

LITURGICAL REFLECTION – The Consent of the couple follows the three questions on freedom, fidelity, and acceptance of children. The priest or deacon invites the couple to publicly declare their consent to one another. The groom is first; the bride is second. There are two different formulae for the consent; the couple chooses which option of consent they wish for their wedding. There is also the option to repeat after the minister or to simply say “I do.” The bridegroom and the bride are the true ministers of this Sacrament in their public Consent to each other. This Consent should be audible to all in the assembly.


Parish Registration:
