You can view this booklet online on the High School Web page under Counseling Dept., Scholarships, Local/Departmental Scholarships. In addition, copies of the WDHS Scholarship Booklet can be found in the High School Main Office, the High School Counseling Office and the Kilbourn Public Library.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

STEPS TO TAKE FOR LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS:

1. Fill out the **Local Scholarship Application Form** - go to www.sdwd.k12.wi.us, click on High School Page Tab. Under Counseling Dept., Scholarships, Local/Departmental Scholarships. The Local Scholarship Application plus all Additional Applications are located there in WORD format. First save each WORD document to your own storage device so that you can type on and save each one. You only need to complete the local scholarship application one time, changing the scholarship name for each scholarship for which you apply.
2. Use this **Scholarship Booklet**. Read each scholarship offering carefully to choose the scholarships for which you qualify. Check or highlight the ones for which you will apply.
3. Then, follow the instructions for each scholarship application. Some will have you fill out their own **additional application** (See instruction 1. above). All applications must be typed.
4. Write a **Financial Need Statement** (no more than 500 words).
5. Write your **Career Plan** (no more than 500 words).
6. Include a one page **Resume**, also located on the HS web page (under the Counseling Dept. tab, Scholarships, Local/Departmental Scholarship area) in a WORD fillable format.
7. Include **Two Letters of Recommendation**, one from school (i.e. teacher, coach, club advisor), and one from the community (i.e. employer, pastor, youth leader, neighbor, etc.). A Letter of Recommendation - student worksheet may be requested in the HS counseling office.
8. Request a **transcript** from the counseling office after Semester 1 grading is completed.
9. Make copies for each local scholarship for which you apply **and** one additional copy to remain in the counseling office **only one, not one for each scholarship**. Staple all of **the above components** together for each application (you may use a cover sheet with the name of the scholarship and your name on it, but **PLEASE DO NOT USE PLASTIC OR HEAVY PAPER REPORT COVERS**). Applications will be accepted in the High School Counseling office on or before Friday, March 4, 2016.

LOCAL APPLICATIONS DUE Friday, March 4, 2016**

He was active in the tourism industry, promoting Wisconsin Dells tourism. He was active in Wisconsin and National politics. He received the first Wisconsin Dells Visitor & Convention Bureau Lifetime Contribution Award. He was also named, "Man of the Year" in 1959 by the Wisconsin Recreation Industry.

Scholarship Criteria and Selection Process:

1. At least one scholarship shall be awarded annually to a graduating senior from Wisconsin Dells High School, who will be attending an accredited college, university, or technical college.
2. Students are nominated and selected because he/she represents the following five characteristics.
 - A. A commitment to excellence in everything he/she says and does.
 - B. Attempts to do what is right at all times.
 - C. Dedicated to serving others.
 - D. Has the courage to trust, honor, and respect all who walk the halls of WDHS.
 - E. Demonstrates outstanding leadership in school and community.

ADCI - \$1,000 – WDEF Affiliated

This scholarship is to provide assistance to a graduating senior pursuing a career in architecture, building/construction trade, interior design, and engineering or construction management.

Purpose: The purpose of this fund is to provide for post high school educational opportunities for graduating seniors of Wisconsin Dells High School, Wisconsin Dells, Wisconsin.

Scholarship Criteria: At least one scholarship shall be awarded annually to a graduating senior who will be attending an accredited college, university or technical school. The student must have been accepted in one of the above post-secondary institutions, at the time of the application. The student must have a GPA of at least a 3.0. Preferences may be given for coursework that demonstrates a career plan, work experience in a related field, school-to-work study in a related field, and financial need.

Scholarship Application: Formal application for this scholarship through the high school Counseling Office.

AM. LEGION AUXILIARY, CARL E. GRABMAN MEMORIAL

This scholarship is given to financially assist and encourage a worthy senior graduating from Wisconsin Dells High School to further his/her education at a technical or trade school.

