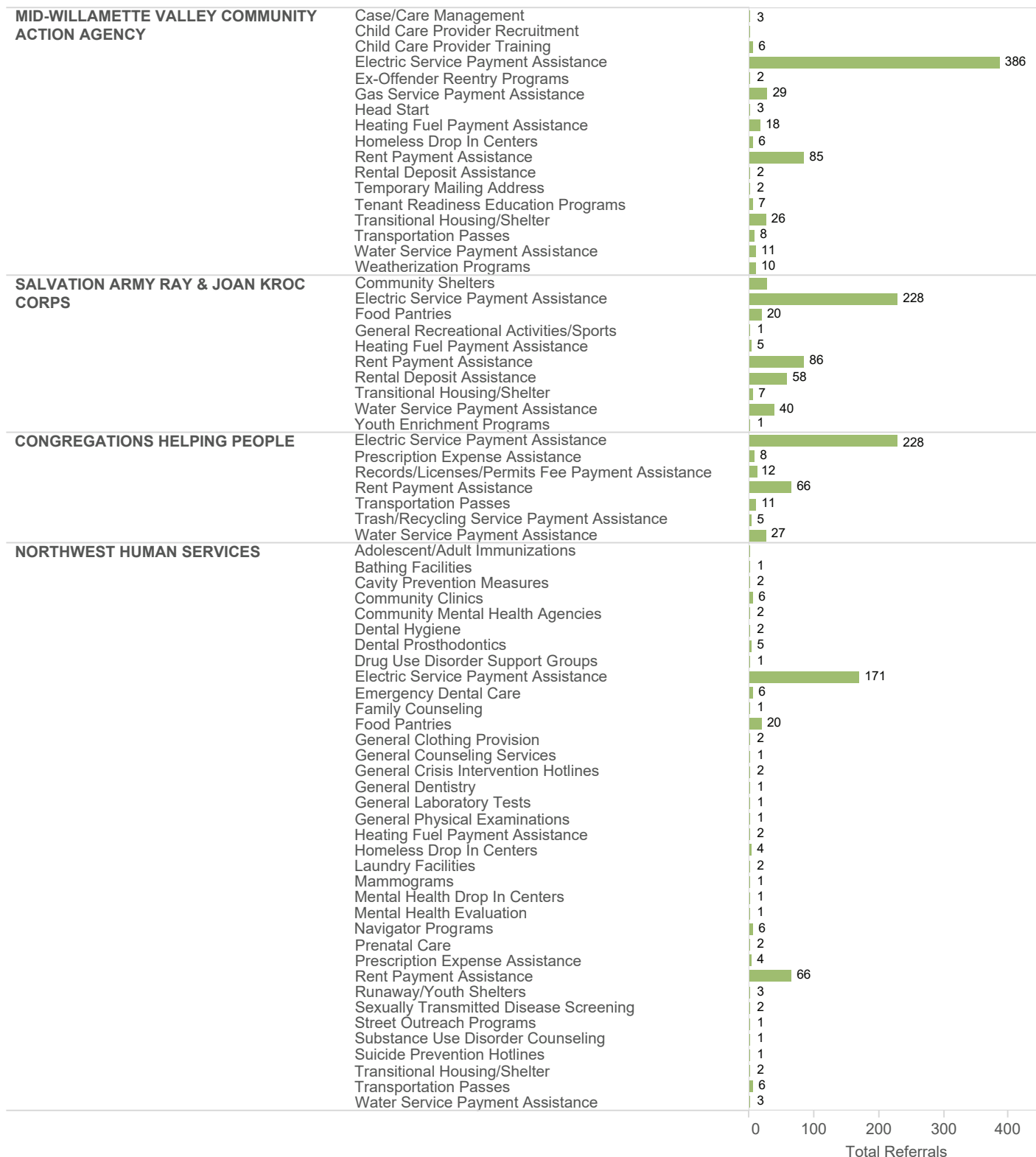

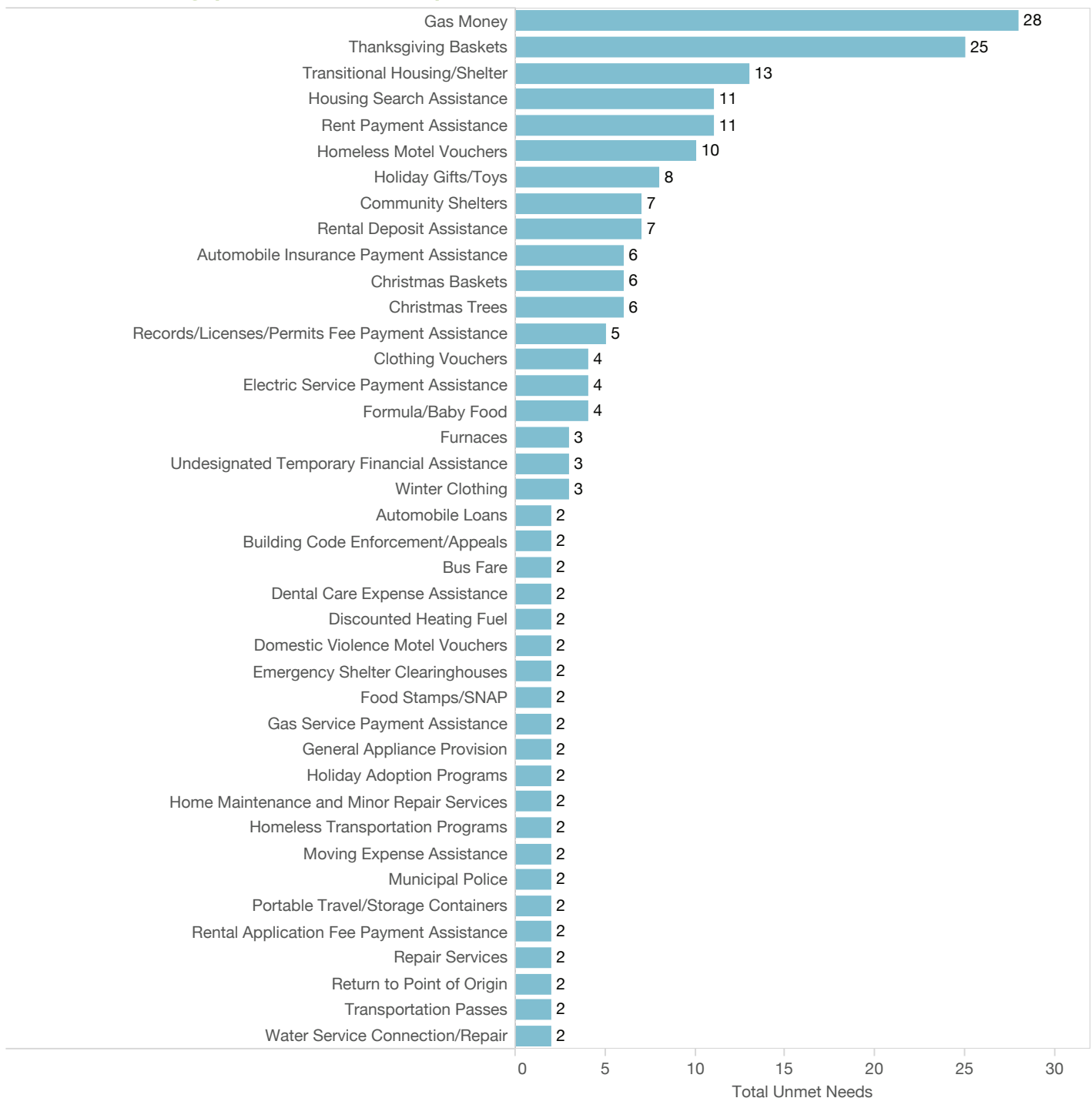


