 - 23 - Icelandic – Novice Four-Gait
 - 24 ** Open Youth/Adult Double Riders Walk & Pleas. Gait – Youth 12 & Under. - Youth in front/adult in back - Youth to control horse unless help is needed for safety reason.
 - 25 - Open 3 gait – Lite Shod, Trail Pleasure
 - 26 - Lite Shod AOT 2 gait OT
 - 27 - Trail Pleasure AOT 2 gait OT
 - 28 - Icelandic – Youth (Child) Tolt
 - 29 ** Open Youth Walk Only Class – Rider 12 & Under - Each youth may have an adult walking alongside of the horse, but adult may not touch horse unless help is needed for safety reason.
 - 30 - Open Novice Horse – 2 gait
 - 31 - Amateur 3 gait – Lite Shod, Trail Pleas., Co. Pleas., AD Pleas.