Award criteria:

1. Need
2. Character and high morals
3. Display of Americanism in his/her everyday actions.

4. Performed community service in the local area.

ANDERSON, BILLY MEMORIAL PERFORMING MUSICIAN \$1,000 – WDEF Affiliated

Biography: Billy's whole life was music. He appeared on Ted Mack's Original Amateur Hour in New York in the early 50's and studied music at the University of Northern Iowa. Billy spent the rest of his life as a professional musician performing in restaurants and night clubs in the Wisconsin Dells and all over Wisconsin. He was a consummate entertainer with the natural ability to bring joy to all who met him.

Purpose: Billy was an active performer and this scholarship was created to encourage WDHS music students to be active in community service through music by performing in the greater Wisconsin Dells community with school ensembles.

Scholarship Criteria:

1. Completion of the local scholarship application and be eligible to graduate with senior standing from Wisconsin Dells High School with a 2.5 GPA or higher. Must be accepted in a technical college, community

college, or four-year college or university at the time of application.

2. Be an active participant in the WD music program (band, jazz, and/or choir) for all four years of high school. Preference will be given to candidates involved in school performances in the greater Wisconsin Dells area community. Emphasis will be placed on junior and senior year performance involvement.

3. In their scholarship application candidates should provide evidence of their stewardship to the community of Wisconsin Dells through their music. (List of performances that the student participated in, signed by the instructor)

BAILEY, LAINA MEMORIAL \$ 1,000 – WDEF Affiliated

This award is a memorial to Laina Bailey, a 1998 WDHS graduate who attended the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee under an athletic scholarship and graduated with a Secondary English Education degree.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this fund is to provide for post high school educational opportunities for graduating female seniors of Wisconsin Dells High School, Wisconsin Dells, Wisconsin.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA: At least one scholarship shall be awarded annually to a graduating female senior who will be attending an accredited four-year college or university. The applicant must have participated in several high school sports and been involved in church activities. Preference may be given to students who also demonstrate involvement in community service and other school activities. Financial need may be a consideration.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION: Standard application for this scholarship located online or through the high school counseling office.

CHRISTENSEN, PETE & ROSANNE MEMORIAL AGRICULTURAL

This scholarship was established as a memorial by Travel Mart, Inc. for Pete and Roseanne Christensen, former Wisconsin Dells locals who dedicated their lives' work to farming in our community. Among their numerous contributions to their community, Roseanne served as the County

Clerk for several years for the Township of Del Prairie. This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a student who plans to further his / her education in the agricultural field. Applicant requirements include:

1. Demonstrated exemplary work in the area of High School Agricultural Science.
2. Plans to pursue a career in any agriculture-related occupation at either a 4-year or 2-year accredited college.
3. Successfully completed a minimum of 2 credits of agriculture education during high school (eligible courses are all classes located in the Course Description Book under Agricultural Science Department).
4. Participation in the Wisconsin Dells FFA Chapter is suggested but not required.

In addition to the general requirements for a local scholarship via the Wisconsin Dells High School, please include an **additional essay** regarding your experiences with technical work and your plans for involvement in this important field in your future.

CLASS OF 2013 SCHOLARSHIP \$500 - WDEF Affiliated

Separate application required, located on the WDEF & HS websites or in the HS Counseling Office.

PURPOSE: The purpose of the Fund is to provide for post high school opportunities for graduating seniors of Wisconsin Dells High School, Wisconsin Dells, Wisconsin.

CRITERIA: At least one scholarship shall be awarded annually to a graduating senior from Wisconsin Dells High School, who will be attending an accredited four year college or university, as a full time student. The student must be accepted at an accredited college or university, have a minimum of a 3.25 GPA, and have been involved in at least 2 extra-curricular activities, for a minimum of 2 years.

APPLICATION: Standard application for this scholarship located online or through the high school counseling office.

COON, HELEN MEMORIAL

Separate application required, located on the HS website or in the HS Counseling Office.

This \$500 award will be given to the following:

PURPOSE: The purpose of this scholarship is to award a graduating senior from the Wisconsin Dells High School, Wisconsin Dells, WI with similar traits and commitment.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA: The graduating senior must be pursuing a 4 year post-secondary education and plan to be attending a Wisconsin public or private university or college.