Top 4 agencies referred to across all contact types

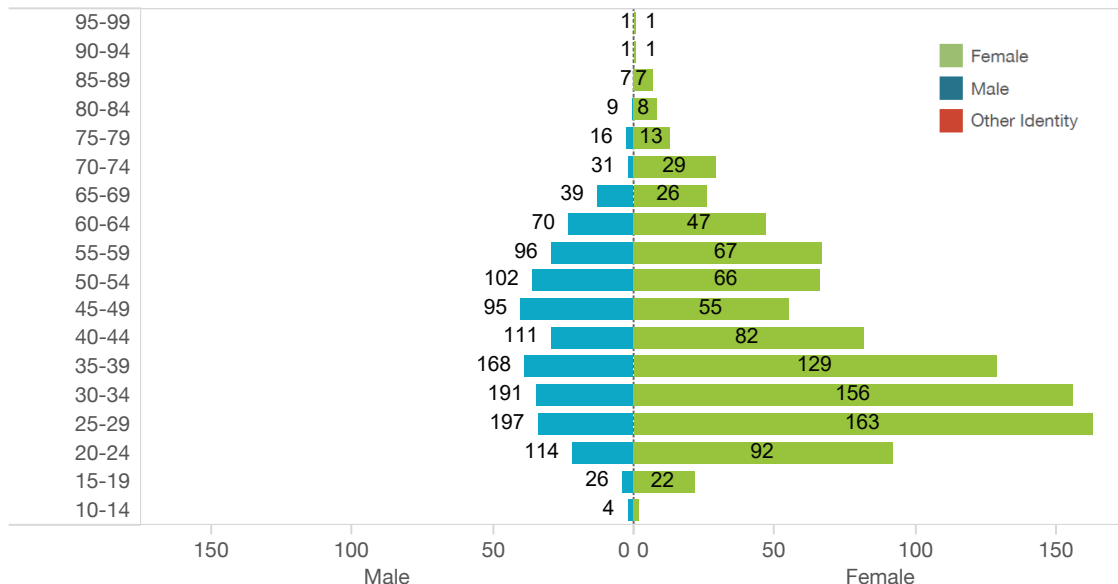

