3. We require a letter from a teacher about the applicant: which should include academic abilities and school activities.
4. We require a letter from a golf pro or a member of the River Valley Junior Golf board describing the candidate's participation and interaction with River Valley Junior Golf.
5. Parents of applicants should not work on the selection process of the award to avoid any conflicts of interest.
6. All application must be received before the last day of the school term. (unless circumstances prevail; then acceptance of the application would be up to the Victoria Senior Golf Club selection committee).
