








### Number of contacts, grouped by month and contact type




### Number of services requested across all contact types, grouped by problem need






### Top 25 service requests across all contact types






### Top 5 agencies referred to across all contact types







#### Potenial service gaps with three or more service requests








### Income as a percentage of the poverty level