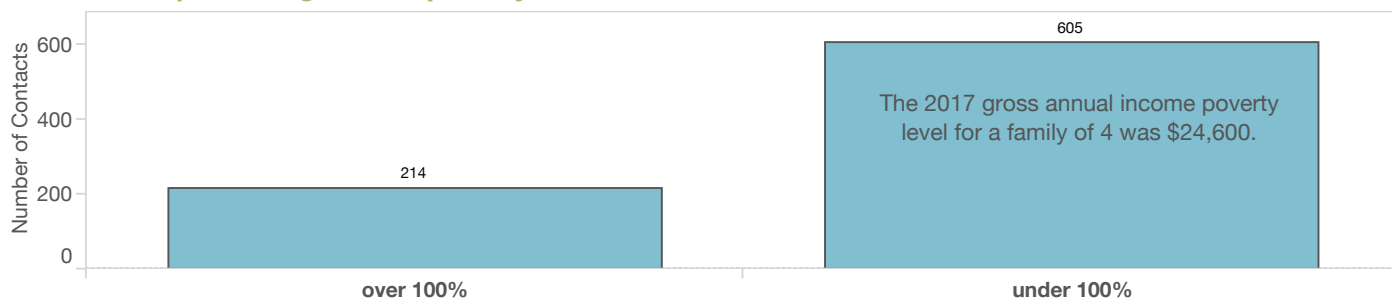

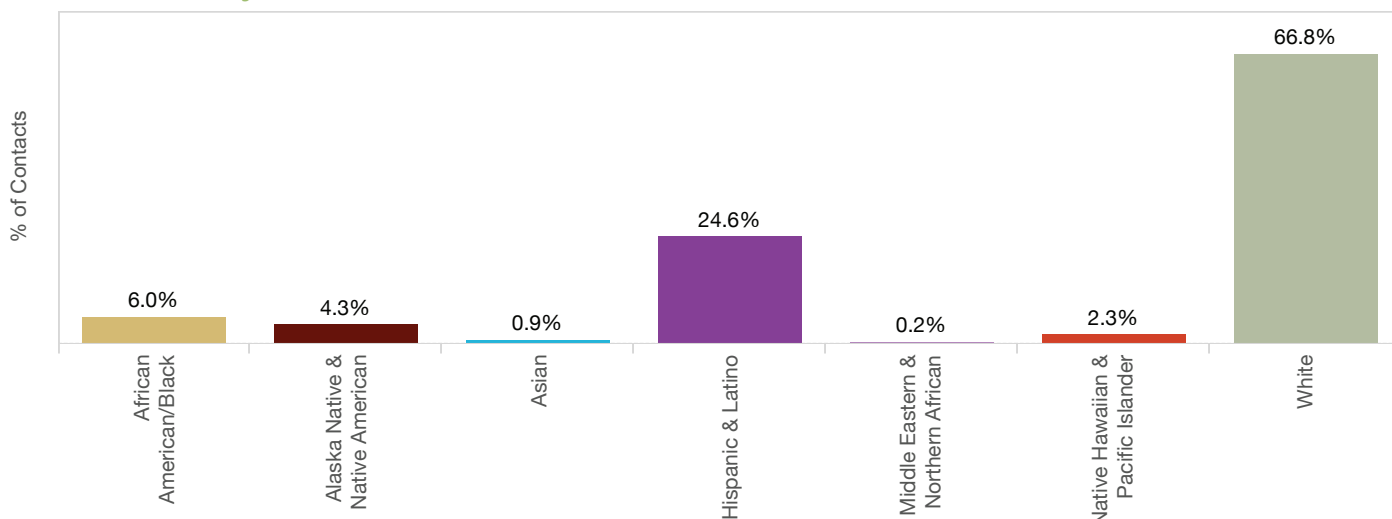
Age and gender



