BULLYING / RELATIONSHIPS

Statistics show that bullying is affecting many of our young people; according to Mission Australia's most recent report, 50% of Australia's young people are concerned about bullying & emotional abuse*. While it's a topic so commonly talked about, so many of our nation's children are suffering the effects of bullying.

As we have conversations with young people we find the majority of students know the right information in regard to bullying; popular sayings like 'treat others how you want to be treated', 'respect' and 'don't judge' flowing freely in their language. But how is it that we still continue to find bullying, hate and inequality as common actions and attitudes throughout many high schools?

During **Loser 2.0** we reframe the bullying conversation down to a simple concept - one that changes the way we see and treat those around us. We ask the question: are you **for** or **against** others?

Throughout this presentation we reflect on the life of Jesus, drawing out stories and teachings that give example of how Jesus treated others, and what drove him to act with compassion, kindness and love.
