FRIENDSHIP / BULLYING / RELATIONSHIPS

During **For or Against**, we aim to broaden the conversation around bullying to one that includes all people; reminding students that each of us has a responsibility to show kindness, respect and inclusion to those around us. We ask the simple question: are you **FOR** or **AGAINST** others?

It is so important for students to understand bullying; what it is, the reasons why, and a response, therefore we address this topic and use the example of a bully being one who is firmly **AGAINST** others. We also give students ideas and tools on how to be kind people and great friends, this being an example of being **FOR** others.

Throughout this presentation, we reflect on the life of Jesus, drawing out stories and teachings that give example of how Jesus treated others, and what drove him to act with compassion, kindness and love.

Through the use of storytelling, role playing and group discussion, students will be given the opportunity to develop a practical understanding of how to create an inclusive and supportive environment.

This highly interactive workshop has a preferred maximum capacity of 60 students. To ensure content is age appropriate, we require groups to be split by year levels (eg. R-2, 3-5, 6-7).