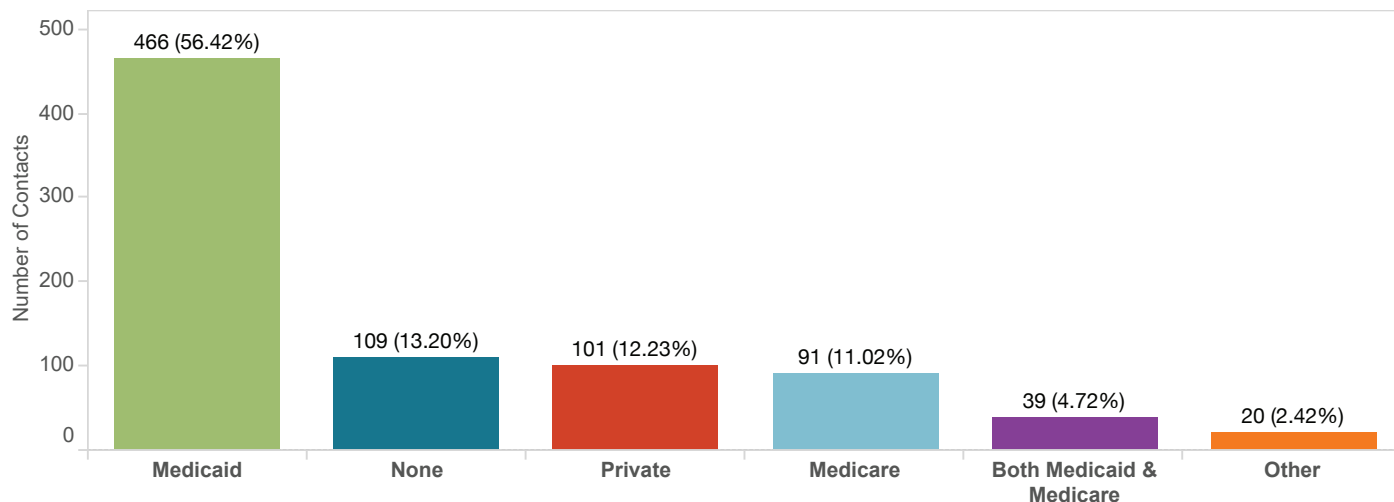
Income as a percentage of the poverty level



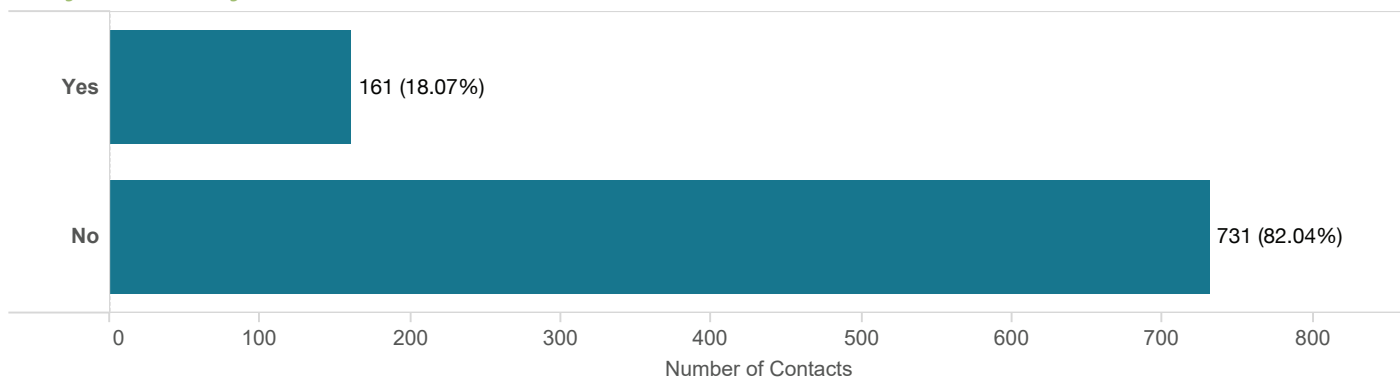
