Larry Spratt was elected to the CFFAE Board of Directors in 2013 and served as President in 2015-16.

He and his wife, Coralie, have four young children and farm with his cousin and his family near Melfort, Saskatchewan. Their operation consists of 5000 acres of grain, 3500 acres of hay/pasture/silage, 200 purebred cattle and a 600 head backgrounding feedlot. They maintain a well-balanced operation through crop rotations, manure management, swath and stubble grazing and rotational pasture grazing. They try to achieve economies of scale by using only one line of machinery for the entire farm.

Larry obtained a Bachelor of Science with a major in Mechanized Agriculture and a minor in Ag Business from the University of Saskatchewan. He also received an Associate of Arts from Briercrest Bible College.