Race and ethnicity



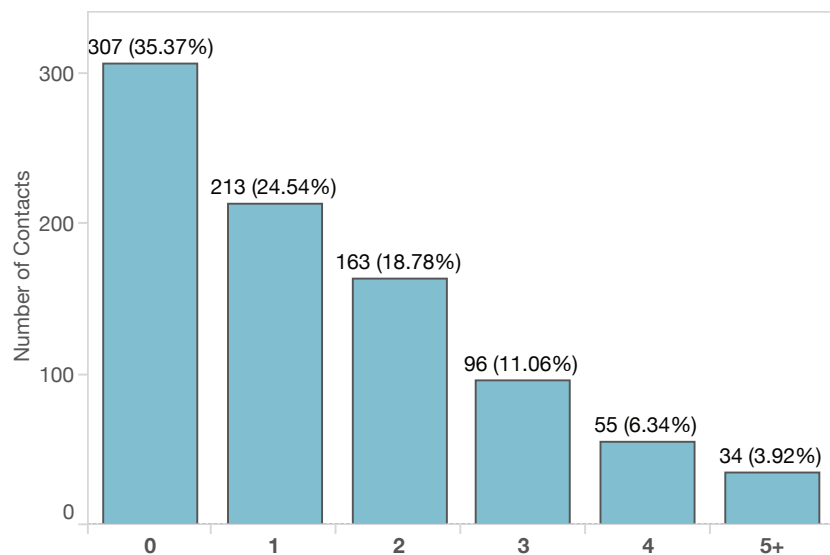
Health insurance status
